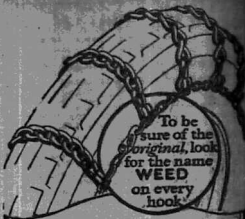

job is done by hand in the usual way. A useful tool for this purpose may be made of a piece of 1/4 inch wire which has one end driven into a piece of round wood to serve as a handle... Partly inflated the tube, against it inside the loop, and with the casting standing on the ground, pull the loop round so the casting is turned. This lays the tube smoothly and straightly in the wire. The wire loop distributes the chalk around the inner side, and if a puncture has occurred it locates the nail or other sharp object if it happens to be sticking through the casing.

STIFFENING TERMINALS. Flexible cables, such as are used for wiring various electrical accessories, often break and fray at the ends owing to lack of rigidity. This is particularly noticeable when the cables pass through holes in a box and there are two simple methods of dealing with this. In the first, when the strain only comes on the terminal, one can strengthen the loop by the use of a terminal system of the type which is made in two halves. After the insulation has been stripped from the cable, the wire is coiled round between the two halves and before the cables are closed a stiffener is inserted consisting of a piece of stout wire... The two loose ends of this wire run parallel with the cable, and are bound by insulating tape. In other circumstances, it is possible to use a certain type of liberty bellows and possible breakage or shorting the best method of strengthening the cable locally is to slip over it a piece of the outer covering of a harden wire. Should it not be possible to obtain this covering of sufficiently large diameter, fine wire can be used, as this can be obtained in any diameter from a gauge of 20 to 24.

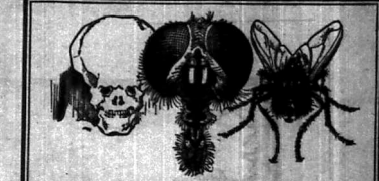

EGGS FOR APPETITE

(By Martin Magran). Eggs serve as a valuable substitute for meat, although their high nutritive value makes it necessary to use them in moderation, and to combine them with food elements rich in starch, such as rice and potatoes. There are four excellent ways of cooking them.

place over gentle heat, and when it boils break in carefully six fresh eggs. Season with a pinch each of salt and pepper, and cook for five minutes. Now set the dish in the oven and allow the eggs to cook to the harden. Being careful not to let them harden. Serve at once.

SCRAMBLED EGGS: Hard-boil six eggs; put into cold water and remove shells. Slice the eggs and place them in alternated layers with breadcrumbs, in a greased buttered baking-dish. Season each layer with a mixture of pepper, salt and chopped parsley, and before putting on the layer of breadcrumbs, pour over all a pint of cream, sauce, thick with brown sugar, and serve very hot in the same dish.

CURRIED EGGS: Hard-boil six eggs, shell them and keep them in a glass jar. Heat half a pound of butter in a deep saucepan of flour, one teaspoonful of brown sugar, and one good dash of paprika. Add a cup of chicken stock, simmer for three minutes, and pour in three cups of evaporated milk. Mix well, beat and cook until thick and creamy.

BAKED EGGS: Cook the bottom of a large, greased tin with shallow pan with half an inch of hot water. Break in very carefully six well-boiled eggs, sprinkle rather thickly with grated Parmesan cheese, salt with pepper and salt, and cook in the oven until the whites are set.



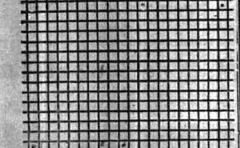

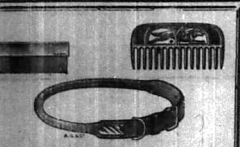
