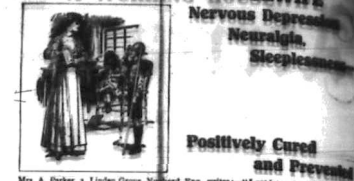

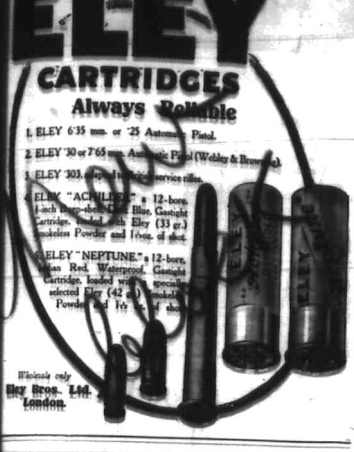

The 11th Meeting of the Council of the British Cotton Growing Association was held at the Office, 15 Cross Street, Manchester, on Tuesday, April 16, the President, The Right Hon. Earl of Derby, G.C.V.O. in the chair.

It was reported that there is every probability of the immediate conversion of the railway to Tokar, which is expected to become an important cotton growing centre in the near future. The reports from the Experimental stations at Tatu and from the Jidda plantation are most satisfactory, and a yield of 600 lbs of lint cotton per acre has been obtained in the Taveta district from 1 acre of 10 rows.

The prospects of cotton in Lagos up to March and amounting to 62,500 bales are compared with 4,925 bales for the same period of 1911, and 6,000 bales for 1909. The cotton is now coming in rapidly and there is every likelihood that this year's crop will be the record one for West Africa, and will total nearly 20,000 bales.

NYASLAND

Thanks very largely to the assistance of the Association, considerable progress has been made during the month in connection with the construction of the railway from Tazara to Port Herald to the Zambesi, and the work will be proceeded with at an early date. As the line is now nearly 20 miles long it is expected that the railway will be completed by the end of the year.

UGANDA

The production of cotton in this Protectorate continues to increase and the cotton is obtaining a ready sale in this country. The cotton growing industry is progressing so rapidly that the transport facilities on the main railway have become completely inadequate, and it is stated by competent authorities that the present line is utterly insufficient to double the line at all. Some schemes and rolling stock are urgently required.

FINANCE

Reference was made to the large increase which has recently taken place in the amount of capital required to be advanced, and additional capital will be required in the near future to carry on the business. Before any steps can be taken for raising this capital on a commercial basis it is essential that the whole of the original capital should be subscribed, and representations have been made to the directors to make a further endeavour to raise the balance of the required amount. It is hoped will be forthcoming within the next few months.

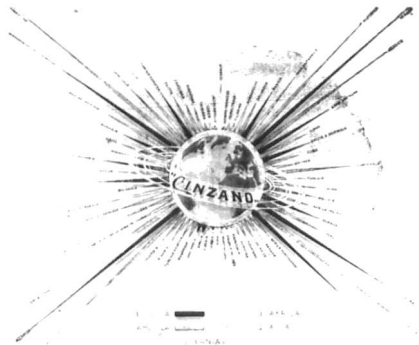

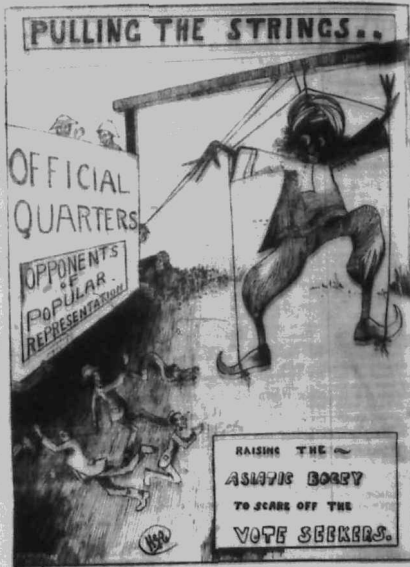

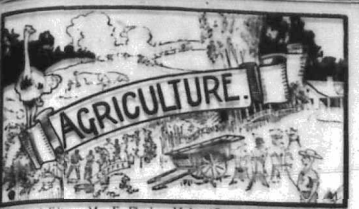

KEEPING OF CATTLE AND EAST COAST FEVER.

(Continued.)
THE HORSE DISEASES.
It is already stated, East Coast fever, redwater fever, bulbar fever, and other diseases, which have been commonly known in the category, are caused by the presence of minute organisms in the blood. In many cases these have been identified, although, as regards redwater, the identity is still probably in doubt.

It has been abundantly proved that the minute organisms, these organisms, when they enter into the animal's system, are not destroyed by any means of drugs which have been used to exterminate the disease. Further, it is a fact that, in more than one species, the disease has been transmitted from one animal to another, both by the blood and by the urine. And again, as observed by Taylor and others, one animal may be infected with the organisms of the disease by contact with the organs of another animal which it attacks itself.

South African stock farmers are so impressed with the disease and their losses, that they are inclined to further experiments. But it is necessary to know the fact that all these diseases are caused by minute organisms, and that they are not transmitted from animal to animal without the intervention of ticks.

METHODS OF DEALING WITH THE TICK.

On account of the extensive transmission of the ticks, many measures have been suggested. But it is necessary to know the fact that all these diseases are caused by minute organisms, and that they are not transmitted from animal to animal without the intervention of ticks.

Chemical Methods.—These consist of applying to the skin of the animals various substances poisonous to the ticks, by which they are killed.

The amount of oil used in spraying the under and rear parts of the animals only, varied as at 1 lb. of a gallon per head.

The effects on the animals were not generally injurious, even when the oil was used undiluted, although, in certain kinds of weather the drying of the oil was delayed, and a slight inflammation of the skin around animals was in consequence produced.

There is little doubt but that paraffin used at sufficient strength and carefully applied under proper conditions, is one of the best spraying agents. The strength of the paraffin-water mixture must be at least 10 per cent paraffin in alcohol. The spray on animal all over it is found that half a gallon of paraffin must be used, the rest of which may be taken as above.

From this it is seen that the cost of spraying with paraffin is prohibitive for ordinary purposes, that is for spraying every 2 or 4 days when labour and other contingent expenses are considered.

It is much to be regretted from the stock farmer's point of view, and it is also great misfortune that paraffin-water mixture by itself cannot be used with good effect at greater dilution than 15 per cent.

Quarantine. Dips of various kinds, proprietary and otherwise, have proved inefficient, and not entirely modern, as tick-killing agents, as appears from the experiments of Lousbury, Watkins-Pitchford, Brush, and others.

Quarantine Mixture.—This is an excellent preparation which has proved considerable favour in Queensland and South Africa. It consists of—

White arsenic	5 lbs.
Castor oil	40 "
Stockholm tar	50 "
Tallow	50 "
Bolled in 400 gallons of water.	

This mixture was recommended by the Queensland Government, and forms the basis of many proprietary dips. It has of course the objection that the ingredients have to be combined by boiling.

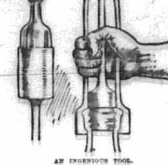

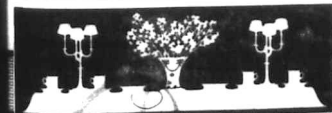
