REASSURING THE NATIVE.

Ginnery Problem Caused by Industry Itself.

His Excellency the Governor of Uganda, Sir William Gowers, replied to some of the main criticisms of the Cotton Commission Report in an address to the Uganda Legislative Council last week. His reply was direct and candid

Sir William explained that Government had agreed in 1927 to the principle of Co-operative Cotton Buying Asso-ciations on receiving an assurance that such combina-tion would not be used to depress the price to the grower. He sided that the institution of Associa-tions had aroused bestifiting and disciplinations. grower. He sided that the institution of Associa-tions had aroused hestility and distrust among the Nativer Souterd by Indiam middlemen. It was most desirable that this should be rectified and it seemed nothing short of the firation of a minimum price would give that reassurance to the Native.

The Gorenzer amounced his intention of inviting repre-centatives of the industry to a conference with him and his advisors. He hoped a "modus virende" would be reached for 1939 bits it would be impossible in the time to bring in legislation to give effect to many of the commendations without causing disturbance which be was unwilling to contemplate.
