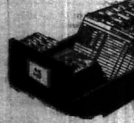

properly chosen, and that they should exercise their functions as representatives with a full sense of responsibility.

The Official Majority.

If the general principle of our approach to the problem of the Central Authority is accepted, we should be able to both, take official advantage in the Legislative Council of Kenya, and in proportion to the powers of the Central Authority, be able to effect the introduction of a progressive re-orientation of official conduct in the Council.

There are limits to what is possible in any arrangement, that has no enforceable limitations, we believe, it is possible to create a recognized and wide field in which the Government of Kenya and the representatives of the local communities will be able to co-operate freely in the conduct of the affairs of the Colony without interference from outside, and that within this field the official representatives can be allowed greater constitutional powers than they have at present, without jeopardizing the maintenance of the main principle of the Government of Kenya.

The proposal which we put forward in this chapter are designed to the advancement of these principles.

Representation of Native Interests.

It will have been seen from the account of the composition which we have already given of the Kenya Legislative Council that the members who have lived in the country of the native lands have under the present arrangement been left with the instruments placed by the appointment of a British member as a representative of these interests.

It is further to be borne in mind that apart from this, we are constrained to give general authority to the native members, by economic and other interests of their own, as well as with the needs of the settled areas, which are not provided with the means for the effective presentation of their views to the Government of the Colony, and interests of the geographical areas which constitute

Official Servants' Duties.

Another serious objection would be that administrative officers who have accepted their service and who possess the necessary qualifications, should be encouraged to remain in the country and be appointed as representatives of native interests in the Council. It is pointed out, however, that to be found among officials who after the completion of their service have decided to remain in the country, is a matter for consideration whether the Government should not seek some possessing the necessary qualifications from outside, approaching the end of their period of service and retain them to represent their constituencies in the Council, paying them a modest honorarium in addition to their salaries.

We see no reason why public funds should be expended in this manner, and that the interests of the native community, to ensure that the officials represented in the Council, should be appointed on a full period of years, and it would be understood that persons appointed, being no longer in the administrative service and being uncommitted by any previous holding of office, would be free to vote as they thought right in the support of the Government.

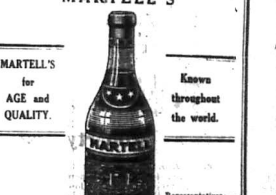



- The memorandum presented to the Commission laid down: (1) That federation should further extend white settlement in Eastern Kenya. (2) Should not be a bar to the natural progress of Kenya towards self-government, and... (3) Was further suggested that any closer union scheme should only operate for a trial period of seven years with provision for review at the end of that period.

A High Commissioner with a Federal Council was a suggestion made with equal unofficial representation from the three Territories for the interim period.

The Federal Council's task was suggested as being co-ordination of Railways, Customs, Posts and Telegraphs, Defence, Law, Native Affairs, Land and Communications.

It was urged that the High Commissioner during the interim period should be the Governor of Kenya and Nairobi the seat of the Federal Government. The High Commissioner to exercise the Secretary of State's veto. The High Commissioner should also be responsible for Native Affairs.

With regard to the Kenya Legislature, the Kenya proposals were—

- (1) An elected European majority, with 28 members to be elected to the House of Representatives. (2) The Council to include two nominated Europeans to represent native interests. (3) Portfolios for Agriculture and Public Works to be given to elected members. (4) No special powers of arbitration.

Finally, the association of the Africans with political life was deprecated and it was considered that their political education could best be achieved through the District Council system now in force.

REDUCING THE COST OF LIVING.

Some East African Recipes that will Help.

No. 14: Economical Breads with Local Flour.

(By J. E. King, Harare.)
 (Special to "The Standard.")

The housewife who has recently arrived from England where a baker's van has called at her door daily, finds the problem of making her own bread a difficult one, especially if the amount offered to her a week work who knows all the tricks of the trade. The following recipes I have used in this country for seven years and have never had a failure.

YEAST.

