

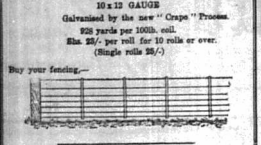

Writing in a recent issue of the "Mining and Metallurgical Magazine," of South Africa, a special editorial points out the essential differences between the copper front of the Katanga, in the Congo basin, and those of Northern Rhodesia, on the other. 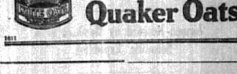

### THE FIRST BABY.

## Some Nursery Ailments.

By Helen Graham C.M.B., etc.



To the mother out of easy reach of medical assistance the problems of Nursery ailments are often a frightening one. Whether the child is teething or colicky, or whether the mother is to give over the greater sympathy, until the baby is well, she will be very anxious to do so. There are many ways in which a mother may be helped. The first baby, unless she is a recognized midwife or nurse, or from an expert like Miss Ford, whom we shall shortly be able to consult for the purpose in our own homes, or application to the Nurse Institute, Nairobi. It is a pity to lose sleep and look to worrying over some apparently alarming, but in reality quite simple, nursery problem, when a little more knowledge would rid your mind of all but the important fact.

And the mother of it, that is, that one who refers to the heading of "Nursery Ailments" in a first book is confronted with so little expert "cosmetic" doctoring (immediately)—"dismaying" account for a "teething" young one, or an outlying form. Moreover, what is difficult to convey in an article of this nature, and so, at the very beginning of it, I would urge upon every mother without exception to make full use of the facilities now offered by the Nurse Institute for help and advice on nursery problems, in interview and correspondence alike.

In the meantime the following outlines of some common nursery ailments may be of use to those whose babies worry them with symptoms they cannot always cope with.

### I. COLIC.

This is an attack of violent spasmodic pain due as a rule to flatulency brought about by errors in feeding—Constipation, diarrhoea and chilling of the body may also cause it, as may teething, and irregular food times. While with a naturally fit infant some individual health, such as the mother's part, will probably be at the root of the trouble.

Baby will wriggle, strain, draw the legs up, squint, and be distressed. abdomen. A warm saline enema (100 grs. F) should be given to relieve the pain and distension, and a drink of one or two teaspoonful of warm boiled water with a pinch of bicarbonate of soda dissolved in it. Warm flannel held on the abdomen and a well-padded hot bottle at the feet, will probably ease the pain and send baby to sleep.

He should be under observation as a mother's touch, or have his diet varied by an expert after an attack the best to ascertain the cause of the trouble and prevent its recurrence.

### II. CONSTIPATION.

This is a most misnamed term, and is often applied to peristalsis, and is a condition which is formed motion that entails some discomfort on a baby's part, or even pain. It is not, as the name implies, a condition of the bowels, but of the condition is perfectly satisfactory.

The same applies to the naturally fit infant who passes a normal motion once in 48 hours, and is not so fastidious, as the condition is perfectly normal, and due to nothing more serious than laxation through orange juice and water, and is a condition of the legs at bed time, to try and find regularity. The number of these two cases however can be easily estimated.

The occupation is associated with discomfort, and probably relief is found in baby's part, the stools being hard and passed with real difficulty.

The cause will almost certainly be a wrongly balanced food, or the use of "Milk-replacer" by Miss Liddiard, and "Feeding and Care of Baby" by Sir F. Trendelenburg, excellent tables for the preparation of milk mixtures for babies will be found, which will be found, which will be found, which will be found.

It is, however, and artificially fed infants in normal health. The cause is usually a common cause of constipation, but excess will also tend to increase the fat percentage in a constipated infant. (Half a teaspoonful of juice in an equal quantity of boiled water should be given at a month, 3/4 at two months, and 1 at a year.)

finger for a few minutes every morning, (beginning at the nose, working up and across under the chin, and then down the side and so on, missing the space in front over the larynx) should be applied. Regular daily training, exercise, extra water, and fresh fruit juice, are most satisfactory weapons with which to defeat this nursery problem.

For a baby who has been allowed to become really constipated, a small gum syringe may be used, (or a No. 12 rubber catheter like attached to the nozzle of a Higginson's syringe) to inject one or two ounces of normal saline at blood heat, gently into the bowel, or an ounce of warm water if it may be used, but not soap water which is too irritating. Normal saline is made by adding one teaspoonful of salt to a pint of boiled water it should be used fresh.

