**The Rearing of Chickens.**  
Importance of Green Food.

The more one tries to do with rearing poultry the more one realizes the importance of green food in the dietary of any bird. It is not a simple supply but only a means essential to the maintenance of health. While birds have liberty over a wide range they will find the necessary green food through the greater part of the year, but when they are reared it is difficult to preserve the grass sufficiently for their needs. It will be found that grass runs that active and productive birds will do best on the greenest of the grass. At the back of green food will be any substitute or poor substitute. The best method when possible is to have a sufficient number of runs to allow changing over to green food. This should be a certain amount of green food. Such things as rape, lucerne, lettuce and cabbage are of great value when the birds are confined in runs.

**WHITE FEATHERS IN CHICKENS.**  
When a beginner sees some eggs of Black Minorca, or of any

dark plumaged bird, the chicks usually come with a few white feathers. The novice is inclined to think he has been "done," for the breeder. It will be found that such chicks in the end will turn out the best workers, having more brilliant adult plumage than the chicks which started with some white. This is provided that the reater gives proper attention to rearing. One-rearing or two many ones will produce white feathers.

**LIGHT AND DARK YOLKS.**  
The colour of the yolk does not depend on the breed of fowl but on the food. When a great variety of food, with abundance of green food, is given to the poultry, the colour of the yolk is deeper than when the birds receive no change of diet. The eggs from poultry in confinement will be found to have pale yolk unless green food is given.

**ANSWERS TO CORRESPONDENTS.**  
PROPORTION OF SEXES: A correspondent writes asking how many hens should be put with

each male. It is a question often asked, and no definite answer can be given. It all depends upon the vicinity of the birds, and conditions under which they are kept, and the variety. The more birds (especially after the season, if it is kept the heavy variety of food is low or less increasing later) the more of them. It is better to have eight or ten may be allowed at the start, increasing by a dozen or fifteen later on. Will reference to another article has been found that, as a rule, when one cock is put in, just two many hens in the breeding pen, the chicks will hatch well from the fertile eggs but there will be a lot of infertility. Occasionally it will be found that too few in the pen prevents having sufficient eggs; it is useless to keep such hens in the pen, and if removed to another breeding pen will probably give better results. It must be remembered that some of the hens have been mated up they should save by increasing with unless absolutely necessary. A. M. D.

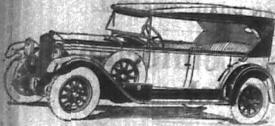

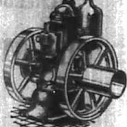

The attention which quite properly has been directed to the extremely valuable work which is being done in Kenya under the supervision of Dr. Orre, Director of the Bowers Research Institute, has perhaps tended to obscure the part played in the inauguration of that work in this country by many resident stock farmers and notably by Lord Delamere and the Honorable Gairdner Cole. For years they have carried out experiments with a view not only to improving the condition of their stock but of developing better types and the community owe a debt to them for having been the means of interesting such an important aspect of the progress in their work which became a scientific knowledge quickly and will prove a benefit to the farming community generally. The task of the investigators in the future should be rendered easier and even more valuable as a result of the information furnished by the country farmers that welcomed by the country because it epitomizes the individual experience of the considerable work with negligible scientific background. Dr. Orre's first report which through the "Kenya and East African Medical Journal" we reproduce to-day will read with interest and should provide a stimulus which farmers greater confidence that the desire of many of them to improve their stock industry methods and to establish such

things as wool growing and dairying on more scientific lines will be realized. In the past efforts lacking the knowledge individuals possess as the result of scientific research have found their efforts in improving stock and in the raising of somewhat unscientific. TOPICS for MOTORISTS.

The Chassis Functions of the Various Parts.

What to include—what to leave out—these are main difficulties involved in attempting a general description of a motor-car chassis and how it works. The underserver to meet a middle course, and to include the main parts of the chassis and the engine, which are the most elementary knowledge only the best of motorists.

Taking the components one by one, it is possible to examine the chassis and engine, which form the foundation upon which the body of the car is built. The engine, connected with lightness, is the largest and most important section of the chassis, which is a high-revving engine.

These two members are tied together at intervals by connecting rods, most of which are also channel-sectioned, but often through a heavy tubular member. In addition, placed near the centre, which receive the twisting action that occurs when rough roads are negotiated. As a rule, suspension forgings are riveted to the ends of the axle members for the adjustment of the springs, and these are known as axle-hubs.

Each of the four springs upon which the framework rests is of a standard shape, and is made of leaves, or plates, which are riveted to the axle-hubs. Another set of four springs are employed, which are known as the front springs, and are of a different shape. The rear eye is fitted with a spring and a shock absorber, which allows for the lengthening and shortening of the spring when it bends and rebounds.

Incidentally, the rubbing of the leaves produces a damping effect, tending to reduce bouncing, but this is usually supplemented by "shock absorbers"—a term which is usually misapplied to the device, as named in almost all book-keeping.

