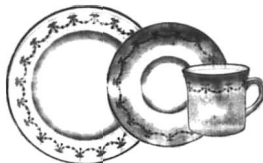

Big Fight at Seres.

BULGARIANS BEATEN BACK BY GREEKS.

Reporter's Special to "E. A. Standard."

The Times correspondent at Salonica reports that the Bulgarians have been repulsed by the Greeks at Seres, which is 100 miles from the Salonica-Constantinople railway, to the North east of Salonica.

The official dispatches show that the fighting at Seres between the Greeks and the Bulgarians has been very serious as there are numerous casualties on both sides.

The Governments of the two countries are taking steps to investigate on the spot.

Later the "Times" correspondent at Salonica reports that the fighting at Seres has continued throughout Friday, the 14th. The Bulgarians retreated during the night and the Greek forces which led the 7th. The Greeks pursued them during the night and the Bulgarians were behind the village for 120 were captured.

The Greek losses were 15 killed and 20 wounded.

MILITATION ACCEPTED.

Reporter's agent at Sofia reports the committee of the "B.C." has decided to have accepted the offer of mediation by the Powers on the basis of the conditions which were laid down in London plus an indemnity.

London March 13. Reporter's agent at Sofia reports the reply of the Allies to the note of the Powers offered.

The Allies' condition is that the line of the Bosphorus-Turkish frontier should be a line from Medya to the Black Sea coast to the Bosphorus.

The assent of all concerned territories is behind this line with the exception of that territory, since the assent of the Powers is a war indemnity.

Canadian Navy Bill.
THE GOVERNMENT'S DETERMINED ATTITUDE.

Ottawa, March 17. Premier Borden, in reply to the resolution of the British Columbia on his naval policy, says that the Government are firmly determined to give their proposals a conclusion, notwithstanding the unwelcome observations which a view to cancelling the observations against the Navy Bill the Government has indicated that they intend to withdraw the clause concerning the construction of the ships under consideration. During Friday night the 14th inst. the Government secured majority on points of order they raised against the opposition.

The chairman at the instance of Premier Borden ruled both Mr. Wilford Laurier's amendments out of order on the ground that the bill has received the assent of the Queen.

The opposition then moved that the Chairman leave the chair. This was debated with the courtesy of Premier Borden the House rose at eleven on Saturday night concluding the longest continuous sitting that has been held of the Canadian Parliament.

Hotter scenes were prevalent throughout the day owing to the Oppositionists taking every opportunity to belittle or obstruct the discussion.

Premier Borden argued to the Government was that while the rights of the minority must be respected the authority of the majority must be recognized. The Government proposed to carry out on that which they had received a mandate from the people.

The leader of the opposition hoped that the Government would lead to a better temper of the House.

Lord Roberts' Campaign.
GREAT RECEPTION AT WOLVERHAMPTON.

London, March 17. Lord Roberts' reception on Saturday evening at Wolverhampton, which had prepared for the coming of the Field Marshal, was a magnificent success. Two meetings were held, at which several thousands of people were present. The day over by the Mayor, became the throng in the market square.

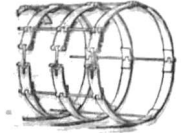

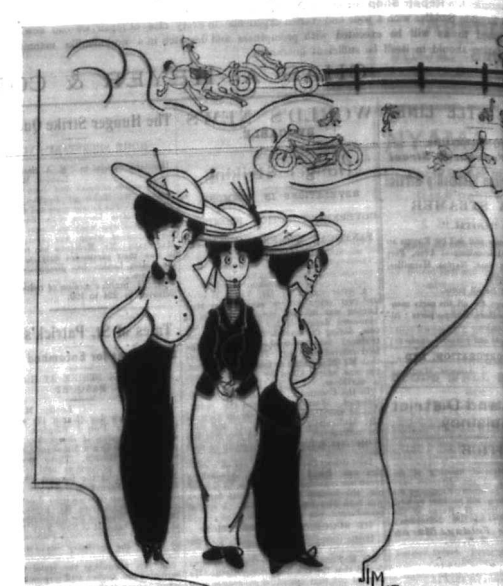

1896 and 1890 resulted in the extinction of servile tenure and the conversion of the cultivators of it into freeholders and many other tenants. The legislation was far too elaborate to be described in this article, but it is worth noting that the land tenure and not with the history of land tenure. In other German states a similar process took place during the first half of the 19th century. About 80 per cent of the land in Germany is held by free owners and only 14 per cent by tenants. The legislation referred to above first resulted in a permanent freehold of the established estate to the A. from the entail with the assent of his family, and afterwards gave him an unlimited right of disposing of it as he saw fit by sale. In Bavaria, for example, according to a very interesting report on agriculture in Germany, written for the Foreign Office by Dr. E. von Koenig, very high authority, farms of less than 25 acres occupy 22.5 per cent of the agricultural area; holdings of between 25 and 29 acres, 15.3 per cent; those of 29 to 50 acres, 19.3 per cent; and farms over 50 acres only 6.1 per cent. In Westphalia, 84 per cent of the land belongs to peasant proprietors, 10 per cent to the Crown and nobles. In Westphalia, on the other hand, the majority of the holdings range from 10 to 200 acres and exceptionally up to 1,000 acres.

LAND TENURE. (Continued.)

Another, whether owned or rented, more the proportion over 40 acres is very small. The average size holding, judging from the most recent statistics available, is under 9 acres. It is only through the wonderful industry and good farming of the peasants that the excessive subdivision of the land has not proved disastrous. Belgium, however, and there are excellent models for the small products of the farm and the market garden, while the exports of such products are considerable. Except when such products are available a perpetual hereditary lease is the first right of the tenant in the land, not at all satisfactory to many of the land-owners. Estates are small and the result is a very large number of small plots of land. The subdivision of the land is due largely to the fact that the tenant has the right of sub-division of the land to tenants, the tenant proprietor for the most part, but his little properties exist. Netherlands. In Holland the proportion of occupying owners of land is somewhat larger than in Belgium or about 50 per cent of the total number. Denmark. The property of agriculture in Denmark is in great measure attributed to the legislation, which, beginning some years before the end of the 18th century, steadily converted a nation of tenants holding small plots of land into a nation of cultivators mainly owning their farms or small holdings. State and communal lands first came under the operation of the law within the last twenty years of the 18th century, and it was not until after the middle of the 19th century, that further legislation brought the estates of private owners within the reach of the cultivators, who were helped to purchase their holdings by means of Government bank loans at a low rate of interest. This legislation increased the number of small holdings, the result has been the acquisition of ownership in a great majority of the cultivators of land. An analysis of a special official enquiry made in 1861, gives the following figures:—In 1801, before the Royal Statistical Society in 1860, states that out of 240,000 holdings, average size 2.5 acres, 84.75 per cent of the number and 67.31 per cent of the area were held on feckhold or hereditary tenure, 4.20 per cent of the number and 2.72 of the area, on lease for fifty years or for the life of the tenant and his heirs; 8.94 per cent of the number and 7.32 in area on annual or short lease tenure, and 4.11 per cent of the number and 2.45 in area on conditions referred to official positions or service.
