**SOIL FERTILITY AND ITS CONTROL.**

**Importance of Plant Nutrition.**

A most important discussion took place recently at the University Building, Cape Town, in connection with the Agricultural Section of the British Association for the Advancement of Science, which was held by Sir John Russell, F.R.S., at the distinguished Hotel Victoria, the Botanical Experimental Station, England.

Dr. John Russell dealt with the factors determining soil fertility with special reference to plant nutrition, and his address is of special interest to South Africa. He defined a fertile soil as one of plants growth, adequately supplying plant nutrients, water, warmth, air for the roots, and gases for the roots, and a hard reaction. These factors were closely linked, especially plant nutrients, water supply and soil aeration; and also water, soil temperature and air supply.

The supply of plants nutrients affected crop production in two ways. Unfavourable the amount of plants growth was increased with soil fertility to a certain point. The relationship was not simple; it could be expressed by two factors, one being the minimal amount, the other the crop of the particular nutrient and the other the supply of the nutrient already present in the mineral soil. Some degree of proportionality between the various nutrients was maintained, but there was no evidence that the ratio were necessary.

**Water Supply.**

These relationships were most affected by the water supply. In general, nutrients were most effective when there was a good water supply and the water was most effective when there was a good nutrient supply. A good water supply and conversely a good nutrient supply constituted water.

For fruit, the relationships were somewhat different. Fruit and plants, being in some ways antagonistic in relation to plants. This second way in which water was affected, the plant was so

slender disease, which had been much studied by Thaler, de Toul and Green in South Africa. This disease was perhaps more common than was usually recognized in certain New Zealand soils and treated to a preliminary analysis of soils, from which they inferred growth and finally died. A similar disease had been reported to occur elsewhere in similar conditions, but the soil was not analysed. Unfortunately no assay of the soil was made, and the vegetation had been observed, but the soil was not analysed.

**Magnesium and Potassium.**

The magnesium deficiency had been attributed a disease of oats, and to magnesium deficiency a chlorosis (yellowing of leaves) of tobacco.

Potassium deficiency was usually found only in relation to nitrogen. When the ratio of potassium to nitrogen was considerably altered, the leaves became very dark green, certain leaflets due to orange or scarlet; the percentage of nitrogen compounds increased, and the nitrogen content of the leaves suffered in cooking quality, and the meat of sugar beet not only contained less sugar, but yielded more impure juice.

**Calcium Deficiency.**

Calcium deficiency was a difficult category, being closely linked up with the exchangeable bases in the soil, and with the whole body of the physical and chemical properties. It was most liable to occur in dry regions, where it resulted in an acid soil. It might occur in dry regions, however, especially where sodium chloride was present, and the sodium had displaced some of the calcium. When this replacement had proceeded beyond a certain stage, the properties of the soil were drastically altered, making it unamenable to many agricultural crops. This change was to great importance in irrigation areas, and it was an important factor in the soil effects of overwatering ("Farmers' Weekly").

## SAVE THE NEW ROADS.

### The Dangers of Ribbon-Building.

THREAT TO FREE TRAFFIC FLOW.

Very special interest attaches to a suggestion made at the recent annual general meeting of the Automobile Association by the member who recommended the extension of the main road to save the arterial roads. The advocacy of all motorists will be extended to any national proposal for ensuring that we secure every possible benefit from the new roads scheme to which we have contributed so many millions of pounds in the form of motor vehicle taxation.

The great danger definitely looming on the horizon at the moment is that the narrow width of the majority of these new roads will be accentuated unless definite steps be taken to prevent this.

By ribbon-building in narrow sections of a line of houses, shops or business premises in fact, this does not only reduce the length of the new roads. If this occurs—and it is actually occurring today—it is obvious that the ribbon-building will cut across a very large number of motor buildings and this will mean that the effective width of the carriage ways will be seriously restricted. On a 40 ft. road with a line of 5 ft. ribbon buildings on each side there is barely enough room for three lines of motor traffic and not a through-traffic road is not an efficient traffic artery.

Width and Safety Synonymous. One of the principal objections to the three lines of traffic road is that the faster vehicles—

whether they are travelling or being overtaken, are bound when overtaking to make use of the "centre" strip in the middle and here they may encounter, with disastrous results, the slow-moving traffic of the main road coming towards them. The same argument can be applied to any busy thoroughfare with a width up to the five-line limit, and it only remains, as Mr. Heenan demonstrated, to compare the road to be given up with six lines of traffic with the road to be given up with four or less—traffic safety can be assured.

