





A sensation was caused in the Legislative Council on Friday when following the announcement by Government of a desire to recommit the Native Lands Trust Bill to Committee for consideration of amendments sug-60 Committee for consideration of amendments sug-gested by the Secretary of State, the Elected Members through the Hon, Conway Harvey announced their intention of leaving the house in a body (Mr. Malik dissenting) if the motion was proceeded with.

The proposed amendment to which the Elected Members took strong exception deals with the provision that in the case of any excision of land from Native Reserves for public purposes an area equivalent in value should be added to the Reserve elsewhere.

The proceedings of the Council came to a standstill and His Excellency asked Elected Members to wait until Government considered their position. After an adjustment of half an hour His Excellency returned and agreed to withdraw the measure until next session. In the interval he will report the position to the Secretary of State.

The Elected Members maintained that the proposed amendment was impracticable and wrong in principle.




