INTENSE COLD CONTINUES IN EUROPE.

Heavy Falls of Snow in all Parts of the Continent.

TRANSPORT AND INDUSTRY PARALYSED.

Rivers in France and Britain Becoming Frozen.

The Arctic conditions in Europe continued during the weekend, the cold wave assuming alarming proportions in its parts, causing, in many places, a complete cessation of transport and industry.

The weather is still severe in Great Britain. Ice is forming more of the River Thames and bridges are falling on the river at Richmond. Owing to the continuation of the snowfalls on the river, the tidal waters are not expected to freeze as they did many years ago.

Shipping is being interrupted in many parts of Britain, even in areas near to London. The multiplicity, however, of small boats visited by one of its well-known "punch" boys, which added to the discomfort of the cold and frost.

Reports predict a slow rise in temperature, although they state there is no prospect of an early thaw.

The text of the Food Control Legislation has been passed. The Bill comes before a special meeting of the Legislative Council this week.

A penalty of £500 or two years imprisonment may be incurred by any person concerned in exportation or attempted exportation of foodstuffs from the Colony, other than by an official licence.

The Food Board will have wide powers including that of purchase of foodstuffs outside the Colony to approximate local supplies.

The legislation, which carries off the end of the year, fixes the basis of prices which will be paid for commodities of various kinds. Substantial penalties are provided for cases of non-compliance with the Board's orders.

NAKURU BOARD AND LOCAL TAXATION.

Official Reply to a Memorandum.

PUBLIC HEALTH.

"STANDARD" (CORRESPONDENT) NAKURU. A special meeting of members of the Nakuru (Incorporated) Municipal Board was held at the Valley Sports Club on January 20 when the following resolution was presented to the Hon. Mr. Leven for the consideration of the Government, Lands and Settlements.

The draft estimate of revenue and expenditure for the first financial year of the Municipal Board of Nakuru would appear to be based on the assumption that certain rates and taxes will be imposed though, so far, the Board has not yet even discussed the desirability of imposing any new rates or taxes at this early stage.

The Board, however, has already decided with some definite suggestions on the appropriate amount of revenue which may be imposed on the district. The Board is in communication with Public Health Officer.

The Board would be glad to give discretionary power to exempt from or alter, or alternatively to apply differential ratings, in cases where it appears whether it will be permitted to exercise the option that the differential powers referred to in the preceding paragraph are not to be exercised.

surprise, the inclusion of agricultural land in the Municipal area for rating purposes, as the principle involved had not been previously submitted to them for consideration, and as this principle appears to be highly contentious, they feel that their report should be submitted for the consideration of the Board under an exceptional power of appointment which in the same manner as suggested in the case of the outgoing township.

Misplaced Boundaries

Mr. Leven stated that, until he had studied the proposals defining the new township boundaries, he would not be in a position to express an opinion on the matter. He thought some mistake had been made in defining boundaries.

If an application was submitted to Government giving sound reasons for the exemption from rates of any particular holdings, he did not anticipate its refusal, but where it was considered that agriculture or other land within the township was obtaining benefits from the Municipality or was being held up for speculative purposes, he would not recommend exemption.

Speaking for himself he would be inclined to exempt from rating the portion of agricultural land lying between the two subdivided portions of 17 1/2 acres (Mr. Coen's) in the Valley Road subdivision of the township. Mr. Leven proposed that the holding should be rated and that the rate should be fixed at 5/- per acre.

Mr. Leven said that his statement as to the public opinion, in the effect that differential rating would be possible, was based on a memorandum, which was handed to him by the Local Government Commission Report, but that he had overlooked and not included in the Ordinance.

the conclusion that a system of differential rating was put forward remained necessary to Government and it might be possible to put through an amending ordinance. He personally would support a proposal to exempt from rating any property which the Board considered, bore too great a burden under the present rating ordinance.

Public Health.

With regard to the public health, Mr. Leven said that it had already been decided that the Board should be appointed as the Local Health Authority, and a proclamation to that effect was awaiting His Excellency's signature.

