**Native Registration.**  
**A BETTER SYSTEM FOR**  
**(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.)**  
Nairobi, Nov. 27

An arrangement has been made between the Police and the Native Registration Department whereby all matters relating to Native Registration will now be dealt with at Nairobi. Heretofore the Police had to deal with all matters in addition to the police duties (which they are now) and the Native Registration Department.

This system was thoroughly well received by the Native Registration Department. Employees could not attend the Police station and they could go if sent, and those who did make their way to the station usually found the policeman on patrol, investigating a case or attending court. The virtue of his calling a policeman to deal with such work is that the prevention and detection of crime has no first claim on his services. The result of this system was that the native often being absent for a day or so off at his employer's expense and then often returning without anything having been done.

Work from the Native Registration Department will be attended at the Police Station during the second and fourth Mondays and Tuesdays in each month with special officers such as finger printers and removal of specimens and such other certificates will be dealt with.

**Cruelty to Animals.**

KENYA CROP PROSPECTS.

Estimated Yields of Wheat, Maize and Coffee.

THE EXPORT SURPLUSES.

The Stationary to the Agricultural Department has issued the following:

A scrutiny of Correspondents' estimates for the month of October discloses little change in the position as compared with the September returns, with the exception of Maize, which shows a decrease on the aggregate of 11,723 bags. This decrease is partly due to over-estimating by Correspondents on August and September, but is mainly accounted for by the Trans-Nova figure having been reduced by 37,253 bags owing to losses by 'Hag' and excessive rain during harvesting. Further losses, due to drought and locusts, are also reported from Nakuru District. The estimated production of 14,700 bags is forecasted in the October report. This is due to 'shorts runs' occurring in the Machakos District and improved yields having been reported from Nakuru District.

With the exception of slight increases in the estimates from Kiambu and Kericho districts, and a slight falling off in Trans-Nova, the coffee figures remain practically the same as those quoted in the September estimate and the export figure of 170,000 cwts. for the year remains unaltered. Weather conditions throughout the Colony have been good, with the exception of the Trans-Nova where, in parts, excessive rain fell. A general rainfall occurred in most districts towards the end of the month, and already offerings are recovering from the effects of the drought conditions which prevailed earlier in the year, and in pastoral districts pasture lands have already improved considerably.

Kiambu.

Locusts are reported to be still in this District, but caused little damage to crops. Good rains fell during the month. A small decrease in the Maize crop is forecasted, otherwise the yields estimated in September remain unchanged.

Fort Hall.

Very good rains occurred towards the end of the month and a heavy

hazy bloom is reported to be appearing on the coffee trees. The September estimate of the coffee yield for the present season remains unchanged at an estimated 24,200 cwts, i.e. 0.78 per cent below that of the previous season.

Kericho.

The picking of coffee has now commenced. A high increase in the September estimate is indicated and a total yield of 10,150 cwts is now forecasted. Good rains occurred during the latter part of the month and trees are beginning to show signs of recovery from the effects of drought.

Machakos.

A 10 per cent increase in the coffee yield is compared with September is estimated, and a total yield of 10,600 cwts is now anticipated. Good heavy rains are reported to have caused loss but now appear to be under control.

Nakuru.

Good rains are reported from this District and extensive sowings of Wheat are now being made. The coffee crop is reported as being poor and the output for the District reduced to 2750 cwts.

Trans-Nova.

The harvesting of maize in this district is now almost completed and an average yield of 12 1/2 bush per acre, giving a total production of 35,000 bags, is forecasted. The September estimates of Wheat and Coffee remain unchanged.

Lalapa.

Droughty conditions continued until the end of the month when good rains occurred. No change in the September estimates of crops are reported.

Narawa.

Locusts and drought are reported to have caused further losses in the Wheat crop which is now estimated at 11,457 bags, as compared with

the September estimate of 10,000 bags. The bulk of the loss is in the east part of the month but increased with the commencement of the crop after rain in the month end.

Nairobi.

Further losses in the Maize crop due to drought and locusts are reported and the total yield of 20,000 bags is estimated for the District, a decrease of 17,644 bags as compared with the September estimate. An average Wheat yield of 8 1/2 bush per acre, giving a total production of 10,000 bags, is forecasted in the September estimate.

Siaya.

No noteworthy change in the yields of the crops is reported. Good rains have fallen and some Wheat has been sown.

Trans-Nova.

Excessive rains have occurred in certain parts of the District, and caused considerable loss in the Maize crop, while slight rain is reported to have caused some loss in Maize. The estimate of coffee has decreased slightly, and is now given at 1,400 cwts, as compared with 10,000 cwts in September.

Uasin Gishu.

The harvesting of Maize has now begun in this District, and a yield of 2 1/2 bush per acre, at a total of 37,200 bags is now estimated. High winds in the Wheat crop forecasted and a total production of 30,222 bags as compared with 28,100 bags in September is estimated. Rain is reported to have damaged crops slightly. Good rains fell during the month.

Wakamba.

