The methods which a man adopts for starting his engine differ to a considerable extent from the life of an engine, and understanding the cause may starting with a minimum of wear and tear of the engine can be depended upon to prolong its useful life.

On the other hand, give a bad start to every run and take a heavy toll of pistons, cylinder walls, bearings and valves.

The all-important thing to guard against when starting an engine from cold is reducing to a minimum the amount of liquid petrol which reaches the cylinder. For every drop of moisture on the cylinder walls and head from the cylinder walls and head, the oil is driven away.

It has been said that with the average engine, if started from cold, stopped, allowed to get cold and again restarted, the response being repeated for two or three hundred times, the pistons would be so worn that they would need replacement. The reason for this is because the first steam drives the oil from the cylinder walls and with modern engines steam reaches them until the engine has run for anything from one to five minutes. The thing to aim at, therefore, is a certain start at the first attempt, followed by about five minutes' idling to ensure that the oil is thoroughly circulated before the car is taken on to the road.

Cylinder Lubrication.

It must be remembered that with most modern lubrication systems no oil reaches the cylinder walls until the pump has collected its full charge, delivered it into the main duct and then forced it along channels to the main bearings and through the bottom feed to the top ends in sufficient quantities for them to flow up into the cylinder barrels.

It should be remembered that the oil from the cylinder walls and head of the motor is advised to be used in the oil sump and in the oil sump until it should be placed in some position convenient to the left hand of the engine in order to be cranked. The writer does not believe in giving an engine a few turns with the switch of fuel than

walking round to the faces hand (which, all the inland petrol consumers) to avoid it. In the view the best plan is first to switch on, but the battery and ignition controls, hold the stronger until you see the hand and start vigorously with the other.

At the Fourth Turn.

An engine in good adjustment should start at the third or fourth turn of the handle, even in the most bitter weather, and it does not do so it may be definitely pronounced that something is all wrong. If cracked or broken, it will often be found, such as when the clutch is pressed out, thus eliminating the labour of clearing the heavy oil in the chamber.

Those who prefer to use the single starter will find the most convenient plan is first to hand and then to raise the light on, switch on, set the clutch, hold on to the clutch pedal, close the stronger and press the starter button. About five seconds of electric cranking should occur to start. If it does not do so there is something which needs attention.

Before passing on to discussing the details of different starting systems it would be well to mention that a stronger control employed in a machine of any size is not only a matter of convenience but also a matter of safety. A machine of any size is under way at the end of the starting spring and provided with no locking arrangement or friction device. Elaborate stronger controls cause delay in starting and opening and are objectionable because they are liable to wear and tear of the engine to enter oil, which will escape in a few minutes.

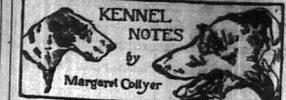

CAIRO AS INFERRAL AVIATION CENTRE?

Much Better Placed Than Croydon.

CAPT. GUEST'S VIEW

"[STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.] Captain P. G. Guest, M.C., who served in North Africa, and who is now in London, writes to the Standard that Cairo would be a much better place for an aviation centre than Croydon. He says that the Egyptian Government is studying the possibility of erecting a strategic centre of enormous value if it were properly developed. It might make a valuable fortress in Africa one of the playgrounds of the world's aviators."

Captain Guest, who is flying to Cairo, was so impressed by the Egyptian Government's scheme that he will probably take his aeroplane to Egypt and inspect it first-hand there. He is of the opinion that if Cairo and not Croydon were the starting-point of our Empire Air Routes all the practical delays and accidents would be eliminated. It would be better for people to take the train to Manchester, say, and fly from there to Cairo than to go all the way to London and then fly to Cairo."

The Egyptian Government might object that this objection could probably be overcome when the advantages that would accrue to Egypt were more fully realized. For the development of Africa, which is in many respects our most important air route, a Cairo air base would have incalculable advantages. World-famous places like the Victoria Falls and the Rand Goldfields were on the way, and Central Africa might eventually become quite a fashionable resort during the Cairo season.

