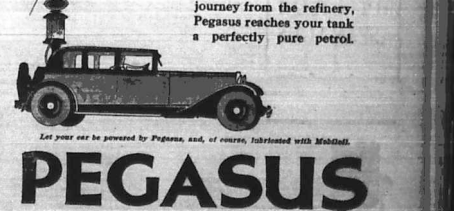

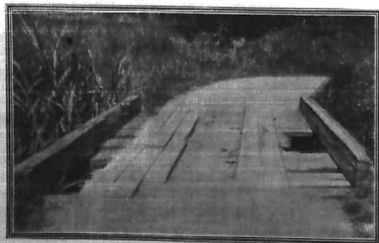

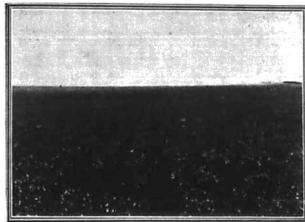

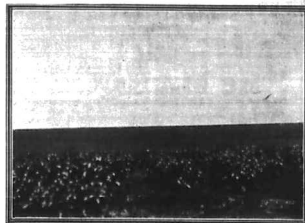

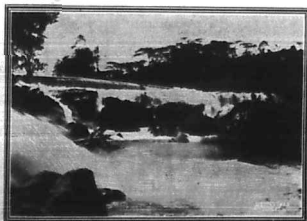

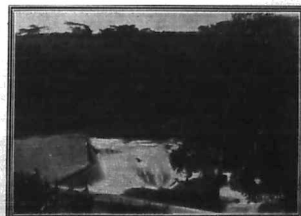

Some months ago, when the question of a Coffee Institute was under consideration, a representative meeting of the Coffee Planters Union of Kenya and East Africa appointed a Special Committee to enquire into and report on methods which should be adopted for the improvement of the general conditions affecting the industry.

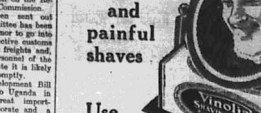

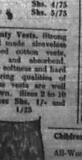

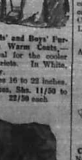
