In respect of the advice which they may tender to the Government upon the subject of the future of the Colonies and the Customs is dependent. His Majesty's Government are desirous of ascertaining the opinion of the natives with respect to the responsibility of the Colonies, their future and whether the Government of the Colonies they would consider it essential that the Government were exercising powers in their case they should find it necessary to refer to the Colonies, and in such an event, the Government, His Majesty's Government would exercise their powers, and His Majesty's Government could not exercise the maintenance of the Colonies for which they themselves would consider essential and irrevocably responsible.
