Papain Extraction.
A New Industry for Kenya?

Papain, which is extracted from the fruit of the paw-paw, is a drug little known in this country. The chief market for the substance is in the form of a powder, where, in its active proportion, it is used in the preparation of meat tenderizers. The fruit looks for unripe and ripened stages in the "Hotway Chloride".

Early last year the Rhodesian Department of Agriculture sent a trial sample of papain to England which was favourably reported on by experts. Little, however, seems to have been done in the matter since then. It would probably be advisable to send a small quantity to establish its worth in order to discover its value and quality.

The price of first-class papain is about 5s 6d per lb. at the retail quotation. At this price it is quite a paying crop, as the fruit is heavy but bulky in transport. Last year the price was about 10s per lb. the present fall being largely the result of increased production. The major portion of the supply comes from Guyana, and the drug is handled by all the big chemical firms in England.

Paw-paw trees thrive best in a deep loam soil and should be in a sheltered position—on the lee side of a hill or a bank of trees or a building. The seeds may be planted in situ or in tins and germinated before it should be planted. The young plants should be protected from the sun by a cloth.

Time for Tapping
 The fruit commences to form about 14 months and after three months is ready to tap. The fruit is fully matured fruit should be tapped, as unripe fruit produces an inferior quality of papain. The tapping should be done in the early morning, before the sun is hot, and great care must be taken to let the latex flow out smoothly. Incisions should be made in the fruit with a sharp glass knife. The paper to be used to catch the latex should flow from the incision into a tin or a glass jar. 

Double jumpers are worn in vertical horizontal stripes of various





The Committee appointed by the Imperial Government, after the Colonial Conference, for the purpose of investigating the subject of veterinary research and administration in the non-self-governing territories of the Empire has recommended a comprehensive scheme for co-ordination and reorganization. The intention of the scheme is to make the Colonial Veterinary Service a first class one likely to attract young and capable men who will give their best service which entails their intellectual energies. The Report recommends the establishment of a Federal of Tropical Medicine in London on the lines of the valuable and successful School of Tropical Medicine and also the establishment of a Federal Central Research Station in the tropics, preferably in East Africa. It will be readily recognized that the proposal to establish a re-

search station at Kenya was made a few years ago by the Conference of East African Governors. The present suggestion by Lord Lorna's Committee would carry the proposal an important stage further and create in East Africa a central research centre for the tropical Empire. The East African Governors Conference resolved that original work with regard to Veterinary Science as regards the East African territories should be centralized at Nairobi with branches at other suitable points in the territories under the control of the headquarters staff. They also recommended that the Veterinary Research work at Nairobi should be under a Director whose services should be available for the various East African Territories in the same way as those of the Director General of Health. The latter staff was selected, with the support and encouragement of the East African Governors' Committee, for a centralized agricultural research and statistics has been adopted as the centre of the British Government's work in connection with the Empire. Following upon the recommendations of the League of Nations International Sleeping Sickness Commission. But although a number of years have passed since the three-fold research scheme was created, the veterinary science on a large scale has been neglected. It is therefore important to recognize the value of the original work now given to the staff of the Imperial Veterinary Research Station. We have seen it stated in a recent and authoritative publication on stock-raising in East Africa that the East African territories in Kenya took up nothing and regarding the speed, the means of assistance, they were surprised to discover the numerous large herds grazing everywhere in the possession of natives. In point of fact, it is a matter of regret that the number of heads in Kenya far exceeds that in other territories on the African Continent, where stock breeding has been active since the early days

of colonization. The explanation of this important historical fact lies in the salubrious climate of the Colony and the persistence of these large native herds locally, despite the ravages of tsetse-flies, and other insects and the still heavy losses due to East Coast Fever and other stock diseases. It is significant that the East African conditions are remarkably suitable to the rearing of stock. We are well aware of the very great difficulties which have faced the establishment of a dairy industry. But it cannot be maintained that the conditions under which the veterinary service of the Colony has been subjected to the control of a large department of Government have been inimical to the stock industry and the proposed extension of research work. If it is proved, should give a new impetus to stock raising. One of the most obvious difficulties facing Kenya today is the immovable herd represented in the number of single crop farming. It is not to be doubted that a sound agriculture, which can only be laid in relation to stock raising, if it is accorded its proper place in the activities of the farmer who today faces all the risks and uncertainties of single crop production. We are confident that the most important and practical advancement by the committee will show by many of the African tribes such as the Wabakas and the peoples of the Northern Frontier Province in their herds of stock and the part played by cattle in the economy of the native peoples. The establishment of a first class veterinary service in Kenya would be of the greatest economic and political value to the East African territories and the Imperial Government may be assured that the recommendations of the Committee will be most cordially received by the African tribes and the people of the Northern Frontier Province.