It is sometimes suggested that ribbon-building should be permitted on the main roads, but this should be arranged in rows at right angles to the main road. Such a method of construction would certainly prevent the roads in which were formerly congested districts resembling nothing but prolonged suburban streets; it would however, unquestionably mean that there would be a very large number of side roads from which vehicles would debouch and inevitably reduce materially the speed of traffic flow on the main thoroughfares.

In view of the fact that the principal object of the new roads is to enable traffic to move rapidly along them, this ribbon-building does seem to be possibly certain, very definite drawbacks, and it should not be encouraged except as a last resort. So far as ribbon-building is concerned, if we discern the policy now of what should be country roads lined with buildings on either side—there is little to be achieved if it were in so far as the continuous line of buildings means many stationary motor vehicles and consequent congestion.

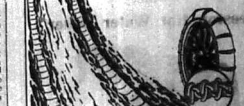
This objection to ribbon-building is so obvious that it is not necessary to elaborate it. It is obvious that it is possible to retain stationary vehicles without actually reducing the effective width of the main road, and this could be achieved by stipulating that whenever a building is erected by the road side it shall be so placed that in front of it there will be an

# WEED TYRE CHAINS

It is possible for town-planning bodies to make provision for more or less similar conditions in urban areas there should be no great difficulty in carrying this idea in force and preventing a trouble that will otherwise mean main thoroughfares.

**Psychology's Aid to Industry.**

enlightening subject. Its appeal is one that will become more widely shared with the great advance which the objective sciences are making in the present generation and with the growth of their combined contribution to human comfort and knowledge. Each discovery in the scientific world has a reaction on the conditions of life; human nature, not always rapid in its capacity for adjustment, changes less quickly than the conditions brought about by scientific research and applied discovery and in psychology we find a link and contact between the human senses and instincts and the vast material world whose evolution brings upon its inhabitants a more and more increasing pressure. Professor Myers has indicated, however briefly, something of the great field of usefulness which the study of human experience, feelings and emotions opens up in their relation to man's own happiness and contentment. He has provided in his lecture an indication of simple tests applied with definite objects and suggested something of the great importance and value of the scientific tests and the knowledge which they yield. He might, too, have indicated the progress of an accumulation of what he might be called "square men in round holes," but instead of concluding that scientific knowledge will come into play by reason, let us take the standard of ability and scientific induction rather, as he believes, the probability of a more beneficial discovery. New Orleans such as Myers, with her mind as a model, native people thought, equally within the orbit of a higher civilization, the scientific and the progress to the trained professional. To him there must be provided the realisation of the equipment necessary for the tasks which face us in all directions of endeavor. His duties are, however, by contact with the positive and the great and urgent need for knowledge. In a of conference a few years ago the Government of Kenya set aside a small sum of money for a preliminary study of the possibility of the African and the restraint of the native peoples to their own senses and environment; their spiritual beliefs and the suggestions conveyed to them by the winning of a new civilisation. It was obvious that promising field of local research was found. Perhaps the lecture which has been delivered by Professor Myers will do us to open it again with a growth of more abiding enthusiasm or it may induce him to keep before us the robustness of our land for properly conducted study, as that when the moment is ripe we may have the attention of those who come under his instruction to the opportunity of service to humanity which lies in these territories.

Each worker brings to his task a set of qualifications for that task; the work itself imposes upon him certain conditions for the operation of his abilities and the task of the psychologist in industry is to discover by test and selection, and to improve by training, the best qualified man for a specific task and the task best fitted the inherent qualifications of workers. 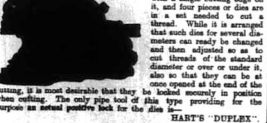

Baiting Methods.

The brain methods of Agency reserves which remain in the trees on our farms might be at present very serious. Following the instructions as to preparation of bait tablets published, found the quantities of arsenic for the district may be had on application to the County Engineer or the District Commissioner of the District. Farmers should provide their own stocks of bait.

The bait is best hung out in the early morning on bare spaces near the trees in which the locusts are nesting. This if done well, will effect the destruction of a portion of the swarm. It is not an operation from which swarms are inevitable. Care should be taken to spray any swarms of locusts that are kept away from baited areas, as the destruction of bait for firing swarms requires to be somewhat thicker (one 100 lbs per acre) than the thin spraying of bait used on hopper bands, and the locusts should not be disturbed.


