Trifles which Help.
Practical Hints for Owners.

General Advice.

The location of any unusual noise in the engine is usually facilitated if the frequency is translated down to the normal level. Common engine noise may generally occur as either crankshaft or mainshaft speed and by taking when the knots covers with reference to the rotation of either of these shafts the knock may be more easily classified. Main bearings, crank-pin, and pistons, in more costly engines knock at crankshaft speed which is one-half that of the mainshaft. We usually take the lower bearing or one half of the shaft first.

Dynamo Brushes.

It is wise continually to remove dynamo brushes and to examine them and the commutator segments. In most dynamo the brushes are held in their guides by spring fingers. By raising the finger which the spring finger rests on the brushes will withdraw. If they are not to be removed they should be replaced from the commutator by a slot wed on the end of a pin.

Getting out of the Mud.

For cross-country driving, when rain is about, it is a good idea always to carry a good stout rope twenty-five or thirty feet long, which may come in useful for towing persons or in other ways. Given a short length of rope they enable the car to extricate itself if it gets stuck in mud or sand. Tied round one of the back three or four tires, with the end under on the tread which, this little added traction usually will suffice to get out if the car is merely bogged in muddy wagon tracks, which

are much narrower than modern type tracks, the sides of the ruts are liable to grab and hold the treads of being too narrow, a car will only slip in the rear wheel. If the engine is too hot a spot is found from which the car can be moved without trouble, and then proceed, being careful to avoid the ruts.

Starting Tips.

To get maximum power and efficiency from an engine it is absolutely necessary that the proper type of starting plug be used. When a plug is too short it does not bring the firing points far enough into the combustion chamber. Good ignition under this condition is impossible. The engine is bound to be sluggish and inefficient. A plug that is too long extends too far into the firing chamber. This will cause the lower end of the plug to become overheated, resulting in igniting the plug too early. The correct length of plug is one that the bottom of the spark plug sits flush with the inside wall of the cylinder head and the upper part extends beyond into the combustion chamber.

Front Spring Bolt.

Loose front spring bolts are responsible for a great deal of steering difficulty for which they are not blamed. When the car steers half and the steering mechanism is in good condition and properly lubricated, shaking the springs frequently reveals the cause of the trouble. Keeping the U-bolts tight keeps the spring leaves in place, helps steering, prevents spring breakage, and adds to riding comfort.

Clutch Bearings.

Clutch release bearings probably suffer more from under-lubri-

cation than from too much of it. Two service records indicate that at least some motorists make the mistake of being too generous when lubricating this fast-working part. Where the bearing is lubricated by a greasy cup the excess should remain in the cup. Grease should be turned more than one revolution at a time. Grabbing of the clutch is the common aftermath of greasing the bearing on a clutch of this kind.

The Spark.

There is a difference between the size of the sparking plug gap that correct will jump from the top side of the cylinder. When trying to locate the source of a rattles, especially in the bearings, do not grab the bumper and try to shove it up and down. Bumpers will never spring themselves that way. Just hit them gently with the hand, and if there are any loose bolts they will be sure to "belly" to you.

Typo Temperatures.

Temperature is a highly important factor in tyre wear. The higher the temperature under load, the more rapid the wear will be. At the same time, even a few degrees over can cause three times faster as the temperature doubles.

One way to prevent scoring the cylinder, especially when travelling at high speed, is to remove the foot from the accelerator from time to time. The throttle is thus closed and oil is smudged up past the piston.

Brakes squeal when the surfaces become glass smooth. Rub with a wire brush to remove the polished surface, thus avoiding the squealing and making the brakes more effective.

Trouble with a radiator ornament that will not point in the desired direction may be cured by slipping a rubber washer into the radiator cap. The setting of the washer will be facilitated by dipping the washer into water frequently.

The fitting medium or pad in an oil filter should be changed every 1000 miles, or according to the maker's instruction. Reduce interspersed any work on the generator, or to change a combination on setting a combination, one of the battery leads should be disconnected.

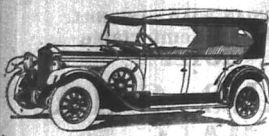

Now Resolution on an Old Subject.

