

(4.) "Mortgage of land" means a lease mortgage, or one resulting automatically with a lease mortgage.

(5.) "Land" means a statutory piece of land, not less than one acre in extent, which is permanently occupied and which is not being cultivated or used for grazing purposes.

(6.) "Note of land" means a preliminary note, with or without evidence, according to the circumstances, of the land.

It is seen that the only security which the Board is empowered to accept for an advance is a factor in the case of a note of land, advances cannot be given by the Board for notes of land in the Lands Office against the land and a corresponding endorsement on the title deed.

Other securities are, in practice, accepted as collateral security, but the endorsement of land by the Board is a new one for the granting of a note of land, the small number of holders of Crown Lands under Agreement of Purchase referred to above. Applications may be made on land at the date of their application if the purpose of the advance is to purchase a farm. In such cases transfer of the property to the applicant must be registered simultaneously with the passing of a bond to the Land Bank.

**Purpose of Loans.**

Having in mind that the purpose of the Land Bank is to promote agricultural and pastoral pursuits, not merely to lend money, the reason for what might otherwise appear to be a rather to quibbling application form will be appreciated. The purpose to which advances are to be applied are quite thoroughly scrutinized by the Land Bank then would be the same as with ordinary commercial firms advancing money on simple security. Character, financial ability and past records of farming operations are all taken into consideration, as well as the value of the property on which the advance is to be made, and the value of the property, which administering the Land Bank, who accordingly issue upon a definite policy suited to their objects, the advances sought up to the amount.

The Government could make it considerably clear that the development of Empire was not the prerogative of any party and was a matter of public policy and was the accepted policy of every Government of this day.

Political diplomacy was good but why not trade diplomacy as well? Government was going to revive commercial diplomatic posts in Columbia, Brazil, Argentina, Brazil and Argentina. It was going to create new posts in Finland and strengthen diplomatic representation in Egypt, China, Canada, South Africa, East Africa and West India. In view of the success of our economic relations to South America, it was suggested that Mr. Pakenham should be invited to visit the Americas to study the situation.—British Official Wireless Service.

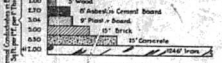

## SIXTH AVENUE RAILWAY CROSSING.

### Failure of the Warning Bell.

#### A COURT STORY.

Gatekeeper Admits the Bell Wire was Broken by Train.

Once again the question of whether the warning bells were ringing at the Sixth Avenue level crossing at a certain time occupied the attention of the Resident Magistrate's court for a considerable time on Friday morning.

The question arose as the result of charges against a European, in which it was alleged that he had attempted to drive a motor and some other level crossing when he knew that a train was approaching.

As a result he was caught between the gates after they had closed. The Magistrate, Mr. S. H. Cleverly, after studying the information on the file for a few minutes, remarked that he was unable to read, it as it was so badly written. The Court Prosecutor explained the case. He said that the driver of a fuel train was approaching Nairobi at about 6.30 when he saw a locomotive on standing on the permanent way. The train had been signalled and had the right of way. If the driver of the train had not been keeping a sharp look-out, in spite of the signals being correct, he would have smashed into the car.

The accused pleaded "not guilty." Evidence was produced by the Crown in support of their story. The engine driver of the train identified the accused as being the man who was driving the car that was stopped between the gates, and said that there was another man in the car at the time. The accused told him that the car

was under control also while this. The European who was with the accused corroborated this statement. He stated definitely that he had been standing at the crossing at the time the train was passing, and that he had seen the car stop between the gates, he got out and spoke to the native gatekeeper, and told him that it was a "short of the bell." When the driver of the train came up to him he told him that it was a "short of the bell," and he alleged that the driver agreed and said that the boy was always the same.

**Delay in Bringing Case.**  
 The native gatekeeper remembered the occasion and said that the bells were sounding as the car approached. He stated ringing the bell as soon as the train passed the crossing at Sixth Avenue. He spoke to one of the Europeans, but not to the accused.

**A Frequent Occurrence.**  
 The native gatekeeper on being recalled said that the wire referred to by the accused was the bell wire which was broken by the train, and that after the train had passed the bell would not ring. That had happened many times before.