Take 1 quart of cold water put 2 tablespoonfuls of compressed yeast, 1 tablespoonful of sugar and 1 teaspoonful of salt. Put on the stove and boil for 15 minutes. Strain, return by fire, and add 1 cup of flour which has been mixed with a little cold water. Boil 4 minutes or two longer and remove from fire. When cool, pour into a jar and leave in a warm place for one or three days, or until it works. Don't be persuaded by a neighbour to stir a little of her yeast to start it. It may make good, but its quality may also be impaired, and for reasons that you must have perfect yeast. After you have had your own yeast, and know that it is good, use it right each time to add to your own yeast. This addition should not be made until the yeast has ceased to ferment.

BREAD.

Measure 2 quarts of white flour and wash thoroughly by sifting on the sieve and strain carefully through the hands. Into a quart measure put 1 cup of the above yeast (after it has worked well) 2 tablespoonfuls of sugar, 2 teaspoonfuls of melted shortening (this may be omitted if preferred) and fill the measure with lukewarm water. Mix with a spoon until the sugar and salt are dissolved. If a bread mixer is used put the flour in first, then the yeast and turn the handle for 5 minutes. If it is to be made by hand, make a hole in the centre and pour in the mixture. Mix with a spoon until it becomes too stiff to stir, then knead with the hands for 10 or 12 minutes. Cover with a blanket, put in a place for 10 or 12 minutes. Cover very lightly, cut into 4 pieces. Sprinkle each with a half cup of yeast, and press and mould into balls. Allow to rise until double in bulk and bake.

CURRY BREAD.

Take 1 lb. of dough when ready to put in the tin and knead by 7 cup of washed curries. It is a slightly sweet loaf, it does not, it is rather light-coloured or too of sugar. Allow 4 lbs. and bake as plain bread.

CINNAMON BREAD.

Take 1 lb. of the dough when ready to put in the tin and roll out to 1 inch thick. Spread it evenly with butter and sprinkle on a mixture of 2 cup of sugar and 1 cup of cinnamon. Roll up and cut in 1 inch slices. Lay in a greased and floured baking tin, allow to rise until double in bulk and bake in a hot oven. When done break over with sugar covered with a little hot water or with a syrup made of 1 cup of sugar, 1 cup of water and 1 teaspoonful of cloves. Roll until 3 tablespoonfuls.

LIGHT FANCY BUNS.

Take 2 of the dough when ready to put in the tin and add 1 cup of sugar, 1 cup of butter, 1 egg, the grated rind of 1 lemon and 1/2 cup of raisins. Roll out and shape into to make something easy. They may be made with dough in a plain tin, or with the addition of 1 cup of any kind of the following: Currants, nutmeg, peel, chopped dates, chopped raisins or chopped nuts. Or the plain lemon rind may be omitted and

Seven Years Term.

It is believed to attempt to establish a head and fast Federal Council, which, by agreement, will be empowered to legislate and probably also to enforce, even if a scheme could be devised which would meet the views and sentiments of the three States, would constitute a Federal Council composed on the lines and with the functions hitherto proposed should be limited to a period of seven years only, with provision for a review of the whole situation and a revision of the existing scheme should it be found necessary to modify it in any way or to extend it to a fully developed Federal Constitution.

It is proposed that closer union be attained by the appointment of a High Commissioner for East Africa and the establishment of a Federal Council, which should be composed of senior officials from each of the three Territories. The functions of the Federal Council should be to coordinate the services hitherto which the various agencies do it, but that the control of the Highway to be hereafter more specifically dealt with should be in the hands of the legislatures of the three Territories. In other words, the Federal Council should have control only over such funds as are voted for its purposes by the local legislatures.

The Federal Council will be the body of the unofficial representation of the three Territories and because it is intended to apply to the interim period only, and is without prejudice to the right of any of the three Territories to demand an increased representation in the final Federal scheme should it be desired.

