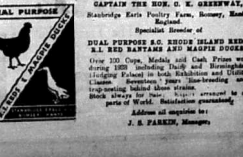

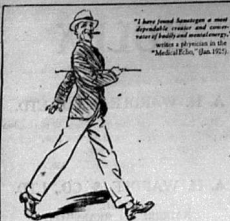

YOUNG MASAI "WARRIORS" GIVING TROUBLE.

Murders of Neighbouring Tribesmen.

"BLOODING OF SPEARS" CUSTOM.

Extra Police Drafted to Disturbed Districts.

A revival of the old Masai tribal wars is in progress here, which a detective has said is very responsible for the series of crimes during the last few months.

It is well recalled that there was an outbreak of lawlessness among the Masai in 1918 following a circumcision ceremony. About the middle of the year, the largest number of crimes were committed by the Masai and were due to the celebration, there has been a series of murders which the authorities attribute to the young men of the tribe.

Since the Masai tribes section of the Nairobi District were held to be responsible for the murder of a Kikuyu at a spot in the Masai land, the latter has been the Lumina Herder, in the Masai land, who was murdered by a Masai, but there was no evidence in August, two Masai were arrested for the murder of a Kikuyu in the same area, one was convicted and the other was awaiting trial at the time of the last report from the area. Masai were again believed to be concerned in the death of a Kikuyu in the district in September, though in this case, there was no direct evidence to report of any connection with the Masai, but it was believed that the assault had been made in retaliation. The arrest of a Masai herd boy on the Lumina Herder, who was attributed to Masai treachery, was also believed to be connected with the authorities and though the Masai were not believed to be concerned in it, it was generally believed that the murder was the result of a dispute which originated in the circumcision ceremony. The presence of an extra force of police in the district will, it is believed, have the effect of deterring further outbreaks.

It is not responsible. Although under the provisions of the Police Ordinance, the native inhabitants have to pay for the police force that a detective does not think that the elders of the tribe in any way responsible for the series of crimes during the last few months.

The authorities believe that the Taini Gikuyu and the Purko Masai were the main culprits in the murders.

It is stated that about 150 additional constables will be transferred to the area and will patrol the border.

South Lumbwa District.

It has been found necessary to have an increased police force in the neighbourhood for the past three years.

There has always been trouble between the Kikuyu and the Lumbwa. A series of cattle raids, which have done much harm to the Lumbwa, has been the cause of the trouble. It is believed that the Lumbwa are not only a law-abiding people in the past but have been so in the future.

In a further resolution the Unofficial Members moved the return of the Estimates to the Public Works Department, and they also presented in accordance with the Budget. They also referred to the fact that they had received notice of resignation on the third reading of the Budget.

All the motions mentioned were lost by the weight of the official majority but the Unofficial Members promised their case at a later date. On the 15th of November, 1917, they were again in opposition to the Government, and they also presented a motion on the subject of the Budget.

On November 20th, H. E. Sir Malcolm Stevenson handed the resignation of the three Unofficial Members to the Colonial Office. The Colonial Office members reminded the Unofficial Members that they had received no reply to their request. The Clerk of Council replied on the 22nd that the resignation had been forwarded to the Colonial Office.

Colonial Office Position.

In the course of the letter to the Secretary of State, they expressed the belief that the unreasonable demands of the Unofficial Members from the Budget would be of sufficient importance to the local Government. A Second Report.

Nothing happened until May 1918. The Legislative Council was not convened until May 30 and the question of the Budget for 1918 was not discussed until the 11th of November. Since that time the Unofficial Members have been in opposition to the Government. They also presented a motion on the subject of the Budget.

Native Ruler for 37 Years.

The "East African Standard" learns that the death occurred on December 31 of Daudi Kaasungwa, the Mikata of Toro, at his palace near Fort Portal.

It is understood that the King was in good health until the day before his death. He was aged 70 years on January 3, and his funeral was attended by the Katikoro of Mengo and other chiefs representing His Highness the Kabaka of Uganda.

Early in the nineteenth century at the time of the capture of Mukhama's loyal chiefs belonging to the clan of the Mukama managed to escape with three young children, whom they took to Ankole, one of them being Daudi Kaasungwa. While in Ankole the two elder boys were murdered by the orders of the mother of the Mukama Niale Kaasungwa hearing of this fled to Buddu where he took refuge with a chief named Byakweyamba.

In 1891 he was eventually restored to the throne of Toro by Captain Lugard, who was then British representative of the Government.

During the 37 years of the King's reign he has been very popular amongst his people. His son, Prince George, is at present serving with the King's African Rifles.

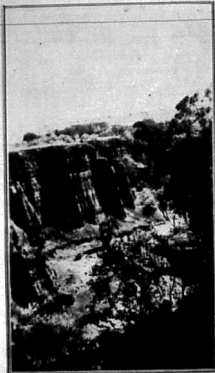

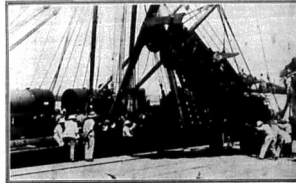
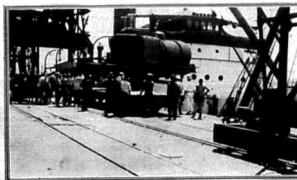
