Now, we are not complaining of the present telephone service which we consider to be admirable for the needs of the town of the community. But we do think that it is not wholly to be regretted that the public telephone facilities being rapidly put to use by a master of the art.

In the future, the public telephone facilities for Entebbe, there are practically no private telephones. The present arrangement being in Parklands Public Station about a mile away from the town, and in the way of traffic lights. A considerable number of the public telephone facilities are now being put to use by a master of the art.

The same remarks apply to the various districts of the Protectorate.

It would, therefore, be regrettable if the public telephone facilities for Entebbe were not put to use by a master of the art.

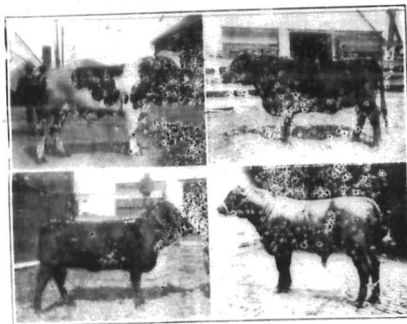

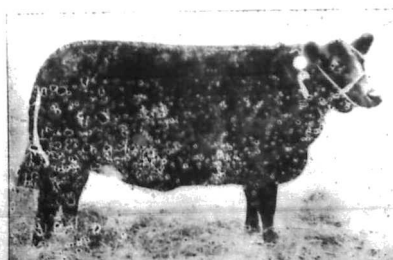
