TOPICS FOR MOTORISTS.

Early Minor Adjustments.

Valuable Hints to the New-Owner.

It is the little adjustments, easily and simply and quickly made, which go with a long way towards getting the best out of the new and prizing further, at the time when it will require overhaul or repair.

When the little adjustments are neglected, the most adjustment is certain, sooner or later to lead to more grave trouble, and may in some cases lead to extensive damage and the necessity for expensive repairs.

Particularly when the car is new should the owner take care to make the little adjustments as soon as ever they become necessary. Doing so will greatly preserve the car and its efficiency. Neglected small adjustments invariably lead to trouble, and the car is now its first few hundred miles will inevitably be followed by a working in of parts, something of pains and trouble, and maybe some loss of time or loss of money, which, if avoided at once, will not require attention, for the many hundreds of miles, since the first few hundred of miles "wear" has laid down the mechanism to wear down before "run in."

Some of the little details which should be attended to early when the car is new may be mentioned here. They will apply generally, but can vary, and will be suggested by these notes, will come in handy when the car is new, and when you should look for the things which will require adjustment.

The Wheels.

Front wheels which are of the screw-down and self-aligning type will require adjustment, and when this is likely to be the case some few hundred of miles when the car is new—they should be looked up, the way around, and

the set-screw of each after removing the nut with a screw-driver should be tightened up a little. It is usually a matter of a quarter of a turn. Between the hub and the cone should be a film of oil, and the cone should be greased with a fat or a grease or a thin layer of oil. The wheel hub should be well packed with grease or oil if of aluminium alloy, and all tightened up again.

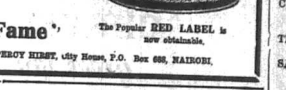

The epoch of physical fitness has long been in the air. Though similar in kind, his power of endurance is not only his, but his thinking has covered many lines on the subject.

Immigration Ordinance.

INDIAN OBJECTION TO PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

The Indian Association, Madras, has stated an objection to the proposed amendments to the Immigration Restriction Ordinance, in which the word "country" is to be replaced by "territory" and information will be made available to the local authorities as well as from private sources and the police. It is understood that information from the police source should form part of the "trusted source," as the objection made by the Indian Association, which has communicated the views to the Colonial Secretary and the Attorney General. The amendments proposed in the police being regarded as a "trusted source" because past experience has shown that Indian Evidence Act applicable to the country do not allow any material to be placed in the Public Criminal Investigation Department, who are liable to do anything they like. The present law being workable and sufficient the whole amendment is unnecessary.

Having regard to the past experience of rural mismanagement of various matters, this committee has advised the amendment with question. A provision for the right of appeal in a Court of Law is suggested.

China and Japan.

The significance of Japan's new China policy which was outlined by Hirota Zaika last July, several months after he had become head of the Japanese Government, was not generally appreciated until late in the year when China voiced a strong protest against certain Japanese demands with regard to Manchuria. The anti-Japanese agitation which followed served to emphasize the Government from the so-called "Friendship Policy" pursued by the Government since the Washington Conference, at least so far as the developing economic relations between Japan and Manchuria and Mongolia were concerned. The "Friendship Policy" drew a sharp line between Manchuria and Mongolia and China proper; it recognized Japan's special interests in the former area and openly announced Japan's intention to defend those interests at all costs. At the Washington Conference in 1921 Japan submitted to the world treaty and to the several agreements relating to China. Article 1 of the treaty provided for reciprocity and politics to be followed in matters concerning China laid down certain specific

obligations which the signatory powers, including Japan, agreed to observe. Clause 1 and 2 of the Article read as follows: "(1) To respect the sovereignty, the independence, and the territorial and administrative integrity of China. (2) To provide the fullest and most complete opportunity to China to develop and maintain for herself an effective and stable government." In carrying out these and other obligations Japan intended a new policy toward China, popularly known as the "Friendship Policy" which promised to lead to a better relationship between the two countries. In June of last year, however, Hirota Zaika called an Imperial Conference which was attended by all military and naval ministers, among others, by the Minister to Tokio and the Consul-General in Mukden and Shanghai. It was at the final session of the conference that the Premier announced that Japan's policy must differ in respect to China proper and to Manchuria and Mongolia. While the reforms for China proper will not differ materially from previous arrangements, Hirota Zaika emphasized the fact that Japan held a special position in Manchuria and Mongolia. In connection with her national defence, as well as for the maintenance of relations, it would honor itself to Japan's own position as a great nation and to keep the region free for the safe living of Chinese and foreigners by maintaining peace and order and developing economic conditions there." As to the position of Japan's special position in this area, the Government "would carry out measures not only to the occasion." Should disturbances arise endangering Japan's special interests, "Japan shall steps to protect them, no matter how they might direct the Chinese cause." Manchuria had been recognized as the danger spot of Eastern Asia. It is a land where there exists a great possibility of a civil war which would be a source of danger to the peace of the world.

Manchuria has been regarded as a buffer state against other States of Japan, a source of income and a field for overpopulation. To Japan, Manchuria means the presence of raw materials, a market for Japanese goods and the front line of defence against military aggression from the Asiatic continent. To Russia, Manchuria is the link connecting Siberia and Vladivostok; the possible port to an inland port in the East, a source of income and, until recently, a channel for the propagation of Communism. DELEGATES VIEWS.

After having the opening address of the Director of Agriculture (the Hon. Alex. Hales) and the annual report of the Chief (Grades and Inspector) Mr. Sharp both of which have been published, the session led in Nairobi was devoted to the agenda.

Mr. Tyson required it was very objection to writing of incomes and expenditure on the condition of the year to year and suggested that this be done.

Mr. Tyson suggested that there was a question of book-keeping and that the Income was not available in a separate account of the Treasury.



An Elephant's Death.

THE GOVERNOR OF UGANDA PUZZLED.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT, London, July 17. Sir William Gowers Governor of Uganda, has arrived in this country, although few people saw him. This week he wrote to The Times on an incident which occurred in the country.

Two months ago he was what I believe to be a very unusual thing—a dead elephant was found in the bush. It was not by any act of violence or accident. The carcass was a female. The animal was a young one, perhaps two years old, and about 6ft. in height. With the aid of native porters who were with me I was just able to get the body turned over and to examine the back side of it. There was no trace whatever of any external injury, nor did the animal, which had been dead not more than half an hour, appear to be in any way decomposed. The trunk of the elephant was in a position which would have been possible if it had been struck on the tip of which would have been the only place where a blow could have been inflicted. Perhaps some of your readers have seen similar cases. An elephant found dead without any obvious cause is a very rare occurrence, and I suggest some probable explanation for its death which has puzzled me greatly.

successful conclusion of the agreement to which I refer in England with the great shipping companies and the Trade Commissioner-General Manager of Bombay.

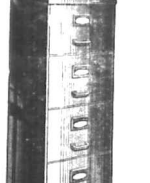
