LORD OLIVIER REPLIES TO KENYA LEADERS' VIEWS ON REPORT.

Will Move Appointment of Joint Committee of Both Houses.

TWO VIEWS OF MR. CHURCHILL'S 1922 SPEECH.

Approving a Code of Native Policy Principles for Application in Africa.

A lengthy reply to the communique issued by the Conference of Elected Members and the Executive of the Convention of Associations, has been made to 'The Times' by Lord Olivier, the Labour Peer.

He interprets Mr. Churchill's 1922 declaration regarding self-government in Kenya in a different sense from that used by the Conference.

Lord Olivier proposes that a Joint Committee of both Houses of Parliament should be set up to define the guiding principles of the native trusteeship and to introduce a motion to that effect in the House of Lords.

Meanwhile, the Elected Members and the Executive of the Convention are beginning active in Kenya following the recent joint Conference in Nairobi, which envisaged the holding of a general election.

THE FINANCIAL WORLD IN 1928.

Review Reveals Some Striking Facts.

COPYRIGHTS MEMORANDUM.

(FINANCIAL CORRESPONDENT.)

Although the record of 1928 in the field of industry and trade was in many respects less favorable than that of its predecessor, the year was characterized by the general side, for marking a recovery in the financial markets, and for the resumption of the financial year, the year was surpassed by the 1927 total. That itself was exceeded only in 1926. The figure for 1928 was \$2645 millions, only \$111 millions smaller than in 1926, when the level of wholesale prices was roughly twice as high.

Of the total increase in the British Commonwealth of Nations absorbed a slightly lower amount than in 1927, for although India took a larger share, other British overseas countries accounted for a considerably smaller total. Out of \$784 millions for those areas, Canada and Newfoundland took \$200 millions, a larger amount than in any year since the war, and nearly three times as much as in 1927. Australasia accounted for \$244 millions, as compared with \$41 millions in 1927. The amount paid to Africa was \$113 millions smaller in 1928, being \$100 millions in 1927, including India and Ceylon, took \$81 million, or rather less than in the previous year.

Foreign Borrowings

The amount taken by foreign borrowers was \$243 millions, larger than in 1927, though the total, up to \$257 millions, Asiatic countries again accounted for a very small amount, only slightly over \$1 billion. The British share of this, including the total, was for 1927, being \$193 millions as against \$264 millions in 1928. Brazil and Argentina were the heaviest borrowers, with \$118 millions and \$44 millions respectively.

The increase in foreign issues therefor to be attributed to Europe, on behalf of which the 1928 issues reached \$232 millions, as compared with \$214 millions in 1927. As in the former year, Germany was the largest borrower, with \$81 millions, as against \$72 millions, Greece coming second on the list with \$73 millions, and Hungary third for \$45 millions. When we come to domestic issues, as distinguished between public

and semi-public borrowings on the one hand, and issues by companies of all kinds on the other, the figures show a marked reduction in 1928, both absolutely and proportionately to the other.

One is that the general impression of the general impression of the new issue market has been considerably improved, and that the undertakings of all kinds, both new and old. The amount raised by the group for 1928 was \$1,000 million, as against \$1,000 million in 1927.

Moreover, two facts stand out as noteworthy in connection with the issue market. One is that the growth of issues by financial, land, investment and trust companies was more than maintained in 1928, when \$681 millions were absorbed by this group. The figure is much larger than that for any year on record, and indicates the growing popularity of this particular field of investment.

The second striking fact is the enormous increase in the amount raised by miscellaneous commercial and industrial undertakings. The total for 1928 was nearly double the already large figure for 1927, and is comparable only with that for 1926, when the total of \$1,000 million, the peak of boom finance being the figure of \$1,100 million. The great bulk of last year's total was raised for some purposes, but as in 1928, in most cases we are surprised that the whole amount was devoted to solid industrial and trading development, such as the provision of new plant and equipment and the setting up of new industrial or trading units.

Much of it was of a purely financial character and must have represented little if any addition to the country's productive assets. The miscellaneous commercial and industrial issues have been widely distributed over a great variety of undertakings. The figure for some particular branches of home business, however, are of special interest. Thus companies engaged in the provision of apartments of all kinds accounted for \$113 millions in 1928, as compared with \$23 millions in the previous year. Companies concerned mainly in the production of films, gramophones, wireless apparatus and similar goods absorbed \$78 millions, as against only about a quarter of that sum in 1927. The home textile industries absorbed \$114 millions in 1928, \$443 millions more than in the preceding year, almost the entire amount going to artificial products. These figures represent, in an indirect sense, a diversion of portions of their share in relation to the total new issues for the entire group.

