"Ultimately the Destiny of the Country Rests on the White Settler."

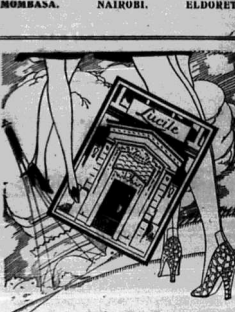

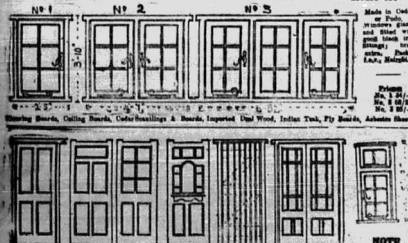

Nairobi Public Opinion.

It is proposed to call a public meeting in Nairobi to-morrow afternoon to consider the formation of some organization to enable the people of Nairobi to express their opinion of matters of public importance. While it is not improbable that the number for Nairobi North, who is in the point of leaving the Colony, will find the meeting an opportunity for addressing his constituents upon the future plans of the primary school for the meeting is to discuss the best methods of giving to the people of the Capital some representative which will enable them to express their opinion to be known and taken into account. The organization takes its proper place in the consideration of problems affecting the Colony as a whole. For some time we have heard the importance of such a step. Following the most successful in Nairobi, a small committee was voluntarily formed to draw up a scheme for consideration by a public meeting. They formulated the proposals on April 27th. They outlined the proposed formation of a body to be known as the "Nairobi Association" and membership of which would be open to all the voters in the town. It was further suggested that the Association should appoint the same officers and an Executive Committee of five representative members. This latter being the body upon which they devolve the responsibility for protection if the opinion of Nairobi. Among the aims of the Association would be the completion of the Victoria Road by securing the addition of every portion required to give satisfaction at various points and the provision of representative to the public to express their views on occasions of important importance. These are the suggestions which have been prepared for consideration by the public meeting to-morrow, with the important question that the public themselves shall decide the ultimate form they desire any organization to take. Our own position has been clear and our attitude consistent. Having in mind the past history of political associations in Nairobi, and the fact that the majority of the members of the other associations have expressed the opinion of forming another association and have agreed the selection of a committee to represent the views of the public upon matters of public opinion, we are ready to undertake the responsibility of forming such a public association and ready to call a public meeting when the occasion requires the expression of a general view. We believe, in the present conditions, that the only sound way with a chance of success. Associations find themselves in early stages of their formation, they are more representative, they are restricted by complicated conditions, they are at the mercy of the public body and, as a history has disclosed, it is a hard business for them, they are relatively new to them, they distinguish themselves as easily, leaving the public in a worse position than before. There is an assurance at the moment that the meeting to-morrow will be representative of that it will have the support of the handful of public opinion, who are known to be in the general public. Should it not be a representative gathering, the meeting will be jeopardized rather than assisted by any damage by such a meeting to take any form.

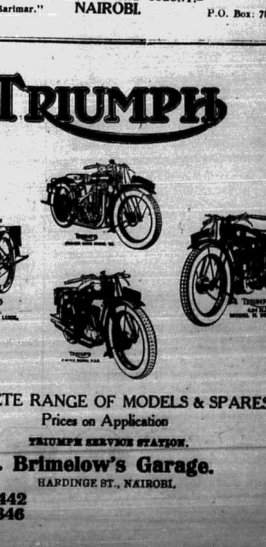

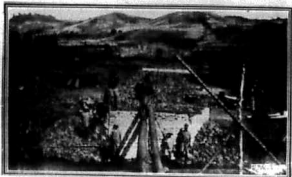

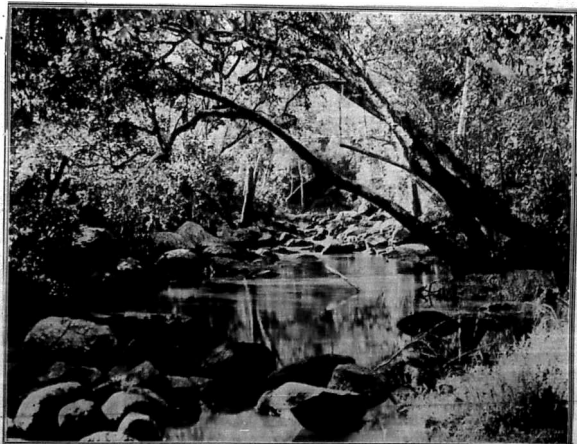
