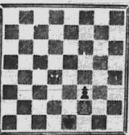

Danger of a Split in Nationalist Party.

Below is the second of a series of articles dealing with the recent change in the political outlook in the Union of South Africa particularly in regard to questions affecting its position in the Empire.

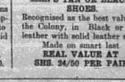

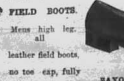
