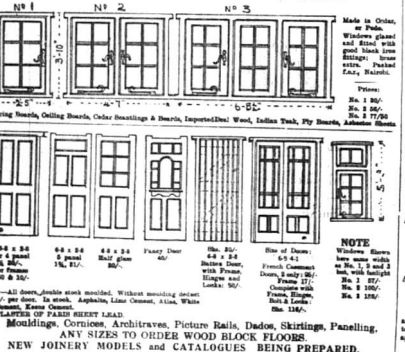

THE FISHING SEASON

"STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.

Nairobi, December 29. All traffic has recently been held up in this area and hence news has been scarce. However, summer weather now prevailing—dry winds and sun-drenched mountains—was weathering through again.

Great sport is being enjoyed by the fortunate few fishermen on the head trout streams. ... The fish are being taken in the kitchen of the Silverback Hotel—largest sport hotel—under two pounds weight, during the rains—that is for the last three months or so—wild rivers have been in spate and fish have freely descended thence.

Mr. and Mrs. Martin Johnson, and their party reported excellent sport on the upper waters of the Lake on many occasions two or three fish having been hooked by one or the other or several and over an unstarved pool.

Great reports are also received from the Harpoot and Omburi rivers and other head streams and it is an estimated run of up to 100 fish of salmon size to be taken from the upper waters of the Nairobi especially in the lower reaches of the river where the water is so cold and as the water is so cold, the fish are in the habit of jumping out of the water and are expected during the last few weeks to be in the habit of jumping out of the water.

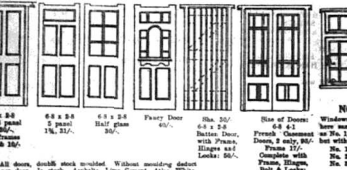

FERMENTATION OF COFFEE.

Preliminary Notes by Agricultural Chemist.

RESULTS OF EXPERIMENTS

Reports on Samples of Treated by Different Methods

Will eventually be placed to serve two cells, the whole range along into the dividing wall. The cell doors are of the heavy iron-plate variety, made by the F.W.D. studded with iron bolts and fitted with automatic locks. These, I was informed are of the very latest type used in English gaols. The doors have small lattice openings so that the warden can examine the cell completely at any time. A little further on we come to the orderly room, where complaints are heard and arrangements made for offences against prison discipline. We then visit one of four "association wards." These are large airy rooms each capable of sleeping accommodation for 30 prisoners, one of these rooms is being temporarily used as a hospital. Here we saw the prison sick, with a native European doctor at Mulago Hospital attending to his patients. A European doctor from Mulago visits regularly and he has an Indian sub-assistant surgeon to help him.

The Punishment.

It is this single cell system that the authorities hope will prove the most effective way of dealing with crime in Uganda. The native or the ordinary villager or town dweller is not so likely to be tempted to do what he is told in this prison as promptly. He knows his fate. This is desired because it takes his woman about to lock and marry. He has to do every manual job for himself and for others. But above all, even those to look and assist with his fellow-prisoners, often for into the night, and generally about working at all but unskilled it is a conversation. Now at six p.m. after his day's work is over he is locked in his little cell with no possible chance of exchanging a word with anyone. At six o'clock the next morning, his cell is unlocked, and after taking up his day's work, each has meals—and returns to his cell for another 12 hours. This is undoubtedly going to have very far-reaching effects, especially upon the minds of the habitues who used to have no fear of prison. Without doubt, when a prisoner has completed his term he is going to talk of this system to all and sundry and it is believed that the native will think very hard before putting himself in danger

of the same experience. The gaol in Kampala has long been too small to allow of the proper segregation of prisoners, and it is believed that the new building will be chiefly housed in Association wards. The possibility of collision in the matter of attempts to escape and the making of arrangements for further escape of prisoners remains when their terms should have expired. Training the Govnet.

Later, when the prison is completely ready an association ward will be transformed into a cell block, and a number of the very best of any working business, very delicate perhaps but yet a prisoner's shop will have a shadow tent behind him.
