NEW CRIMINAL CODE.

Bringing East Africa in Line with English Law.

A Bill recently published for public criticism marks what is in practice the departure of East Africa from the long-established Indian Penal Code and the substitution thereof of a penal code based principally on English law as applied to Nigeria, with certain sections retained from the Kenya law and the Indian Code.

The proposed legislation, prepared by the Colonial Office and considered by the East African Law Officers, has already been accepted by East African Government.

One of the most important changes is that the death penalty must be passed in cases where a person has been convicted of murder. Previously the law allowed for the alternative of imprisonment, and the Secretary of State considered that there was no alternative but to insist on the alternative of imprisonment.

The intention of the new Code, which is accompanied by an explanatory Bill on the subject of procedure, is to obtain uniformity in criminal law in East Africa and to bring the Supreme Court in particular as closely as possible into line with the H.M. High Court of Justice in Britain.

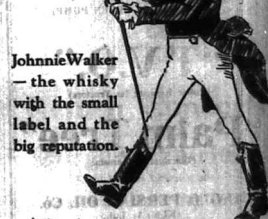

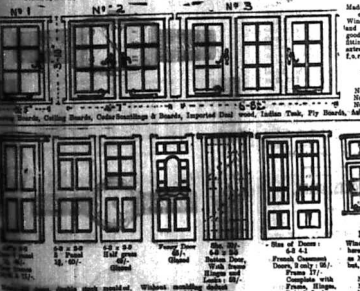