Large apparatuses are inadvisable unless good rubber fitted syringe (such as catlin's) is used, and the open very carefully rounded— a better plan is to use the No. 12 rubber catheter dipped in warm oil, and inserted into the rectum, very gently into the rectum to the depth of 2 inches.

Medical advice should always be sought in a case of persistent constipation—hundreds of people are going about today with quite constitutions very much deteriorated, and with purgatives they were treated.

### III. CONVULSIONS.

These are perhaps the most terrifying of all nursery ailments and are almost always due to a divided to their actual danger to life, there can be no doubt that every attack is more likely than the last to inflict permanent damage to the nervous system, and every effort should be made to prevent their recurrence.

The advent of the tractor in this country has done much to lessen the importance of the ox as a draught animal, and many farmers are still, however, and must be a very important factor in the development of the country.

The use of oxen for ploughing and transport, though the oxen are not so much used as in former times, is still a feature of many farms through the lack of knowledge in selecting and handling them. The object of the following notes is to help young farmers beginning in this country in choosing and training animals.

**Appearance and Legality.**

Animals should be chosen from a higher altitude and from a district near the locality where they are to be worked in, if possible, as they thrive better than those brought from a lower altitude and a distance, which have to be acclimated before being used for hard work.

should be hairy long, broad and curved, and tapering off to the tail. The line of the back should be a gentle slope from the hindquarters to the hump.

The hindquarters should be large and well rounded. A young ox will show wrinkles of fat under the tail.

**Colour.**

Red oxen are usually considered the best, as they retain the head better than most other animals. Black oxen are difficult to handle.

The colour should be good, not watery or weak.

Both black and white are more susceptible to some ticks. Animals with large horns growing straight out are more difficult to handle than animals with horns curved upward.

**Training.**

An ox should not be trained until he is about four years old. There are several methods employed in training oxen.

The animal is caught and a rope is fastened to the horns and fastened lightly. Care should be taken to fasten it tight enough to prevent him from slipping off over the horns, but not too tight, as it will cut into the flesh, and oxen which are extremely hard to deal with are the result because their horns are difficult to handle. The rope should be kept on until the animal is fully trained.

The animal is then fastened in a yoke beside a well trained ox and the rein on the ox in front of him. A new ox should be fastened in about the third or fourth pair from the front of the train.

If on his line down, the team should be whipped immediately as otherwise he is liable to be strong.

led. An animal that occasionally gives in to a strong force will be yoked or directly the team leader. The ox should be fastened in a yoke beside a well trained ox and the rein on the ox in front of him. A new ox should be fastened in about the third or fourth pair from the front of the train.

Young oxen as first will generally stand with all four legs spread out and firmly planted on the ground and refuse to move until they are forced to do so. It is in this position that they will make a dash forward and attempt to break away, but gradually as they become trained they will settle down and walk quietly. Most oxen do not pull at first, but lag back and horns be made to get up into the yoke.

It is important to teach an animal at this stage that he has got to pull or he will probably learn that he can hang back and just walk along quietly. One animal in a team will show considerable more work than all the rest. This is if his span was not there.

An ox should be trained on the side of the wagon or plough as he should not be considered trained until he will go together with the yoke without being handled.

Another method employed in training oxen is to fasten two smaller animals similar in build and possible in colour, and they should always be worked together. The reins are fastened round the necks of the animals, and they are accustomed to being fastened together, they are then put into a yoke and allowed to run for a few days, when they may be have yoked down. A yoked ox should always be in charge of him by seeing that they do not get tied up in anything and strangled.

**Insapping.**

The frog gear should be fastened on a break of the wagon or plough in the following manner. The hook of the rope chain should be passed through the staple on the yoke of the ox on the plough, and the hook of each of the other chains placed in the ring of the chain immediately following it. The yokes should be set at right angles to the shafts. The reins should be fastened to the rings of the shafts and the reins of the shafts fastened to the rings of the shafts by a short neck of iron.

