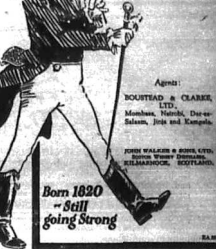

The Department of Agriculture has issued a long crop report, the first for the 1920-20 season, dealing with European and Native areas.

The Indian crop report is the first published in respect of the 1920-20 season, dealing only with the areas under the main crops and the progress attending those crops.

The publication of the report is noteworthy because the paucity of the number of returns sent in is correspondingly low, and the returns in which many of the returns actually submitted were rejected.

The paucity of returns referred to the figures given in this report is regarded as being fully representative of each district.

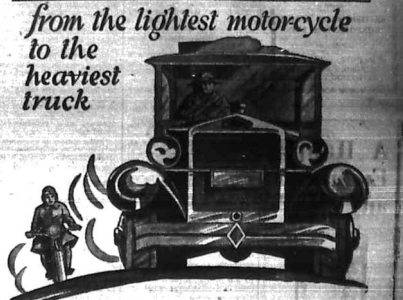

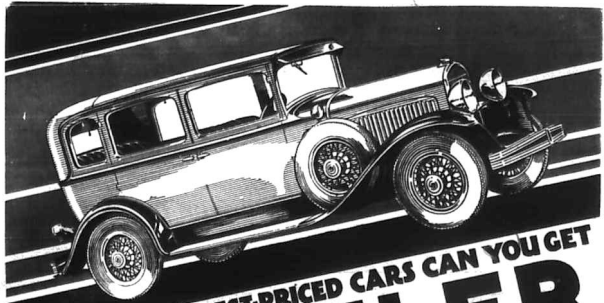

SOUTH AFRICAN STUDENTS RUGBY TOUR

Further Steps in Regard to Proposed Visit.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY FOR THE PARTY.

Rugby Union Meeting to Decide.

Events are moving towards a definite outcome of the proposal that a party of South African students should be invited to make a Rugby tour of the Colony. The suggestion is in the public eye for some weeks and of recent days there have been forces at work steadily pushing forward the scheme, covering up the ground work for such a tour, drawing up facts, relating to the financial aspect of the undertaking, and including committees in order that the authoritative body may examine some price to divide the delicate sections in the proposal.

It is a new scheme, such as in the sporting life of the Colony, and its proponent, Mr. O. Wadsworth, has worked hard and successfully towards bringing the visit to be an accomplished fact. Recently a committee was organized to go into the subject and draw up a report for submission to the Rugby Union of Kenya, and it is understood that this is now ready, and will be submitted to the governing body of the sport at a meeting to-morrow evening.

A New Programme.

Some time ago, when the present steps were what might be termed in their infancy, an itinerary was drawn up, and this was published with a view to obtaining the opinion of clubs through-out the Colony on it, and also to permit of suggestions as to the way of alterations being submitted. Again, this itinerary was circulated among the various clubs, and as a result of the expression of opinion a number of changes were suggested. These have had effect in a new programme which has been completed, and this will be submitted, along with the report, for the Union's consideration and approval.

A glimpse at the itinerary, which is appended, will suffice to show the time with which it has been compiled. It is detailed in every respect, and should be regarded as a proposal, which is intended to be modified in places of interest through-out the Colony, as the case may be. It is understood that the itinerary and report, not being of a widely spreading nature, depending on landing, entertainment and travelling expenses, party as to the various towns, the particular clubs visited, and the programme for the tour of the trip.
