Washington, April 4

Montenegro.

The Blockade Begun.

VIEWS OF POWERS.

(Gleizer's Special to "E. A. Standard.") London, April 11.
 The blockade of Montenegro began to-day, Friday.
 Reuter learns that the feeling in the diplomatic circles regarding the satisfactory solution of the difficulty with Montenegro is that an early conclusion of peace is increasingly hopeful. Italy and Russia are setting at naught with a view to effecting cooperation to Montenegro for the loss of Scutari.
 The same view prevails in London, where the working in London to effect a better understanding between the Powers and Montenegro. Some official statements have been issued in Berlin and Vienna which confirm these views. The statements moreover emphasize that Germany's communication cannot be granted at the expense of Albania, but it would have to be at the expense of Serbia or of Italy—Scutari.
 A communication issued at St. Petersburg from the Foreign Ministry declares that the principal object of Russia is to secure the Balkan Peninsula from the results of the difficulties which have been complicated by the different negotiations. Russia has preserved Pivrend, Ipek, Djahova and Dibra for the Slavs. Russia thought it necessary to concede Scutari for Albania in order to preserve peace—a rupture of peace on such a case was manifestly absurd as Scutari was purely an Albanian town, the seat of the Catholic Archbishop. Moreover the Russian Vice Consul at Scutari had proved that the Montenegrins were essentially a military race and incapable of assimilating the several thousand Albanians who had settled in Montenegro for 25 years. Consequently the annexation of a portion of Sandjak and Scutari to Montenegro would bring in a hundred thousand Albanians which would tend to make Montenegro merely a Montenegrin Albania.

Reuter learns that Greece has protested against the frequent passages of the Turkish cruiser "Hamidiyah" through the Canal to Suez. The Greek authorities declare that she has been allowed to provision at Alexandria and has chartered colliers and has communicated freely with Constantinople. They also point out that this warship is infringing the regulations of the Suez Canal and has constituted a dangerous precedent for future wars.
 The "Hamidiyah" is at present in the Red Sea.

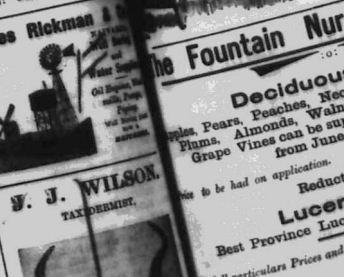
