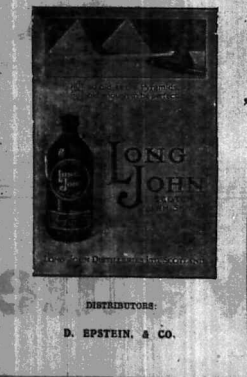
The Esprit de Cars.

One of the heaviest of the skids in this country is skid. This is not in any way alarming or dangerous as it appears in the article. The author tells in simple language how a skid may be mastered, and conditions have been explained, the skid can be turned to good account as a means of avoiding a collision. When the skid of the rear wheels is such that the brakes are not working properly because it is not understood. In consequence, some drivers are so surprised to see a car skidding when the roads are wet and rains of contact, skidding of rear blood-sucking flies that add to the general consternation. The reason for all this is the very fact that the car is not skidding, but only overcomes that trouble by providing it until the remedy is found after much experience.

Skidding should be studied by a driver as a necessary part of the art of driving. It occurs nearly always in an emergency, is more prevalent on a wet surface, but sometimes occurs even if the road is dry, and is first caused by the skidding of the rear wheels, which is, as a rule, on a wet surface. ENGLAND WINS FOURTH TEST BY DOZEN RUNS.

The Triumph of Youth at Adelaide.

LESSONS FOR THE FUTURE.

Field Policy of Experiment Required for the Last Test.

Last season's tension marked the close of the fourth Test, played at Adelaide.

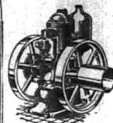

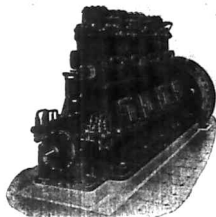
