THE POULTRY WORLD.

BREEDING THE FIRST CROSS.

Unreliable Birds.

It often happens that I am asked for the addresses of men who sell first crosses for sale; and the answer is, I have never such letters on hand. The average poultry farmer does not, as a rule, bother himself with first crosses, except in the case of wanting to make up a few special bred pullets to a certain number, and not having numerous pullets to make a pen, add a few of a different breed and distinctive colored eggs to avoid under-mating and yet have the fear of getting the eggs mixed. Such birds are usually well bred, as the pure level, and will cost just as much to rear, but when they are ready for sale buyers do not expect to give as much for them as for the pure bred stock. It is not very easy to make a paying proposition of poultry farming in this country where one is so liable to many things which cause mortality amongst the stock, as all practical poultry farmers have to consider what one can do so long in the best returns.

Personally, I cannot see the use of breeding first crosses. The only time I do it is under the circumstance noted above, and such stock goes into the egg production pen and is not bred, as a number is it added, except to make runs for younger birds. We all breed of many kinds in the country, as they should do all requirements in their pure strains. Other cross-breds should be pure bred of a different breed, and breeding from the progeny of a first-cross will most probably, in the next generation, bring out the worst points in each of the original breeds and instead of the stock improving it will deteriorate.

If I know a number of people in Kenya do not agree with the one on the other, but after years of practical poultry farming I still have four my own experience that I am right. Suppose for another, we take a few crosses: White Leghorn and Rhode

Island Red? The White Leghorn is bred for egg laying, breed, the size being to get large eggs and many of them. The Rhode Island is in some cases a good and useful utility, and will perform that it is desired to have a White Leghorn cock and Rhode Island hen. The progeny from this mating will probably be, as far as the cockerets are concerned, white with splashes of red in plumage. The pullets for the most part will furnish fair table birds, but not so good in quality as the pure Rhode Island. The pullets will lay well, but not so well as the pure Leghorn; some will go broody, but will be in many cases untrustable. The eggs will be mixed and should be kept

Suppose these first cross pullets are mated back to a pure bred Rhode Island Cockerel, in accordance with what I said. The resulting cockbirds will be red with plenty of splashes of white; they will then be pure Rhode Island, and pullets will be mostly mixed and splash. These cockbirds will come up, and come down, and some half and half, the egg producing qualities will be distinctly mixed, there will be a number of unreliable brooders, and they will moult heavily, going right off laying for some time. With all these matters it will be found that on each generation there will be more and more under-bred birds. It is difficult to see how there will be any breeding from pure bred stock, but the stock will deteriorate much quicker when crossed.

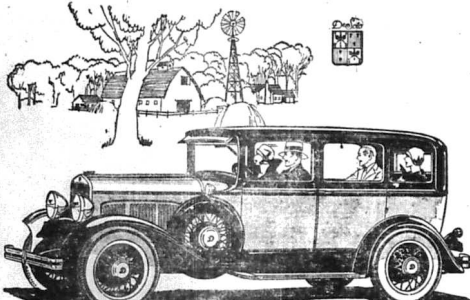

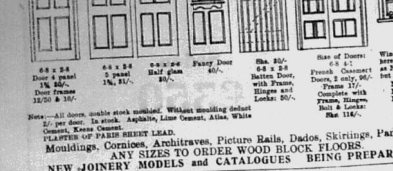

A blow in the head of the character is most likely to be due to the filler becoming so dirty that it should accordingly be removed and cleaned. The best method of doing this is to pour clean kerosene oil to pour down the filler to clean the filler in the reverse direction to normal, so that particles of dirt will be carried away from the turbine instead of being washed into them. Holding the piece close to the lip and suction is another fairly satisfactory means of cleaning but on no account should any attempt be made to poke out dirt with a pin, as it is very easy to damage fine passages in this manner.