Summary of crop reports (Native harvesters). Although several stores occurred in the month there has been insufficient rain to secure a satisfactory maize harvest. The coffee crop of Malindi has been picked. It is of good quality, and there is little evidence of disease or pests. Young in the future of this crop from the crop, is much smaller than that originally estimated, the total being now estimated at 100,000 cwts. Public opinion remains very favourable, a serious shortage of food stuffs at the end of the year is expected. No planting has yet been undertaken in the Trans-Nova District.

South Kenya Reserve.

Harvesting is now completed in the low rainfall zone. Some of the crops are under average, but a surplus of grain will be available. Planting is still in full swing.

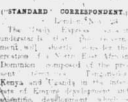

## The Tribes of Kenya.

### Origin of the Nandi and the Mystery of the Sirikwa.

Following is the first of a brief series of articles on some of the pastoral and hunting tribes of Kenya. Their religious beliefs and their customs.

(Special to the "E.A. Standard" by G. W. B. Huntingford, F.R.A.S.)

If you look on a map of Kenya, you will see two main groups of 170,000 nomads of a diverse but related race, scattered mainly north and south. The western is the Nandi, who live in the Kilimanjaro hills, and the eastern is the Sirikwa, who live in the Masai country on the equator, and from where the Masai movement goes off in a westerly direction.

This country of nomads is the home of a group of pastoral tribes of which everybody knows the names of at least two—the Nandi and the Masai. This grouping is more correct than the usual Masai. Of course the Masai do not live there now, but two sections, the Il-Dun-Dun (the "striped cattle") and the Akikipki (the "black cattle"), did live there 20 to 30 years ago. "Pastors" bring some those whose chief interest is in cattle, and who do not practice agriculture. The most important pastoral people in this country belong to a race called Nil-Hamitic, though there are Hamite cattle tribes; but we are not concerned with them now, as we have no knowledge of them as the Avelones or Kish of North East Africa.

Nil-Hamitic means that their forefathers were partly Nilotic (like the Luo of Kenia, and the Dinka in the Sudan), and partly Hamitic. The only Hamitic tribe now living in Eastern Africa is the Oka of Southern Abyssinia. This Nil-Hamitic race has two branches in Kenya—the Nandi and the Masai. In both, the Nilotic element is much stronger than the Hamitic, though I think the Masai branch has more of the Hamite in it than the Nandi.

**THE NANDI.**  
It is of the Nandi branch that I wish to write. There are numerous kinds of them, but only a few

of the Nandi, who are not related to the Nandi, though they all speak a dialect of Nandi. These tribes fall into five groups, and are classified according to their language, which are dialects of Nandi. The names of the tribes are:

1. SUK GROUP.
  1. The Ensope, of Mt. Delon, in Uganda.
  2. A tribe on Mt. Morosi, in Uganda.
  3. A tribe on Mt. Kamungu, in Uganda.
2. The "Pikwa" or "Pik" in Kenya.
3. The Kikwa or To
4. The Marakwet
5. The Masai

6. ELGON GROUP (ALL ON MT. ELGON).
  6. The T-Koyi, Kony, or Egeyo, of the Pigi or Laha.
  7. The Kipsirok, Sapei, Sapei, or "Sapei."
  8. The Masai.
  9. The Nandi.
  10. The Sirikwa.
7. KANAWA GROUP (KANAWA SCARF-PATTERN).
  11. The Tuku or Kigonyo.
  12. The "Kakum."
8. KIPSIKI GROUP.
  13. The Kipsiki or "Lambwe."
  14. The Turk, amongst the Nyak, between Nandi and Kikuyu.
  15. This is pronounced like the "ng" in "wenger."
9. NANDI GROUP.
  16. The Kevu or "Egeyo."
  17. The Nandi or "Ghomwa."

**TRADITION.**  
Knowing the names of the tribes, we can try to make out something of their history. Needless to say, we have no written records to go by, but only tradi-

tion, and the evidence of language and the names of places, and other things. The Nandi and the Masai came into Kenya from the north east, probably from somewhere on the "Nile" in the Southern Sudan; the Masai branch came by Lake Bahr. The Nandi in their westward journey reached a hill called Kamungu, 60 miles N.W. of Elgon, and halted there, according to a tradition of the hills in the Eastern Province of Uganda—namely at Lake Morosi, Morosi, Lohopoi, Lohoyi—must have been occupied, and there as well the remnant of a tribe on Delon, and Kamungu and Morosi were inhabited 20 years ago.

**ELGON SETTLEMENT.**  
However, the main body settled on Elgon, where they split up, and went off in various directions. First the ancestors of the Suk group went to the east of Elgon, later the Kanawas went to the east of the Elgony escarpment—perhaps there were already Hamites in Lushaka, who stopped them from going further eastward. They were settled on the west side of the Rift Valley. Another set of the Nandi, who were applied to people who have taken up agriculture, and really belong to the Kipsiki, who sell themselves Turk, settled on the west of the Masai, after the partition of the Nandi tribe, and merged with the Hamite in that part of the group stayed on Elgon, and are still there.

# Strains on Tyres.

One of the most vital, yet most abused, parts of a car is the tyre. Motorists who often take the best of care of their car, mechanically, many times fail to slow the process of amount of thought for those tyres. The result is that they do not give the same amount of mileage that they would give if proper attention had been paid to them.

