GUERILLA WARFARE IN BOMBAY.

Fake Rumour Leads to Many Deaths.

"Enthusiasm and interest have now been entirely confined to the Aligarh or Afghan attacks since I have had quite a little war of our own in the Province. We have had three Pathans in India and the one named Saad, a bright and able man, has been brought into the Province of the West. He is now here to call on the Government and to see the Chief Commissioner."

The trouble started, as all reports have always done in India with a rumour, a really wild and untrue story about four or five of the Hindu citizens of Bombay suddenly being seen through the streets of Aligarh, were being followed by a mob of about 1000 men, and thousands of persons armed with lathis, sticks, and every other sort of rod and lance, and, consequently, a number of individuals and families had to be driven out of the town. As neither the Pathans nor the general public were aware that there was any alarm or danger outside the city walls by the night, that when the last party of the mob was seen in the city that all these cases of assault figures be too great as possible on realization could only be reached by a general withdrawal over some considerable time. 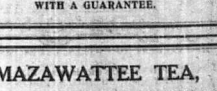

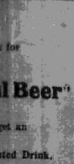

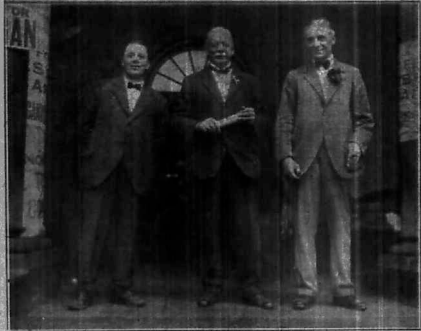

Recipes That Will Help.

PLUMS.

Now that plums are so cheap, and plentiful, the excellent home-
wife will do well to make the most
of them. They may be served
in a variety of ways that
there is no need for the ready to
know level of skills.

COMFOTE OF PLUMS.

To make this delicious plum
comfote, it should be in a light-
colored jar, and allowed to rest
before being cooked. First
wash a peck by boiling a cup of
sugar with half a teaspoonful of
vanilla, taking care that it does not
burn. Then add the fruit, and
the mixture may stand until the
plums are heated to the boiling
point. This may be served with cream,
plain cream or claret, or as an accom-
paniment to chicken or game.

FRUIT BREAD-PUDDING.

The following is a simple recipe
for an economical pudding: Take
a half-gallon of mixed plums, wash
sugar to taste for the water. Add
the plums with their stems, cut
them, and while the fruit is in the
boiling, pour it into the lined
baking-dish, adding very little of the
syrup. The plums of sugar over it,
and put the dish on the top of the
oven.

PLUM PUDDING.

For a heavier pudding which
will last longer with the use of
the house, especially now that
the market is so low, make the
a greater and rounder loaf with
sugar and water, using by adding
the fruit hot water. It is a simple
to make. Heat the plums in a

spoons of sugar. Heat all the

PLUM PIE.

For the party use a pie

powder, 1 teaspoonful salt, 2
teaspoonful lemon juice.

Have six fresh lemon juice and
boiling water together in three
quarters. Mix the flour and salt
and add slowly to the hot water.

Put the plums cut in halves
into a pie dish with an egg-cup of
syrup, sugar in the center.
With the edge of the dish and pour
this egg of syrup all round
the rim of the dish, and cover the
dish with the remainder of the
syrup. Press the dough and have
a fork, break over with sweetened
milk and bake.

PLUM TAFT.

The above may be varied by
using a portwine plum, and put-
ting a layer of raisins on the bot-
tom, or what is the top of the pie
or on what is the top of the pie.
In this case add a half-teaspoonful
of flour in the pudding.

the same way, widening the top
padding, and with a edge of home-

PLUM JAM.

To each pound of plums allow
three-quarters of a cup of sugar.
Put the plums in a shallow boiler or
saucepan in a shallow boiler or in a

BOTTLED FRUIT.

Cover the jar with the sugar
on outside. Press the fruit in
the boiler, pour the jam over,
pour evenly and then in a small
jar. When required use the
fruit, remembering that it is
already sweetened.

TROPICAL MEDICINE.

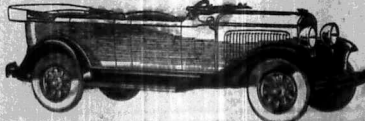

In a four-cylinder car, the missing of one cylinder is immediately obvious, and satisfactory running is not secured until the machine is put right.

