A POT-FORRE FOR OWNER DRIVERS.

Standardizing System of Repair Charges.

IS HIGH TIRE INFLATION HARMFUL?

During the past year or two one of the most interesting new developments in the motor trade has been the adoption by many motor repairers and traders of what are called "standard repair" charges. These are what the car owner has to pay when he has his car overhauled. His car was his hobby, his pride, his life. He was not only driving, or as they say in the slang of the auto world, "keeping up his hand" in the light of an expensive hobby, like all sportsmen, was liable to prove costly. To-day for most people a car is a utility vehicle; it is a means of transport, and they like to regard it as an investment from which they will get a return in the shape of service of a reasonable order. The change of attitude, accompanied as it has been by a great expansion in car ownership, has brought to the notice of the car owner the fact that the new car owners of limited means are in condition to run their machines cheaper for repairs must be reduced to a low, a figure as small as possible. In order to do this motor firms all over the country have shops and service stations, where the most up-to-date plant and machinery are available for undertaking practically any repair job the motorist is likely to demand for his car from small alterations to a complete overhaul. A high standard of efficiency has been reached in the handling of repairs, and with the aid and co-operation of the manufacturers of most of the cars which are produced in quantity a system of standard or flat-rate charges has been evolved. Within the next twelve months this plan has been established fully, and there are reasons which fully believe that in the course of time practically all motor servicing business will run on a standard rate basis.

Standardized System. Many motor owners draw the attention of their customers to the standard charges under the standardized system, and they contend that in this way they gain the confidence of their clients. No motor owner likes paying repairs, and he is inclined to pay the bill beforehand when the particular job is undertaken, but it will be less likely to kick when the bill is rendered after the work is completed. Another point which is often mentioned is that motor owners put off getting some adjustments done, or even serious defects altered merely because they are afraid of what the repairer is going to charge them. With a schedule of flat rates before him he need not fear that he will be charged exorbitantly. Charge differential according to the kind of work to be repaired. For example, do not charge for grinding or valves, and adjusting, tappets, a maintenance allowance for oil or more than four pour or later if he does not use good oil. These things may cost about 25s. for small cars, 35s. for cars between 10 and 12 h.p., and 45s. for larger cars. The mixing of brake and the adjustment and lubrication of brake gear work at 20s. for a small car, 25s. for a 12 h.p. car and 30s. for a 20 h.p. car. Apart from actual repair work, overalls, pits, such as oiling and greasing, washing and polishing, cleaning of filters, cutwaters, plugs, and magnets, are often included in flat rate schedules so that the motorist can charge for any of these operations. One of the most satisfactory features of this development is that many of the car manufacturers are keenly interested in it, and they encourage their local agents to develop the servicing side of their business, and to adopt flat rate charges, believing that customers welcome the idea.

Tyre Inflation. Many car owners must prefer to follow the tyre pressure list drawn by the manufacturers of the cars they buy, or to have it ascertained by some authority. It is not, however, the view that high inflation of automobile tyres is harmful. The service manager of General Motors, for instance, advises that motorists to leave their tyres at a pressure of five pounds above the regulation rate. "By doing this

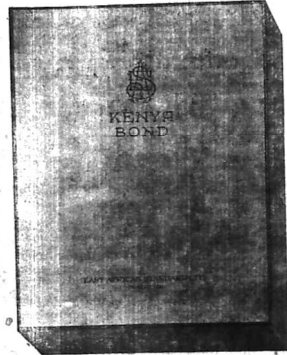

WATERS OF THE NILE PROBLEM Agreement Between Egypt and Britain. RESUME OF NOTES.

The question of rights in the waters of the Nile has for some time been the subject of negotiation between the British and Egyptian Governments, particularly in regard to irrigation work in the upper Nile.

An agreement on the subject has been reached by the exchange of notes between the Prime Minister of Egypt and Lord Lytton, the late British High Commissioner.

His Excellency the President of the Council of Ministers in His Excellency His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner in Egypt, Cairo, May 7, 1928.

1. In confirmation of our recent conversations I have the pleasure to communicate to Your Excellency the views of the Egyptian Government in regard to those irrigation questions which have been the subject of our discussions.

2. It is wished that the Egyptian Government has always been anxious to encourage such development, and will therefore continue that policy and be willing to agree with His Majesty's Government upon such an increase of this quantity as does not infringe Egypt's natural and historical rights in the waters of the Nile and the requirements of agricultural extension, subject to satisfactory arrangements for the safeguarding of Egyptian interests as detailed in later parts of the note.

1928 Nile Commission, whose reports are attached hereto, and is accompanied by the project of a General Agreement. 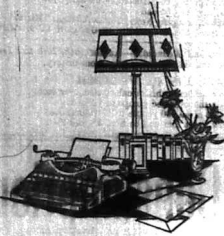