Another common type of spring, particularly on heavy motor-cars, is the coil spring, which is shown at the rear end of the specimen chassis. 

**KILINDI OR TANGA?**

**A Question for Meats Coffee Planters.**

**MOMBASA DISCUSSION.**

**Higher Charge But Better Facilities.**

Members, Thursday.

["STANDARD" SPECIAL REPORT.]

In view of the increased port charges at Kilindini, the Chamber of Meats Coffee Planters to ship their produce through Tanga instead of Kilindini.

In moving this resolution on behalf of the Meats Chamber at the conference of the Association of Eastern African Chambers of Commerce at Mombasa, Monday, Major A. K. Perkins remarked: "I know I am going to get a rap over the knuckles for this."

He stated that when it was suggested that certain improvements be made at the Port of Tanga in 1929, the Chamber of Meats Coffee Planters expressed an understanding that had been arrived at that all produce from the province should be concentrated on Kilindini; that it was not his intention at that time to make provision for improvements on the Tanga wharves, and that the Port would be used only for coasting work in the area. The matter was then dropped and all Meats Coffee Planters had been reported as Kilindini. During the past four to five months plants had been advised to ship coffee and meat to Tanga. The matter became acute when the Kilindini Port charges were increased and Tanganyika were informed that there would be a saving of 5s/6 per ton on coffee if shipped to Tanga instead of by Kilindini. It was a vital point because nearly half year they expected to export about 3,000 tons of coffee.

**A Suggestion.**

The President, Mr. A. C. T. Tsalali asked Major Perkins if it would meet his point if the Association recorded the fact that in view of the increased charges at Kilindini, planters might have to ship their produce through the port of Tanga and that it should be an instruction to the Executive Committee to enquire into the matter.

Major Perkins stated that that would meet the point.

On a point raised by Mr. R. R.

Completed there was some discussion as to the actual amount of the difference between the port charges at Tanga and Kilindini.

Mr. Kemp stated that this was obviously a business matter for the planters themselves. He did not see that the Association should pass any resolution in connection with it.

Mr. J. A. Wood said that this matter had been considered previously by the Harbour Advisory Board. The Board considered that even after the tariffs had been reduced but at this stage they were unable to advise a reduction in the charges on coffee. They had to give the Association the opportunity to produce evidence and he personally would advocate a reduction on the rates for coffee when the balance sheet showed that a reduction could be made. He would set planters in the territories to look at the matter from the broad point of view and to consider that even though they were at the moment paying the 6/ per ton more on a particular commodity, there were other commodities on which the charge had been lower. He would ask their Meats friends to consider that at a later stage when the returns and expenditures showed a better position they could only on the Harbour Advisory Board to consider any case for a reduction. He expressed the hope that the delegates of the Meats Chamber would have their resolution.

**Improved Facilities.**

The Commissioner of Customs pointed out that members were enjoying greatly improved shipping facilities at Kilindini Port and it seemed to him only reasonable that the people who made use of those facilities should pay something for that.

Major Perkins said there were many planters in his area who were prepared to pay the higher rates at Kilindini in order that their goods would be handled in

the right way. He brought the matter forward to point out the difference in charges at Kilindini and Tanga and to mention whether the better facilities for handling at Kilindini compensated the planters in his district for the extra payments.

Mr. T. Campbell, Mombasa, then proceeded to describe the better facilities to exporters at Kilindini. They had a more regular service of vessels, he pointed out, and were shipped across the bay water there, thus avoiding the risk of lightening landing. There were other suggestions which made it advisable for planters to pay the extra charge to be handled very much while the Kilindini rates were so much higher than those at Tanga as had been suggested.

Major Perkins said he would place on record that owing to the high rates at Kilindini which excluded those at Tanga by the 5/ per ton the Meats Chamber was considering whether it was advisable to ship through Tanga instead of the high Kilindini.

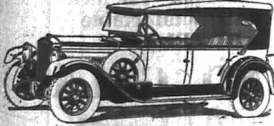

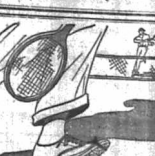

**TOPICS for MOTORISTS.**

**Considerate Driving.**  
Good and Bad Form.

We hear many complaints, not only as to vehicles and drivers, but also as to the manner of driving. While improper driving may perhaps at times of the nature of both offences, it is a rule there is a very distinct line of demarcation between them. Inconsiderate driving may be in some degree dangerous driving, and broadly all forms of dangerous driving are inconsiderate driving, but the simple reason that, were it not for the fact that, in some cases, considered, such offences would not be committed. 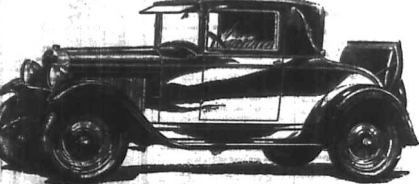

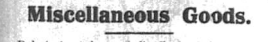