It had been considered more desirable, during the early stages of the Board's existence, to continue to employ the Government Medical Officer of Health and Sanitary Inspector and that arrangements should be made for Mr. Leven to be appointed as the Sanitary Inspector and that the Government Medical Officer of Health should be appointed as the Sanitary Inspector.

Subject only to the authority of the Standing Committee, which had taken the place of the Central Board of Health, the Board would have executive power and control of the policy of the Local Health Office and as to continuity of policy, the Health Office staff would have executive power only in minor or trifling matters, but would have to refer to the Board in cases where it was necessary to issue orders with respect to the health of the township.



Ambrey, Captain H. A. Strangier and Captain W. F. Williams, were nominated as a sub-committee to select a Board Committee to assist the local representative on the District Council—Major H. A. R. Levy, Mr. E. W. Willam, Major R. H. Holmes Jackson and Captain H. A. Strangier.

Major H. A. R. Levy gave a review of the activities of the Subukia Farmers' Association. On the motion of Captain H. J. Eckstein, who stressed the desirability of having satisfactory installations carried out annually, it was resolved to refer the matter to the Veterinary Department to have the Subukia District placed on the roster of the "Flying Squadrons" for ringworm, insecticides and other sanitary measures.

An interesting discussion on matters in connection with the Subukia Farmers' Association was conducted by Major F. D. Boyce, elected representative on the Nairobi Area Defence Committee, who reported the work done by that Committee in the appointment of a Commandant, Section Commanding, Veterinary, and Transport Officers, etc. Major Boyce having been seconded by the Nairobi Area Committee to draw up an organisation and plan of defence for the consideration of the Committee, explained in outline his suggested organisation and scheme of defence. He particularly drew attention to the need for a mobile force and after some definite discussion it was agreed that the scheme was sound and workable. It was explained that the Commandant, General Holden, had selected Major Levy's farm "Spring Valley" as the most suitable rallying point and defence centre in the event of an invasion being ordered. Major Boyce's selection as Subukia Section Commander was confirmed, and on his suggestion Major H. H. Holmes Jackson and Captain W. K. Killamson were elected section commanders, and Major H. A. Levy was elected Defence Post Commander.

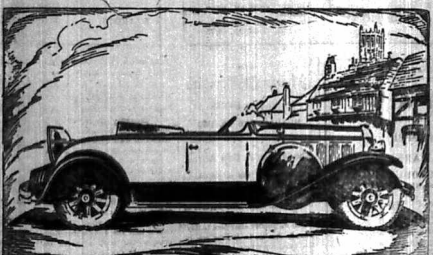

Presence of the magnitude of the field of work open to public spirited women in a paper offered in the annual Reports of the East African Women's League which will publish elsewhere today. This, Mr. W. G. is now one of the most important bodies in the Colony. Its membership consists of over 1,000 women in all respects covers nearly thirty branches. The policy of decentralization of control adopted over a year ago has stimulated public spirit among the women of the neighboring parts of Kenya by presenting to them an opportunity for the expression of their own individuality with the spirit and enthusiasm of the knowledge that behind these small district groups there is the weight and authority of a whole of the League. 

Topics for the Motorist.

Economy in Motoring.

Records as an Aid to Cheap Running.

Keep Accurate Accounts.

To be keen motorist to whom expense is a consideration then often comes the question as to how the car is costing, and how long it will last.

The answer to the former question can best be discovered by keeping a record of the cost of the car and the answer to the latter, depending as it does on the care taken of the car and the distance run, cannot be ascertained by stating a definite period of time, but the period can be lengthened by a systematic care of the car.

Both these objects are assisted by carrying a car logbook, which should always be kept in the car, and by entering up all items of expenditure as they occur, and by keeping within any set limits allowed or advised.

Using a Logbook.

Not only is this book useful for reference at the end of any lengthy period of time, but, from the details supplied, we are able to check from time to time with items as petrol consumption, and an abnormal consumption is recorded we are able to take steps to remedy the cause.

