**REDUCTION IMPERATIVE.**

**Effect of Drop in World Prices on the Industry.**

The Kenya Board of Agriculture has, during the past week, been investigating the question of the costs of production in the principal products of the Colony which are at present prevailing prices. This investigation has not yet concluded, but a report issued yesterday indicates that some valuable data has been obtained.

The Board is of the opinion that there must be a revision by all parties concerned in the process of producing primary products on the world's markets, if production is to be maintained.

Proceeding the report states that the value of every product has seriously declined in value during the past few months. Figures are given to show that there is a loss on every product on production costs.

Cuts in relation to profits is controlled by output. There four output is regarded as a primary object in reducing cost, this is a slow process and the need for revision of costs is urgent.

The Board is convinced that material reductions can be made, and detailed examination will be proceeded with and the results published. Material reductions in the report are indicated in which reductions should be sought. The directions referred to include payments to native labour, management and supervision charges and transport costs.

Concluding the Board hopes that those responsible for management and charges outside the control of the producer, will do their share by revising their charges, because without their co-operation, the concerted efforts of the industries will not effect the desired results.

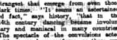

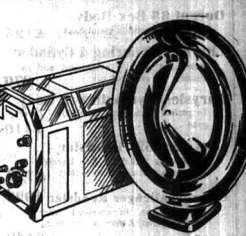

**OTHER DISEASES OF POULTRY AND THEIR TREATMENT.**

Chicken Pox. This is an infectious disease of birds and is characterized by a rash of small red spots on the skin. It is caused by a virus which is transmitted by contact with infected birds or by the air. The disease is most common in young chicks and is usually fatal. Treatment consists in isolating the affected birds and keeping them in a clean, dry, and well-ventilated place. The use of disinfectants and antiseptics is also recommended.
