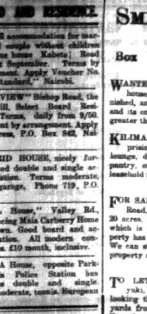

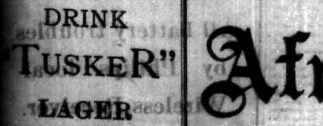

 The sympathy of the British Government was conveyed by telegram on the 27th instant from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs as follows:—  
 "His Majesty's Government have learned with sorrow the catastrophe in Southern Italy and Sicily which has caused such deep sympathy with the Italian Government and people. They long that the expression of their sympathy should be conveyed to the relatives of the victims of this terrible calamity—through Official War Office Service.  
 "Telegraphic information has been received from the Italian Government that the area of the earthquake, which has been the theatre of the disaster, comprises the provinces of Benevento, Avellino and Foggia, where 1,778 persons have been slain. The Italian action in East Africa, however, should not be obscured by these unfortunate events which have been exaggerated."  
 His Majesty's Government has declined all offers of help or money on the part of the Italian Government but has undertaken the necessary steps to help the population.

# A Peace Move in India.

The most encouraging and hopeful sign in the Indian situation is the attempt which is being made by the Government to approach the leaders of the Congress party with the object of declaring the Civil Disobedience movement at an end. Two prominent representatives of moderate opinion in India have had a four hours interview with Mr. Gandhi and the Ministry today and they are now going to carry a message from the prime minister of the Congress to the other Congress leaders in London. It is expected that every reasonable step will be taken to bring about a cessation of the Civil Disobedience Movement in India. Although in a number of instances the Government has stated that it has no political objectives at all, its reluctance has caused some serious dissatisfaction among the Indian people. It is felt that the Government is not approaching the matter of the Civil Disobedience Movement in India, and particularly in Punjab, with sufficient sincerity. Parliament is called upon to consider the Government's attitude at a session of the constitutional assembly to be held in the near future.

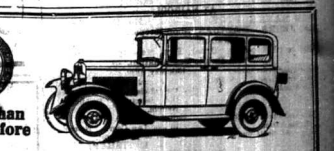

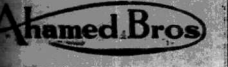