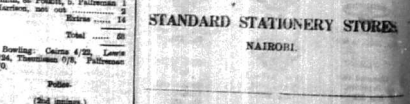

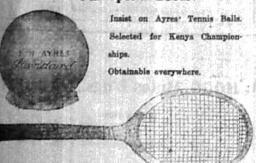

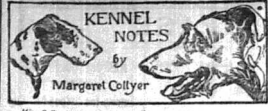

### MR. SHAW ADDRESSES CHIEF CONSTABLES

"Never Driven Without Breaking the Law."

COMMUNIST ADVISER.

Mr. George Bernard Shaw has in his last lecture when addressing the Association of Chief Constables in Harrogate, the chief constables of each constabulary officer, Mr. Bernard Shaw had something to say about traffic regulations; the thousands of women into the ranks of the constabulary and the constabulary of girls.

"I have been driven," he said, "in my own car, and I have driven certainly a good deal over a hundred thousand miles in that time. By the way, I hope everything I say here will not be used against me on any occasion without breaking the law—laughter)—and I often thought that a dreadful thing it must be to be a chief constable and be obliged by your position never to exceed the limit. I keep mine down and always having I keep mine down, miles an hour.

#### Once Prosecuted.

"In all those twenty years I have been prosecuted only once. I was informed that I had passed through a police net at a speed of 27 miles an hour. Well, there was no question, no room for argument. The fact remains that I was perfectly civil to any soldier. They got my name, because when constabulary were very pleased when they got my name, because they knew they would be in the papers. I was greatly pleased because what came into my hand was 'Well, it's a mercy they did not catch me half an hour ago when I was driving at 45.' Had the charge been one of driving to the public danger, they would have passed from the region of fact to the region of opinion, and that was where the chief constable found all his troubles—and the sensible and protest and letters to the papers.

#### Constabulary Life.

Mr. Shaw spoke of police personal change. "When I was a constable, about 70 years ago," he said, "there was a village I went which was supposed to be managed by a police officer, and it bothered the man who takes to prison him who steals what isn't his." Fifty years elapsed from that

time of the song and another young because popular—"I've got to know the time and the policeman." The entire conception of police that we had, and what were some "That soldier" might be a learned "Well, the workers." There were now some 100,000 men in the constabulary. "I think nothing would amount; yet there is no doubt that it is a development which is going to be of great importance, and we will probably presently have women police everywhere, as we have had in the moment they get into a phase which is a woman's world, and have to be allowed to measure it for the years of our private life. I am by no means sure that in another 50 years we shall have a constabulary of women, but I do not think it is not so certain as it is of the ladies.

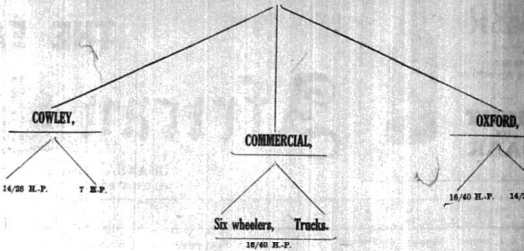
Mr. Shaw said the chief constabulary organization was one of the most important in the country, and had he been asked to address the House of Lords, he was not certain he would take the time. Throughout his speech he showed and their position. He was once in jail, to a woman of one of the authors of England, he was one of the "patriotic authors, and journalists." If he were to commit a crime, the next day they would see in the paper "Bernard Shaw, constable of number, or burglary, or whatever it was, or if it were a more trivial crime it might be 'O.B.S.' It would not say 'Author and the constable, but supposing a chief constable made a mistake this mistake or crime was always said to be committed by the police.

#### Membership of Plays.

Mr. Shaw advised the chief constables to read all the pamphlets to get upon them the responsibility of membership of plays. It would give them a frightful lot of trouble and from time to time they should not be done locally, but should be done by the Public Prosecutor.

A final word about films and a reference to "Pact" contained a threat at Whitehall. "The speaker," said Mr. Shaw, "that the film 'There is nothing to be done' is a wonderful thing, with the assistance of a great English actress, does bring home to people that above all the regulations you owe to your own country. There is something higher, and that is the law of God. Our military authorities are not to be taken into the We O.B.S., but on week days they greatly disliked people being reminded that there was anything to do with the War Office. 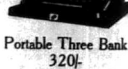

### TRIAL BY JURY IN SOUTH AFRICA.

#### Alleged Misarrangements of Justice.

#### FRESH COMMENT.

A South African newspaper of the "Manchester Guardian," commenting on the trial of the justice in black and white cases in the Union.