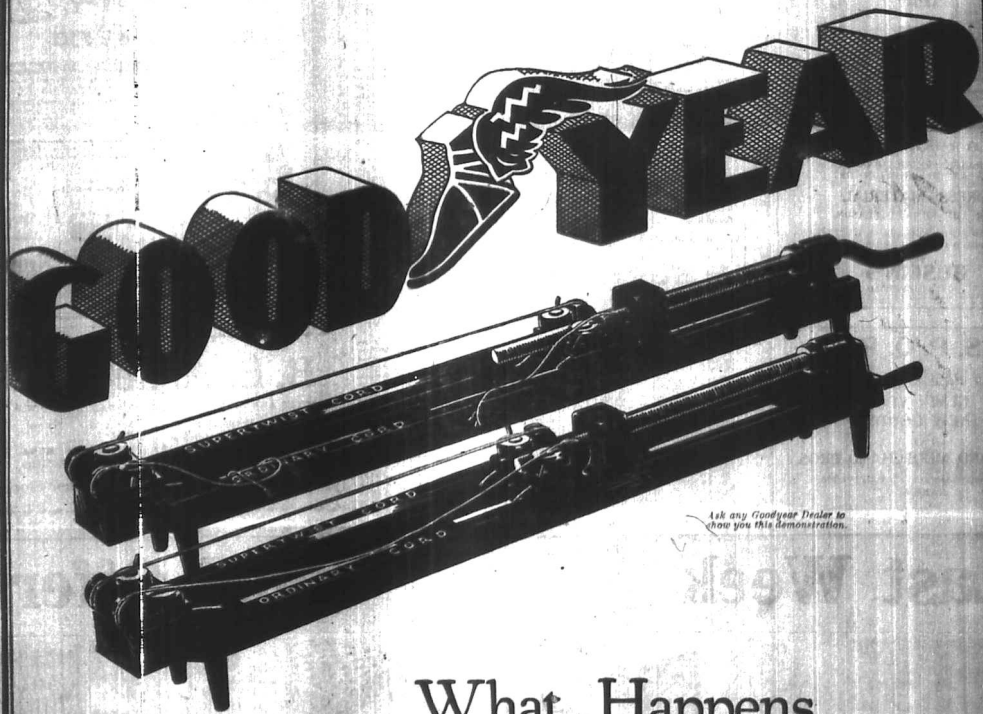

more time retaining a casting vote of the Government. The reaction of an unofficial majority must be recognized as introducing a substantial change in the existing situation, and it is scarcely probable whether the plan does not involve the risk of introducing a measure which would be an irreparable offence with all the well-known officials, such as a situation. There are, however, essential features in the present conditions, and in the form of our proposals, which appear to eliminate such a risk. The very nature of this unofficial majority makes it reasonable to expect that it will vote together on any measure of this kind, but, in the event, not of embarrassing the Government, but of giving assistance to a particular measure.

At the same time, it is most clearly understood that in the present conditions of our country, the Government of the Central Africa should be prepared to prevent any abuse of the system by not allowing it to be used in any way which would be the method of withholding support being used to force the Executive.

It is the official representative of the different sections they will, under the circumstances we propose, have increasing power to influence the laws under which they shall live, so far as they are concerned with their differences, it is to the Government, and that the content of a measure should be settled by a majority of the whole, which is a fair and equitable method of settling a matter of public interest, which is not to be done by a majority and give rise to increasing local tension.

Common Interest.

It is said that his Majesty on the modified side which our proposals make is composed of such diverse elements that there is little chance of the majority ever being effective. We should reply that it is in answer to this kind of objection that the basis and purpose of our plan can best be explained. It is not a matter of mere expediency, but a matter of principle. It is intended that the local community should have some responsibility for the conduct of the affairs of the Colony, but a question of the highest importance is whether or not the responsibility should be entrusted to a body of 100 members, who are to be elected by the community in the form which will be the result of the progress of the plan. It is our intention that we will have a body which will ever grow suitable to the needs of the community, but particularly very remote such that the community should be able to elect a representative of the community.