**No Warning Bell.**

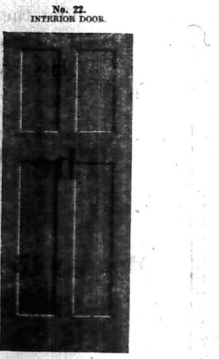

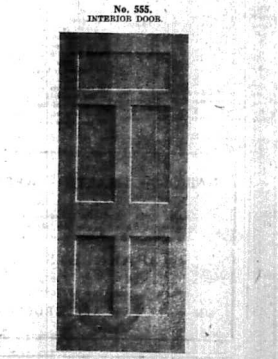

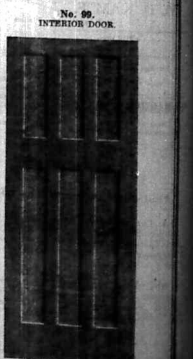

They include Mechanical Engineers of high qualifications, experienced in the erection of all kinds of buildings, installation of electric and mechanical, particularly internal combustion engines, and being possessed, etc. Surely there is room for such in the expanding commerce, developing plantations, extending railways and last but not least, the Government Departments of the three provinces mentioned. From many years experience in India and East Africa I was fully conversant with Mr. Macdonald that few men of his calibre exist during their first 12 months, if not for double that period, and I cannot help fully for firms plantations, etc. to avail themselves of the services of men from home when possible, and to avoid men from the country, who are not so well versed in the country. Every citizen, who is not a native, should be widely advertised, and to those who are in remote places, to make their applications, and only when this has proved unsuccessful should new men be imported.

## THE AGE OF THE SPECIALIST.

### South African Referee on Rugby Tactics.

### MR. J. G. FINLAY'S TRIBUTE TO FAMOUS SCOTTISH INTERNATIONAL.

### Loose Scrums Greatest Attacking Position OF ALL.

The great part played by tactics in Rugby is perhaps better realised than practiced. Yet the side which takes the field devoid of plan is doomed before the game make a commencement. There are two aspects to all games—the theoretical and the practical. Combined the two give Rugby in the highest sense stand off.

Some idea of the importance of tactics was forthcoming as a result of a lecture on forward and back play in Rugby by Mr. J. G. Finlay, a recognised authority on the game in South Africa, at Kitale, on Wednesday. The theoretical side was discussed and the practical emphasised.

A full appreciation of the part played by the forwards was given by the lecturer, who deprecated the tendency of players to attach too little importance to the line-out. Again, he forced home on his hearers the realisation that too little attention was paid to dribbling. Intensive backing up was a paramount essential to success, particularly in the case of loose scrums, where quick setting following upon this backing up offered the greatest attacking position of all on the Rugby field.

### THE LOOSE HEAD IN RUGBY.

Special Correspondent

Kitale, Thursday. The statement applies as much on the field of sport as in the ordinary walks of life. Occasionally one comes across some fellow who is gifted to fill any well with useful faculty and distinction. Nowhere in the realm of sport is the need for the specialist more apparent than in the sphere of Rugby.

### Keay's Fruin.

One of the most apparent faults in Rugby in Kenya is undoubtedly the inability of the forwards to come to the scrum. It is a pity that the need for proper practice in the scrum is not so much as it is at Kitale. It is essential that forwards should pack straight and low, then getting the maximum of weight and power on the scrum.

An expert forward play which had been developed at other countries, but which had been ignored in Kenya was the struggle for the loose head. He hoped that Keay would take a sensible attitude in this regard. In a sense the loose head had given birth to the wrong foot look, and danger to the liability of the backer to cross the outside man.

Touching on line-out play, the speaker referred to the manner in which the scrum half is being perfected by New Zealand. showing. A deep throw could be resorted to on occasion with advantage. There might be an element of danger to such a move, but it would be worth the risk of changing defence lines. The throw should be made in this instance with a forward lying deep.

There was another wrong aspect in regard to line-out methods and that was the tendency for the forwards to knock the ball to the line. The danger lay in the three backs, but it was a constant tactic, and the forwards should knock it and drop it on the ground scrumming it in the usual manner.

### Forward Dribbling

One of the big defects in South African Rugby was the liability of the scrum half to dribble the ball. It was a phase and feature of the Scottish game which other countries had learnt to appreciate.

In this regard Mr. Finlay mentioned the case of J. Hamman, the famous Scottish forward, who could dribble the ball a hundred yards in something like twenty seconds and never lose control. ### The Scrum Half.

Nowhere in Rugby was the need for complete understanding more necessary than between scrum half, forwards and stand-off. He was the link joining the front division to the back. It was one more instance of the specialist player.

The scrum half provided three with a controversial aspect of the game—the maul and deliberate of the drive and the maulive game. There were those who believed in the drive game, and those who held staunchly to the maulive. The two great opponents of each style were Lewis, of South Africa, and Bamber, of the famous English half and exponent of the maulive game. The drive game was given to the scrum half with the ball above the head, and the maul with the hands. The disadvantage of this method lay in the fact that the scrum half was temperate out.

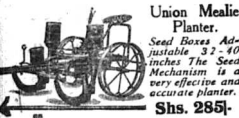

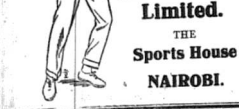