To get down to the factors that cause tyre wear, it is necessary to look at the changed driving conditions that exist today.

There has been a tremendous change since 1920, because of the design that make motoring more enjoyable than ever before. One of the most important is those powerful motors that make high-speed driving natural and easy. The public in U.S.A. has become so accustomed to the performance of these new power-plants that the average speed on the open road is at least 15 miles an hour higher than it was three years ago. Then, from 25 to 35 miles an hour was the average speed outside of traffic. Now it is from 35 to 50 miles an hour.

When a car is driven at high speed, it runs a great deal more from side to side of the road. This is to be expected for certain buyers to know that standard tyres that will deliver a certain mileage at 35 miles an hour will give about half that mileage at an average speed of 45 miles an hour under the same road conditions and temperature. An increase of 10 miles an hour will approximately double the rate of tread wear between 30 and 50 miles per hour. Temperature is a most important factor in tyre tread wear.

higher the temperature under which tyres are operated, the more rapid the wear will be. A glance at the following table strikingly illustrates the fact and on other items of interest is that at the average speed, tread wear on three times faster motor will be approximately 60 per cent more mileage than on standard tyre to wear 10,000 miles at 20 miles per hour average speed. The same degree average temperature, the tread wear is affected by temperature as follows:

Temperature 20 m. ph. 40 m. ph.	Tread Wear
40	10,000 2,000
60	5,000 3,000
80	2,500 2,000
100	2,000 1,200

From the table it can readily be seen that the more the heat the less miles of wear; while the more speed the less miles of wear. Thus the two elements of tyre life car gets either the wheel bearings wear, the axle nuts, steering gear connections wear and the wheel pitch and rest, absorbing some wear—these will therefore be affected.

**Dry Weather.**

The trend of the times is definitely toward high speed motors and higher-powered motors. Drivers make high speed runs more and more. The conservative motorist who keeps to a 25 mile average speed should secure at least three times the tyre mileage that will be delivered at 45 miles or higher.

In and of wet weather, the rate of tyre tread wear is slow.

but in hot dry weather the rate increases rapidly. This is to be borne out by the fact that in the northern section of the United States an average standard tyre will deliver approximately 60 per cent more mileage than on standard tyre as operated in the Southern States.

Traffic conditions are also responsible for heavy wear on tyre. Of course traffic under the conditions of the world over, yet as transportation increases the problems of an overloaded road are the problem of an overloaded road.

The last official registration figure for the United States showed the number of cars in the States at over 21,000,000. That means that in most cities of any size there are equal systems for the control of vehicle traffic. As a natural result, there has been an increase in the number of starts and stops necessitated when driving in cities, and this type of operation has an impact bearing on the rate of tyre wear.

A car driven at a 35 mile per hour speed, stopped every quarter of a mile without altering the wheels and then accelerated again to 35 miles per hour, will wear away one-half of the tread design at about 100 miles. If the sharp corners the same car driven at 35 miles an hour but stopped only every mile but a few feet being accelerated to that speed, will wear half the tyre tread every 50 miles or about 3,000 miles.

Only a few years ago, when a motorist driving at 20 miles per hour anticipated a stop, he had to allow about 200 feet in which to do it. Now powerful horsepower brakes stop a car immediately. At times the speed of other years a car is halted in half the distance formerly required. Even two-

wheel brakes are much more powerful than ever before. Care can be stopped quickly enough—there is no question about that. However, tyre under the corner, causing excessive and unequal wear on the same tyre, and spreading the rubber as it slips.

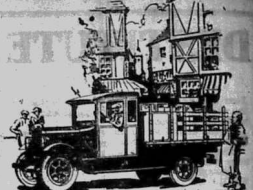
**New Design has Its Effects.**

Clearly allied with this condition is the new car design that gives a lower center of gravity. This permits higher open road speeds because the car holds the road better. It also allows cars to be taken at high speeds with less danger of turning over. But the conservative driver who has regard for the number of miles he wants his car to go before he takes the curve at normal average speed.

Poorly adjusted brakes of any type are big factors in tyre wear. Because the brakes are not equalized the car comes to an uneven or lumpy stop, with one or more wheels dragging while others are still moving. This means terrific scuffing or abrasion action on the tyre tread and soon wears down a tyre. It is estimated that 90 per cent of the cars that have broken up in 18 miles are poorly equipped. One having this fault should be repaired or replaced to immediately if tyre mileage is to be secured, and operators should be advised.

Four-wheel brakes must be adjusted perfectly so that no one tyre will wear more than another. If they are not properly adjusted or one tyre will take most of the strain and wear faster than the other.

There is a very real test for determining properly adjusted brakes covered with a standard brake covering machine.

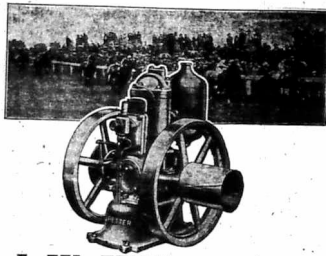

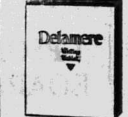