A few months ago there was a report of a misarrangement of justice between black and white in South Africa. A Zimpson was accused of the murder of an old and infirm white, and the verdict was given in face of evidence so over-whelming that the judge, in dismissing the prisoner, felt com- pelled to dissent in the strongest terms from the jury's finding.

And now there comes from the same Circuit Court of the Northern Transvaal an even wiser story. Two persons (young men) were convicted of about eleven years' imprisonment by a famous named Jury in the District of Louis Trichardt.

The body of one of them was found floating under an outcrop, and his death, it is said, was caused by a blow from a stone which was thrown by Ross and his brother.

After a preliminary examination, the magistrate, the two brothers were committed for trial on a charge of murder.

Juryman Challenged.

At the trial the two accused were defended by a distinguished King's Counsel, who has before now been tried in Pretoria Courts of appeal. The case opened with the defence challenging on more than six of the twelve jurymen, who had accordingly to be replaced. There has been considerable comment on the fact that the composition of the murdered boy was the only crown witness called. There was no medical evidence as to the cause of death, and no evidence taken from other witnesses in Ross's camp or to this man's treatment of the prisoner before the latter's death.

The story told by the surviving prisoner was about but quite definite. The dead boy had been employed by Ross at a salary of six shillings monthly, plus the usual native rations, but had been neglected and ill-treated, and it is frequently said. Ross and his brother then moved the two boys to a court and overtook them. The boy whose

body was subsequently found was tied to a tree and his legs were severed that death resulted. "They hit to kill," said his companion quite definitely. The boy had then to submit to a grueling cross-examination. It is scarcely surprising that in face of this bit of evidence, as the law has to mount evidence, the jury found guilty.

The story told by him in the magistrate's court differed in important details from his later evidence, called on to retract to give the relative position of the cart, his hand, the dead boy and the blow broken in because surprised and wanted to get away from the justice. He had then to get the stone, in fact, he was sent away and had him by de- feating counsel.

Common Assail.

At the conclusion of the ex-amination it was clear that the case for the prosecution had broken down. The Crown pro-secution and the defence coun- cils conferred, and as a result the charge of murder was with- drawn and the accused agreed to plead guilty to a charge of com- mon assault. They admitted their guilt and the judge, who had shown death must now remain a mystery. Five of £20 and 200 years' indicated. Comment, though there has been much of it in the Press and elsewhere, is needless. The "Johnsburg Star" con- tains a leading article on the case with the following views:

"The verdict of this common assauld had been a European child and the accused native, would the trial have been conducted as this case is and would the guilty men have been given the option of a fine or imprisonment which to pay it? It is not as though the Louis Trichardt case was a rare occurrence. Similar offences have become frequent within recent years, and have attracted less public protest than at any time during the past forty or fifty years.

"To the credit of South Africa it should be added that the case has been the public conscience a bad thing. Many years ago it was recognized that to try a native by a jury of white farmers was a gross injustice, and native law courts were the only means of settling such cases. It is a pity that the trial by a judge with two magistrate sitting as assessors. This option it is needless to say, is rarely exercised. But it is when a white man is charged with an offence against a native that we get such happenings as that at Louis Tri- chardt. To submit trial by jury in such cases would not remove all the evil, but it would go far towards doing so, and it is this which the native leaders are con- stantly demanding.

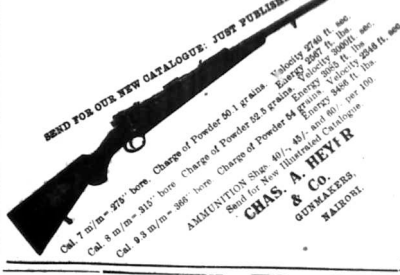
#### New workers Not Allowed to Bear Arms.

The principle of sex equality has been carried out in some States that under an military law, according to a correspondent in Moscow, requires the duty of de- fending the country on all occa- sions, including women, but has done that only in a limited way. The principle of sex equality will be allowed to bear arms. New- workers are to be limited into labour detachments, to carry out the work at the rear of the armies. The new law provides both sexes within the range of general mili- tary training.