GERMAN TRADE TREATY WITH SOUTH AFRICA.

Grave Appreciation in Britain.

P.R.I. VIEW.

The Federation of British Industries have had little to say in connection with the proposed Commerce Treaty between the Union of South Africa and Great Britain.

The Federation do not question the right of South Africa as a self-governing member of the British Commonwealth of Nations, to adopt any policy which is considered desirable in its own interests. The Federation would, however, point out that Great Britain is still a Great Britain, and in the terms of the proposed Treaty, which will result in a foreign country's reaching equality with Great Britain in the matter of all tariff preferences which may be granted in the future. The effect of such a departure in policy on the part of the Union Government is thereby pre-empting British business opinion, and it is feared that the results will be seriously to both British and South African trade and industries.

The Federation would point out that the United Kingdom is overwhelmingly the most important customer of South Africa, her purchases in all 1928 being \$100 million, as compared with 19 million pounds' worth purchased by all foreign countries combined. While, as stated above, Great Britain imported 46 million pounds' worth of goods from South Africa in the year in question, the Union imported 5 million pounds worth of British goods, leaving a balance of trade in favour of South Africa of about 95 million pounds.

In the case of Germany, which is the country to receive the benefit of the proposed Treaty, the exportation of South African goods to Germany was only slightly over 4 million pounds, whereas the importation of German food into South Africa amounted this amount by half a million, thus showing an unfavorable trade balance for South Africa.

Results From Britain.

The Federation readily recognizes the value of the preference granted by South Africa to British goods. On the other hand they would point out that South Africa receives, at present, very substantial commercial benefits from Great Britain.

In the first place Great Britain granted to South Africa in 1927 a preference which in 1928, approximately half the value of the preference received by her. In connection with this it is interesting to recall that at the last Imperial Conference Mr. Hargreaves stated that he was the bearer of a special message of appreciation from the fruit growers of South Africa, who were expressing the full advantage of the free admission of their fruit into the United Kingdom, which is a proof of the appreciation felt in South Africa for the benefits of the tariff preferences granted by the British Government.

In the second place the British taxpayer is at present paying one million sterling per annum for the maintenance of the Imperial Preference, for the purpose of which the Government has established a special fund. It is interesting to note that any other Government is taking similar action for the maintenance of South Africa's exports.

Question of Capital.

Thirdly, capital has been needed and will be needed for the economic development of the Union, and the provision of new capital from South Africa is a matter of the highest importance. It is interesting to note that the Colonial Stock Act of 1920, according to the last official return, estimate shows under the Act over £20 million per annum for the sterling—a substantial contribution towards the development of South African resources.

Finally the Federation cannot avoid pointing out that the British taxpayer is called upon to provide for the bulk of the cost of the Imperial Preference, which are necessary for the maintenance of the Empire as a whole. This is only one example of the way in which the Empire is called upon to contribute to the maintenance of the Empire, and it is to be hoped that the Government will be able to secure for the Empire a more equitable arrangement of the contributions of every part of the Empire to the maintenance of the Empire, and to ensure free access to their own markets.

The Federation trusts that these points will be given the consideration which they deserve before a line of policy is definitely adopted which would be seriously harmful to British trade interests, with an effect on the maintenance of the power of this country to protect its South African products.

In view of the marked interest in a doubling of the trade between Great Britain and South Africa, it is interesting to note that the Government is taking steps to ensure that the commercial relations between the two countries cannot be over-estimated.

Agriculture.

The Establishment of Permanent Pastures. Use of Cereals as Nurse Crops.

The following bulletin regarding the establishment of permanent pastures using cereals as nurse crops by Mr. W. J. W. Watt, C.I.A.S.S. For. has been issued by the Department of Agriculture. Copies of the bulletin may be obtained free on application to the Librarian, Department of Agriculture, Nairobi.

In Kenya today a very large proportion of the land covered with natural pasture which has been in a similar state for several centuries. While the quality of the grazing is undoubtedly good, and heavy crops of grass cover the land in many places, this is not always the case, and the carrying capacity of great stretches of land is too inferior to be of any real economic value to the owner of the country.