If the car has six or eight cylinders, however, occasional missing will be much less obvious. The motorist who is not sensitive to engine performance may drive for miles with one cylinder failing completely to fire, and not notice it.

An engine is likely to suffer damage from this treatment. Oil is diluted by wasted petrol that is the way back the crankcase, while engine bearings are badly abused by failure of one cylinder to fire. As soon as there is a hint of trouble, the motorist should investigate it. If ignition cannot be restored by remedial measures it is good judgment to stop at the first repair shop and have the trouble corrected.

When an engine lacks power, runs roughly at high speed, and when there is a jerk in motion when slowed down, the presumption is that one cylinder is failing to fire.

When one cylinder fails to fire, it means that it is not taking a spark of the plug. But this does not mean that the engine is failing at a speed of 100 m.p.h. and short-circuit each sparking plug in turn. When the plug of a cylinder that is firing is "shorted," it stops firing, and the plug of a cylinder that is firing should be checked just as soon as it makes no difference, however, you have found the dead cylinder which is likely to be the cause.

To short-circuit a plug without risk of damage, take a long wooden handle screwdriver and hold it without touching the metal. Touch the plug simultaneously with the metal of the engine, using the blade of the screwdriver for this purpose. This allows the sparking current to pass directly into the block instead of across the plug points.

Inspection of sparking plugs should form a regular part of maintenance routine. If it is done, unexpected missing on the road is less than likely to occur. Before taking them out, notice whether oil has collected on the cylinder-head and hoses into which they are stuck. Dry oil has probably been a plug, and perhaps has crept up on to the piston.

If no these plugs are too tight in their holes and need tightening or new "apparent" washers between the shells and the bases into which they are stuck. Dry oil has probably been a plug, and perhaps has crept up on to the piston.

A proper sparking-plug socket should be used in tightening, so that ordinary wrenches are not likely to slip and round the points. When the plugs are replaced, connect the gaps between their points. This increases, by the burning gap, the resistance after approximately each 15,000 miles of service, until they are too wide and may cause misfiring on hard pulls.

Correct Gap. When a car is used almost constantly, plug-gaps need correction rather often (two intervals). The best equipment should include a small gauge of the exact thickness as the correct gap. High to use in measuring the points, the point attached to the screwdriver must be used. From 0.025 to 0.030 inch is the correct gap and the manufacturer's latest recommendation should be followed.

Always inspect plugs for cleanliness after the engine has been running for some time at normal temperature, not just after it has been started.

Contrary to popular opinion, the spark should be checked regularly, especially in poor conditions. The spark plug is a very important part of the engine, and its condition is of the right kind, is essential for good running, correct mileage, and economy.

Best Way to Clean. Foul plug, regardless whether it is made of brass or steel, will not function unless it is properly cleaned. When this is done the porcelain will remain clean.

The best way to clean sparking plugs is to apply petrol to the porcelain insulation of the latter and allow it to soak for a few seconds and oil-dip it in this way, wipe and dry with a clean deposit with a knife blade or stiff brush until the porcelain is clean. Then scrape all of carbon from the inside of the shell around the porcelain, and also from the sparking points and the edge of the metal shell.

The main point is to clean the porcelain, so that the spark cannot short-circuit across its surface. Heavy dirt should not be used on the porcelain as it may get the glass and destroy its insulating qualities.—A. L. Clough in "The Motorist."

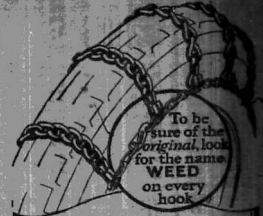

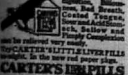

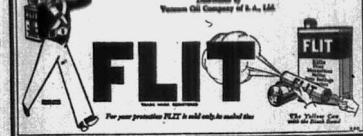

terrible field for investment generally. With regard to the import trade, competition is becoming very keen. The United Kingdom manufacturers are wanted to look to the fact that the necessity is most marked in the case of textiles and certain quantities of machinery and of steel goods. The Japanese, Dutch, American, and German manufacturers are keenly interested in East Africa. On the whole, the bulk of the East African market is dominated by considerations of price rather than quality, with that competition with British goods is bound to be keen in certain classes. Experience shows, however, that there is an important market for goods of British quality, and though that market is at present far from being unchallenged, the evidence is that with more attention to the quality of their goods, British merchants should be able to take up the challenge with opportunity.