Meanwhile, France Comman- dant Warren, of New York, ex- pressed the opinion that the utility of women police is limited to certain fields. Consequently, he has indicated to increase the number of women in the city's police force who at present num- ber 116, or sixteen per cent of the total force. He has suggested that 2,500 to 4,000 yearly only about 50 of them are engaged in various duties, while the others are occupied in duties usually carried out by men. He would like to see the number of women Police Commissioner Warren be- lieves cannot be increased.

As a result of a session by the Mayor's committee, however, Mr. Wilson has ordered the com- mander Warren to fill up the va- cancies in the Women Police Force.

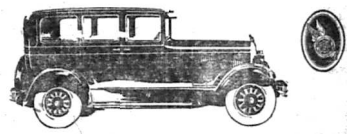

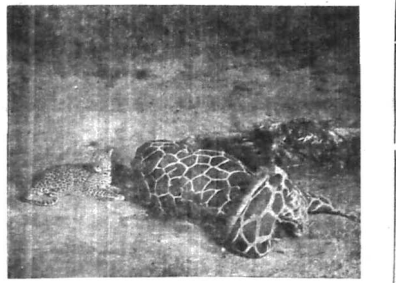

## EXPEDITION TO STUDY ZIMBABWE RUINS.

Search for a Hidden Temple.

### THREE WOMEN IN PARTY.

## Lacerna Hay.

### WINDOW CUTTING METHOD IN MICHIGAN, U.S.A.

A modification in the method of converting lacera into hay is being practiced in Michigan, U.S.A. The advantages claimed for the method are: (1) To save a large amount of labor in the cutting of the hay; (2) To produce a more attractive to the buyer of hay and therefore payable to livestock; (3) To get the hay cut and baled in one operation.

The time of cutting is, of course, prime importance. In Michigan it is advised that hay be cut when the sun is out for two or three hours and the ground is not too dry.

The method is very simple and requires a complete line of modern hay-making tools is available. The cutting is done by a machine which cuts the hay in bundles from swath to swath by machinery.

It is also noted that the plants are cut from the sun or rain immediately after the hay is cut out below it has withered to a certain extent and is ready for the windrow, using the roller-hay method. The hay is then baled in one operation.

In conclusion Dr. Pringle said that he had learned a great deal from his expedition and that he would be glad to share his findings with the public.

When mowing, in driving the rake in that direction, against the heads of the leaves are put to the blade of the rake and come out that way down to the opposite direction. Furthermore, the rake is driven so that the hay will be cut on the right hand rake even when the rake is driven in the same direction as when mowing. The right hand rake will therefore cut an satisfactory job of raking.

With the hay thus raked into windrows, it is then cut by a mower. Furthermore, the heads of the leaves being made the window are protected from the burning effect of the sun. Another advantage is that the hay is kept of the ground when the sun is out and heavy hay it will be necessary to cut the hay in two or three rows with the rake in one row at the top and side bay has curved. This with the rake lowers up the windrow, instead of being cut and beat of many of the leaves with the windrow, which means that the hay will suffer for perfect curing.

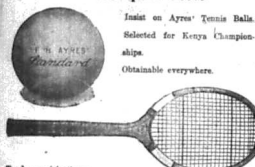

**INCREASE OF "EMPIRE" SMOKING.**

Imperial Economic Committee's Report.

PIPE AND CIGARETTES

The expansion of the world's consumption of tobacco products has led to a decline in popularity of pipe smoking, the statistics show, the smoking pipe tobacco and the general reputation of the main pipe tobacco in the world are among the main points described by the Imperial Economic Committee in their "Tobacco" Report published recently by H.M. Stationery Office (Price 1/6).

The problem facing those responsible for the future of pipe tobacco trade receive little attention in the survey.

In 1921, states the Report, the total tobacco imported into the United Kingdom and in 1927 the figure had risen to 184 per cent. It is estimated that 37 per cent of the pipe tobacco consumed in the United Kingdom in 1927 consisted of Empire leaf, but only slightly over 1 per cent of that of cigarette tobacco. Over 150 brands of Empire pipe tobacco and 40 in the case of Empire cigarettes have been placed on the British market.

While in 1914 the output of pipe tobacco in the United Kingdom was 24 per cent of the population in 1927, 34 per cent were consumed, indicating a rapid increase due, undoubtedly to the extension of the cigarette habit and to smoking on the part of women.