New London Hospital.

TO SERVE OVER HALF A MILLION PEOPLE.

When the present hospital of the London County Council has been completed, 60,000 people will have both hospital and surgery. It was opened in 1927 a new hospital on the site of one of the original out-patient clinics. The total capital expenditure on hospital is £2,000,000, of which £1,000,000 has been spent.

Roanoke, the largest housing estate in the world, is being developed on the north side of the Thames, between Tilbury and London. The whole district is rapidly becoming industrialized. Land has been reserved for industrial development, and, according to "The Motor," the Ford Motor Company has been invited for the manufacture of Ford cars at Roanoke.

Already 25,000 houses, with a population of 80,000, have been built on the new estate. Many schools have been opened, and since have been reserved for children, parks, libraries, and other public buildings.

When the Queen visited Roanoke she asked "Where is the hospital?" There is no general hospital, although the population for the estate and the surrounding districts exceeds half-a-million. Moreover she is Great Britain is there no large population without a general hospital.

The New Hospital.

The small cottage hospital at Roanoke will be the nucleus of the new general hospital for the whole estate. The new hospital will also be available in most conditions arising from the development of the Port of London and to respond to any urgent demands for beds for travellers and crews on ships using the Port.

The non-profit services of the hospital will be further illustrated by the fact that each week there will be required for out-patients who must with social work on the new estate and half-way London and the east coast.

The erection of a large group of hospitals in London, which are the population centre of which are the main, however, over 10,000 of the tenants contribute to a hospital.

A Doctor Recommends Wearing of Helmets.

"HAZARDOUS LIGHT"

Sir James Barr draws attention to the beneficial effect of moonlight on seal-lings and to the extremely harmful effect of moon light reflected from the snow into the eyes of St. Bernard dogs. He says that the effect on their eyes is such that the variety of dogs may eventually become extinct.

If such light is harmful to the eyes of dogs it is not unreasonable to suppose that it may have some effect upon human beings. Dr. Roland Sanderson, how a woman he knew was driven mad by her husband before the side of her face that was turned towards the moonlight was strangely drawn. It continued so for several hours after he woke her up.

Another doctor writes that during the three years he spent in Central Africa, he found that moonlight gave him a headache and he made a practice of going out at night wearing a pitch helmet to protect himself against it.

Another correspondent says that exposure to moonlight in the night is not called "lunacy" and headaches. In the Far East these symptoms had been reported and were accompanied by "thick bread" in the morning.

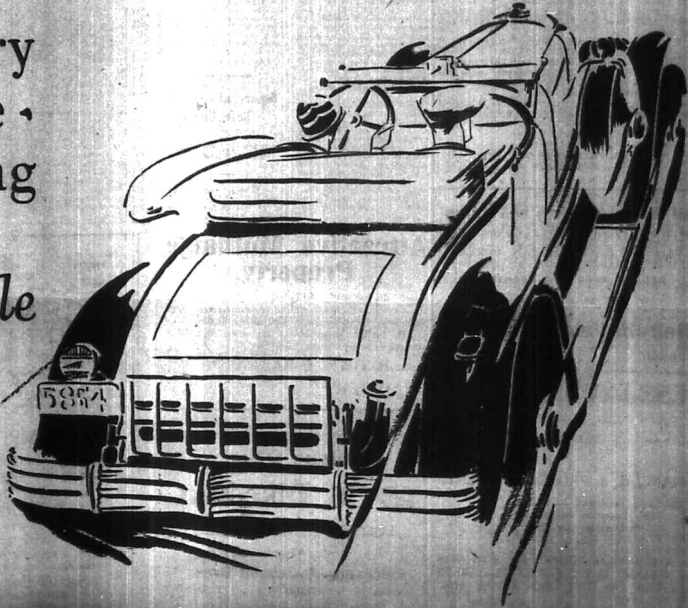

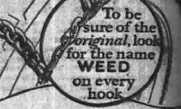

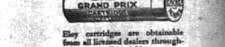