END BARRER.

A number of great interests in Mombasa, Lamu, Zanzibar, the question of direct dealing with the Eastern Telegraph Company was again brought up at the week-end conference of the Association of Chambers of Commerce at Mombasa.

M. B. S. Campbell, on behalf of the Mombasa Chamber, moved the resolution—
That this Association be of opinion that in view of the settlement of the question between the Postmaster General and the Eastern Telegraph Company, the whole question should be reopened in consideration of the benefits which would accrue to the Mombasa Chamber, and the Eastern Telegraph Company.

That subject, he said, had been before the commercial community for the last few years. It was hoped that a settlement would be arrived at as to the alterations and terminal charges, but unfortunately a number of factors had intervened so that approximately £800, was the amount which passed the Government and the Eastern Telegraph Company. This matter was before a recent meeting of the Convention of Associations when a resolution was passed endorsing the one now before the Association. It was, however, that the object which the Association was desirous of attaining was either wholly or in part unattainable. The factors which had intervened, namely, the reduction of cable charges, the fact that whatever was to be agreed in this respect would be subject to the approval of the Postmaster General, and the fact that the Eastern Telegraph Company would, in any event, be bound to accept the rates to meet the conditions recently introduced by the advent of wireless communication. 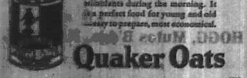

The position could so easily have been far worse" writes Dr. Claude Fuller, the South African expert who recently visited this country to investigate and advise on the locust situation.

"As a result of his observations Dr. Fuller found that on the whole there had been a marked avoidance by the insects of cultivated crops. This in conjunction with the fact that most of the crop-raising has taken place in the drier parts of the country led the expert to believe that the present invasion would prove to be of a temporary character."

Dr. Fuller urges a closer study of the species during the present visitation and emphasizes the need of concerted effort on the part of Kenya, Uganda, Tanganyika, Southern Sudan and perhaps Abyssinia, to establish a central Locust Bureau where the requirements and manifestations of locusts in the various territories should be recorded and correlated and from which advice and warnings could be issued.

The equipment which is standardized on practically all cars necessarily is extremely comprehensive for the average owner's requirements, but the owner of a sports car who desires to add to the standard fittings will find a vast wider range from which to select his equipment.

It is not possible to detail each of these specialties, but they will be dealt with generally and any of outstanding interest mentioned particularly.

The sports car owner is necessarily a well equipped car to him a great appeal. One can generally equip a range of instruments for the dashboard fitting with dials to read, and so provide a single handsome dash.

The speedometer hardly needs mentioning, one being bound to possess it, every car fitted out, but only a cheap one is likely to be chosen. It might be mentioned, however, that it is advisable to check these instruments against the stopwatch when at a certain distance, as they are often made to read artificially and so deceive the owner of the car as to its capabilities.

The tachometer which comes to mind is the revolution counter, the use of which adds considerably to the handling and control of motoring. One is better able to gauge the performance of a car by comparing the speed of the engine with that of the car by means of reading. It will be found most interesting to know the rate at which the engine is "revving" under the varying conditions met with on the road.

An important point which even very many motorists fail to appreciate is that to obtain efficient and economical running of the engine, one must pay attention to and regulate the temperature of the cooling system, particularly in the winter.

water at the degree of heat which gives best results. For this two things are needed—first, a thermometer, and, secondly, a set of radiator stopcocks, a thermostat, too, might be introduced into the cooling system, but this is rather to assist the water to warm up quickly from cold.

Types of Thermometer. With regard to thermometers, there are available two popular types of instrument for fitting into the radiator filler cap, but, in addition, there are instruments for fitting into the radiator, and connected by means of a length of capillary tubing to the receiving apparatus on the face-board.

As the temperature of the water rises the oil in the cylinder expands and this expansion is communicated to the tubing to the receiving apparatus on the face-board.

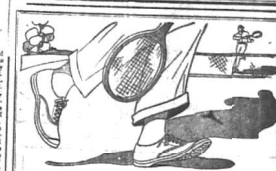