Roughly comparable statistics for other countries were not obtainable, but it has been estimated that in 1926 Belgium's consumption was 4.9 per cent of the output, U.S.A. 6.02 per cent and Germany's 1.18 per cent.

A striking feature in the United Kingdom has been the change in recent years from pipes to cigarettes. In 1907 cigarettes accounted for 28.8 per cent of the total, as against 71.1 per cent pipe tobacco and 0.1 per cent cigars. In 1924 cigarettes had increased to 58.2 per cent, pipe and cigars to 39.4 per cent and 1.5 per cent respectively.

For the evidence we have received from other sources, the Committee adds, it is to the effect that the trend in cigarette smoking has continued since 1924 and witnesses considered that pipe tobacco now accounts for only one quarter of the consumption in the

United Kingdom. It is, we think, probable that pipe tobacco does not now form more than 25 per cent of the total tobacco consumption of the United Kingdom.

The advance of the cigarette as a popular form of smoking is not confined to the United Kingdom. Throughout Europe consumption now inclines towards cigarettes and the similar consumption of pipe tobacco is declining.

Even in Germany where pipe tobacco consumption has shown a marked increase in the consumption of cigarettes and cigars has declined. In the United States, pipe and cigars account for 11 per cent of the consumption but the proportion of cigarettes is increasing. Even in India, an old consumption of cigarettes compared with an annual figure of somewhat under 1,000 million.

The cigarette is thus at the head of the parade in world consumption, favored by the consumption power which is highest in the United Kingdom.

**World Production.**

The position of world supplies receives full analysis.

For the years 1926 to 1928 the average annual world production of leaf, including India and China was estimated, states the Imperial Economic Committee at 2,360 million lbs. For the year 1929 it is computed that 2,415 million lbs. of tobacco leaf were produced. Unfortunately equivalent figures for the other years are not available for India and China, for which two countries the crop in 1926 was estimated at 1,425 million lbs. If this quantity be included the total production of tobacco in the world in 1926 was 4,000 million lbs. The United States of America and the British Empire produced approximately half of this world total.

Empire countries contributing to this quota were, in the order of their output, India, Canada, Union of South Africa, Southern Rhodesia, New Zealand, Northern Rhodesia, Australia and Cyprus.

In the international trade in tobacco the Empire does not, however, occupy such a prominent position as the quantity of its production would suggest, for some of the countries which are the largest producers of tobacco are also the largest consumers. This is the case with the United States, China, U.S.S.R., the world output of 2,415 million tons of 4,000 million lbs. of tobacco, the total world production. Over three-fourths of the output of the United States (30 per cent of the total), the Dutch East Indies and the Balkans (each 10 per cent) and Brazil (8 per cent). The con-

tribution of the whole of the British Empire was only about 4 per cent.

**Empire Consumption.**

Whereas the Empire only supplied 18 million tons of the 228 million tons of tobacco consumed in the United Kingdom in 1927, the total Empire consumption in 1927 was 222 million tons. Further, while only 10 per cent of the seven and half million lbs. of Empire tobacco imported in 1921 was now drawn from the United States and British North Borneo, whereas in 1927 these had raised their consumption from 10 million lbs. to the imports from Rhodesia, 10 million lbs. and Belgium, 10 million lbs. respectively.

Between 1920 and 1924 the consumption of Empire tobacco in the United Kingdom at a rate of 1,000,000 lbs. rose to 1,200,000 lbs. and in 1927 at a rate of 2,000,000 lbs. a year. Empire tobacco in 1927 was against 22,700,000 lbs. in 1927.

No notice, the Committee continued, that given on the part of the producers increased experience in production, strict attention to the quality of the crop and the requirements of the British market, and given, on the side of the consumers, and British public, solid support for the Empire product to a still greater degree of increase would be obtainable.

Always in virtue of the newer countries of the Empire, such as Southern Rhodesia and Nyasaland, the cultivation of tobacco is becoming more and more being the mainstay of farming and, therefore, less outlaid.

**Free Storage.**

Notice is given in the current issue of the "Tobacco Official Gazette" that the free storage period on the export side of the Empire has been extended to 180 days and, on the import side, to 90 days. 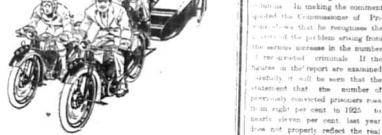