The financial pages of the logbook may be divided into suitable headings, thus on the first page such items as those on which it is impossible to be exact, such as repairs, these items are the cost of the car insurance, tax, garage rent, and any books purchased.

From this page, by making allowance for depreciation, we can obtain some idea of the cost of the car over any period, as this cost is shared by the items which are not included under any of the other pages.

Sturdy Items.

Other pages of the logbook can be devoted to such items as petrol, distilled water, grease, and similar consumable stores. For these we require to know the date of purchase, amount purchased, and the cost. From the figures thus obtained we can obtain a suitable allowance for any consumption of these items, and when the amount used and the date of purchase are known we can effect the consumption; that is, the cost of petrol, a pro rata

parted during driving, was taking place practically all the time, it would result in a heavier consumption than if the same distance were covered in a country run. In a case of this kind, however, the driver should not mean waste.

Further advice should be devoted to tyres and tubes, and the best method is to deal with each tyre and tube separately and to keep a record of the mileage done on any particular tyre. In this manner we have a record of the full life of each tyre or tube.

This completes the essential record, and we now come to the method to be adopted to ensure that the regular updating of which is necessary in the interests of long life and economy.

The best method of securing this regularly is to make a list of the parts normally requiring attention, and whenever anything is done to enter this up on the log book.

The Oil Bill.

Lubrication is one branch, and in this case, with the scope exception of the pump level, which does not enter this up on the log book, the amount of lubrication depends on the mileage run. The actual distances selected depend greatly on the time and place of the run, and the oil used varies in a very good deal from that used in other parts of the country. At 200 miles all points which require the oil of the Esprit motor should be given a fresh supply, and in addition oil should be applied to the brake joints, starting handle, an oiler and oiler motor outside. After 500 miles' running the level of the oil should be checked in the gauges and in the baric seat, and every 1,000 miles grease should be re-stamped in the ball joints, the oil in the gears and back axle should be changed, and after 2,000 miles running the springs should be adjusted, and the oil in the gear should be changed in accordance with the instructions in the Manual, and when necessary that no part is missed.

In a similar manner, records of general maintenance can be carried up, and the date of adjustment noted. Thus every 500 miles the front-chamber may be cleaned out

distilled water added to the battery required. Every 1,000 miles the petrol tank filter and the magneto may be cleaned, the contact breaker points of the magneto may be cleaned, the points should be given over in order to remove dirt which may have become embedded.

At 5,000 miles the distance between the points of the contact breaker should be carefully checked and adjusted, if necessary, and also the distance between the springing plus points. To secure a maximum efficiency the valves should be ground in and the operation of valves disassembled, taking care to give a correct adjustment on the feet, and the valve tappets when reassembling. The chains should be given over, and any loose nuts tightened up. At 10,000 miles a general overhaul should be given and in addition to those items already mentioned the bearings should be cleaned and the bearings ground. All electrical systems and the wiring generally should be inspected, and the petrol system should be thoroughly cleaned.

Then give a general view of the more usual operations to be carried out and try not intended to be a complete list, but will probably make a good deal of sense and get out a similar list.

Certain items such as tyre pumps and the addition of distilled water to the battery may require attention on a time basis instead of a mileage basis if the weekly mileage is less than 200 miles.

Regular Attention.

These lists, however, are not intended to cover every case, but serve rather to form a guide to a method of keeping a record of the car's running. This method has been adopted on the Esprit motor, and the car has accumulated 17,000 miles in 18 months. To give some idea of the hard work done by the car generally it may be said that during four months of this period 300 miles a week was regularly undertaken, of this 300 being journey consisted of a run of 125 miles out and the same distance back again, and the run was accomplished at an average speed of thirty-seven miles an hour. 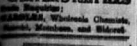

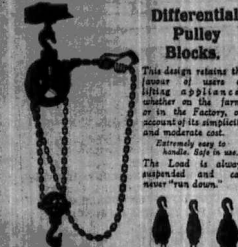

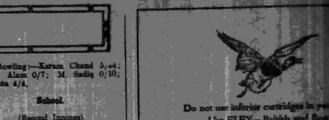