As long settlement increases and it becomes more necessary that every part of the national territory should carry a maximum load of stock, farmers will have to depend less on the natural pasture and replace many areas with feed of a better type and of greater drought-resisting quality.

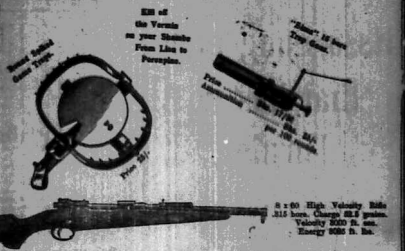
There are many indigenous grasses in the country which are admirably suited for the purpose if they can be economically planted. While in many parts of Kenya there is a wonderful gift of large quantities of Kikuyu grass and Nairobi's Sil grass, which can be increased by the simple method of root division, we are hindered by the small quantities of seed obtainable of such grasses as Fynbos, Paspalum distachyon, and others which form excellent food and are good drought-resisters.

It might be suggested here that stockmen commence sowing on small areas of selected grasses on cultivated land so that in the near future many will have proved grasses for their districts. In the meantime, a few of the best cereals are the present conditions in Kenya (Pennisetum polystachyon, Pennisetum polystachyon, Pennisetum polystachyon, Pennisetum polystachyon).



The Care of Cellulose and Fabric Bodies.

Old & New Styles.

Very people think that a house garage is complete without an area of concrete in front of the building, usually, commonly designated as "a wash," and, of course, suitably drained to meet all the requirements of the local authority, but how many seriously undertake the job of washing down their cars? Most of them are content to "play at it," and seldom think of using more than one bucketful of water for the whole operation. This is generally considered to be the wisest and most economical by the friends who are too polite or too disinclined to point out that the meaning of the old proverb "Out of sight, out of mind" has been interpreted only too correctly. In other words, you can, if you are careful and methodical, remove mud from the body and fenders of a car with a bucketful of water, but you cannot, with the same quantity, thoroughly clean the whole and the motor parts of the chassis.

In these days of cellulose finish and fabric bodies, washing as a routine job is being treated of as a necessity because when it is over to make a car look smart, it is, in a general survey, the best thing you can do for it. It is equally easy to forget that it can be really accomplished under the chassis.

The First Requirement.

There is, therefore, every reason why anyone who takes seriously to undertake the work of cleaning their own car should equip themselves with all the materials and make up the job properly.

The body may now be allowed to dry—rubbing down being unnecessary, unless it is to be polished first away—and even if a not subsequently given a rub over with a soft cloth, it will present a clean, glossy appearance.

It should not be forgotten, however, that cellulose lacquer pays for polishing and that the more it is polished the more it shines.

One of the recognized cellulose lacquer polishing media is therefore recommended, but it should be applied when the surface is wet.

Fabric bodies can be dealt with in much the same way, up to a point. They are impervious to water and a moderately high pressure jet will not harm them, providing the muddy deposit has been removed.

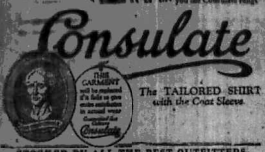

 At a meeting of the Kinangop Farmers last week a delegation was formed to request the Government to issue a permit for the export of their milk to the Nairobi market to meet the demand of the Nairobi home market which would arrive at about noon on Monday. This knowledge met the Nairobi Farmers at a meeting held at the Nairobi Hotel. The matter before the meeting was one of great urgency.

Captain Fry was the spokesman of the Kinangop Farmers and he explained to his headquarters the critical position of the dairy farmers established on the Kinangop which had been brought about by a Government official making an alleged violation of the law by issuing a permit for cattle to be taken from East Coast Fever areas into the midst of the dairy area in the Kinangop. These cattle were all diseased, but not before they had infected the Kinangop cows, whose districts from East Coast Fever are not so far from Nairobi.

The area in danger, if it were allowed to spread, was very large and involved much of the best high grade cattle in the Colony.

This year, 1922, the Nairobi Co-operative Dairy Industry in spite of the dry weather will export to London during January and February 25 tons of butter every week and it is expected that the total export will be about 100 tons. This is a very large quantity of butter and it is expected that the Nairobi dairy farmers would be able to supply the Nairobi market with 100 tons of butter every week.

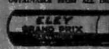
