LUNACY LAW REFORM IN KENYA

Modernisation By Order of Secretary of State

The law of Kenya dealing with the care and treatment of mentally defective people is the same as that in England in 1858 when Dickens was agitating for reform.

But on the instructions of the Secretary of State it is being brought into line with modern practice and a new appointment will be made— a Commissioner for Mental Hygiene who will be the Director of Mental Hygiene.
