New Daily and Weekly Newspaper in Eastern Africa.

The "East African Standard" has pleasure in announcing that a company under the name of East African Standard (Tanganyika) Limited, has been registered in Dar-es-Salaam and will publish a new daily and weekly newspaper to be known as the "Tanganyika Standard."

Specimens have been obtained in Windsor Street, Dar-es-Salaam, and the printing works will be equipped with the latest machinery acquired for the proper establishment of this new development of the newspaper and printing business in East Africa.

Captain Claude Anderson, Managing Director of the "East African Standard," is empowered to undertake the preliminary work connected with the publication of the newspaper.

The Editor of the "Tanganyika Standard" will be Mr. John Mwanja a member of the editorial staff of the "East African Standard" and an experienced journalist who, prior to his association with the "E. A. Standard," was in London, daily and English Provincial journals.

The Works Manager will be Mr. J. H. Horrocks, for many years on the technical staff of the "Standard" in Nairobi.

Mr. L. S. Vincent Njapan, Accountant of the firm, becomes Manager of the new Tanganyika Company.

The European staff will number six and the printing works will be fully manned and equipped.

The proprietor, East African Standard, Ltd. has already received many expressions of congratulatory sympathy upon the decision to extend the business to Tanganyika and most encouraging support has been given by the commercial community throughout East Africa.

The knowledge and experience of the newspaper requires, in addition to the printing, composing and typesetting of the "East African Standard" will be the call of the "Tanganyika Standard."

The premier duty and responsibility of the newspaper will be care for the interests of Tanganyika, and the progress of East Africa as a whole in its constituent parts.

The question of up-country grading came before the Nairobi Chamber of Commerce on Thursday when the following memorandum dealing with the question of up-country grading was submitted by the Mails and Weights Committee, was submitted by Mr. B. H. Henderson.

"This Committee was held at its first meeting on Tuesday, November 10th, 1919, here with a view of the grading, and really the main discussion took place on Island Grading and the question of grading certificates.

"As instructed by your Finance Committee I paid particular attention to the question of up-country grading. I also attach a memorandum which I drew up on the subject and presented to the committee. I might state that all the members of the committee have read the memorandum in its entirety and the committee was in entire agreement that grading certificates should be in force at the earliest possible moment.

"The Director of Agriculture at the time of my proposal this proposition. There was very considerable discussion, but it was ultimately agreed that:

"1. Island grading should be made available for both mail and parcel post and should be limited to those centres in which sufficient stock exists to justify the purpose.

"That the system in the meantime should be confined to one grade at Kitale with the 20s. minimum at Eldoret and one grade at Nanyuki where could be necessary grading at Molo.

"Grading certificates would not be issued at these up-country centres, but all such graded would be marked accordingly, and when they arrived down at Kilindiini the check would then be taken by the Graders there, which the necessary grading certificates would be issued.

"The Director of Agriculture remarked that he would find it extremely difficult if not impossible to secure trustworthy graders locally if it was there now, suggested that he get into communication with the Agricultural Department of the Union of South Africa, and try to arrange for two graders to be seconded to him for a few months here. Graders to be seconded from South Africa's stock season coincides with Kenya season. Therefore, this appeared to be a useful manner to secure qualified graders to the work.

"It is hoped above mentioned graders carry out their duties as heretofore directed to the cost for grading.

- "Working on the last year's grain was a reduced crop and even taking into consideration the above notwithstanding, it was estimated from a balance sheet prepared by the General Manager of the Post and Telegraph Association. A KENYA MAN-EATER.

Campaign Success Against Elephant Poachers.

The 1928 Report of the Kenya Department, recently published, makes many interesting facts known. Captain A. T. A. Ritchie believes to be a hunting party in the history of the game policy of the Colony. The period under review is the first introduction of several important changes including prohibition of "shots" of game as a part of the duties of the Department, and the restriction of the sale of the license in order that the value of the trophy and the cost of the license may bear a closer relation to the value of the animal.

The year was also of interest in another respect. It was the first man-killing lion for many years since the lion was shot in the park.

Considered generally, the 1928 Report is perhaps rather more optimistic and of less general interest than its immediate predecessor.

The following extracts are taken from the report: The sum realized by the sale of Game Licenses during the year was £11,973. This was an increase of £1,000 on the £10,973 of 1927. The decrease in Game Licenses can be explained immediately by the fact that the number of licenses issued in consequence of the change from the old system. There were also fewer headmen's licenses issued.

The revenue from the sale of ivory and condenser trophies amounted to £12,210. 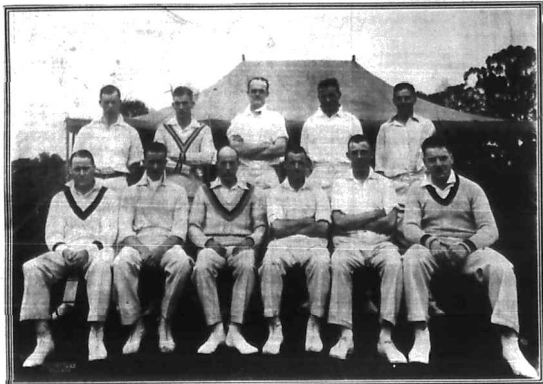

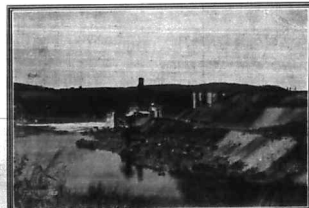

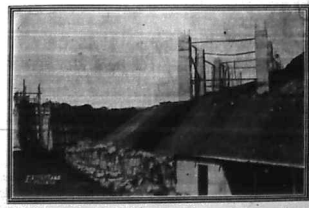

PREHISTORIC MAN IN KENYA.

Interesting Lecture by Mr. L. S. R. Leakey.

On Tuesday evening at the First Mansel Hall, Mr. L. S. R. Leakey, lecturer on "Further Evidence of Prehistoric Man in Kenya." The lecture was an extremely interesting one and did a resume of the work conducted in Kenya by Leakey and other archaeologists and geologists.

Mr. H. L. Sikes, Director of Public Works, presided under the auspices of the Kenya and Uganda Societies. Mr. Leakey had followed the discovery and researches of Mr. Leakey's interest and pride.

Mr. Leakey, during the course of his lecture, said he intended giving an outline of the work done in the district the past season before he returned to the University to publish the results in 1921. He hoped to spend some time in the district in a representative collection of the bones of the Nairobi Museum and also to the Research Institute which he hopes to start this Colony in 1921.

He wanted a copy of the "Proceedings of the Government of Kenya" in view of the fact that the public works department had subscribed money towards this purpose.

Miss Lake Nakuru was gradually dwindling and so her part was given to Mr. C. E. de Keyser. At the close of the Gumberton period there was a period of relative quiet in which lakes dried up.

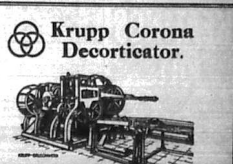

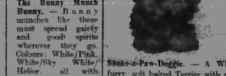
