

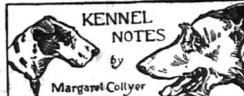

Goodwill Jeopardized by White Papers.

THE JOINT COMMITTEE.

Government Actions to Act On The Decision.

In the House of Lords on July 7, Lord Passfield, Secretary of State for the Colonies, announced that it is desirable that a Joint Committee of both Houses be appointed to consider the proposals on Close Union in East Africa (Cmd. 2324 and Cmd. 2372), in particular with the statement of the conditions of the Majesty's Government (Cmd. 2374), and to report thereon.

He said the Government had come to the conclusion that owing to the quick pace in the House of Commons it was inadvisable to attempt to set up a Joint Committee in this Session. It would have been of great advantage had they been able to do so. The Government had decided to ask both Houses to appoint a Joint Committee immediately to give opinions and to be kept before the Joint Committee their own conclusions in the matter. They hoped that the Joint Committee would support them in carrying out these proposals. It was better in matters of native policy that they should go forward with as large a measure of united support as possible.

The Government proposed that there should be a High Commissioner for Kenya, Uganda and Tanganyika with a dual function. It would be for him as the representative of the Secretary of State to see what was going on, especially in regard to native policy, and to be able to present at the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Government thought it necessary that certain services in these territories, such as railways, road and lake transport, and Customs, should be under common management, and it was proposed that the High Commissioner should administer these transferred services with the support, advice, and assistance of a council composed of all three territories. In Tanganyika there would be a council of the Mandate to retain that territory as a unit, but there would be a council of the common services over for a joint administration of the common services. Great care had been taken to see that the regulations conformed to

the spirit as well as the letter of the Mandate. It is freely admitted that he was moving the motion, only desirably, and would welcome to enter the debate, in order that he would see how the Government would be prepared to give notice that a Joint Committee would be asked for, and set up would almost certainly wish to hear evidence.

The Many Questions.

Lord Cromwell registered the absence of Government to set up a Committee. There had been no serious discussion on East Africa, and each one had been very desirous to get rid of the uncertainty of affairs there. He was glad that the right kind of committee was being set up, but would have been very anxious to see a committee of opinion on any subject was generally difficult to get. It was a society in which good was done too easy to obtain. Of all the people he had known who had tried to get serious on both sides for the common good, no man had had the same measure of success as Sir Ernest Wilson. The agreement he obtained was an interesting thing, and he (Lord Cromwell) registered warmly that the good will expressed by that splendid party had been jeopardized in a marked degree.

With regard to the White Paper on Close Union, he was somewhat amused to find that the Government were that could be put in the hands of one man. The High Commissioner to have complete control over a variety of services. He was to be uncontrolled by anybody; he was to be an absolute monarch. He was even to have his own Secret Service. Surely that was a departure from the whole of our previous policy. The suggestion for a common roll instead of a communal roll instead of any matter of getting the proposals accepted with the good will of the inhabitants of East Africa. He trusted that an opportunity would be given later whereby the whole subject could be ventilated, and he hoped that the great object—to give free play to every section of the population and to get back the good will which had been so rapidly jeopardized.

Native Policy.

The Earl of Plymouth said that Lord Passfield had made it quite clear that the Government did not intend to go back on their decision to set up a Joint Committee. With regard to the question of native policy, the Government proposals were open to the very serious objection. Although there was no right to initiate legislation in the Federal Council with regard to native policy, yet

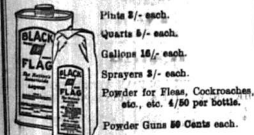

at the same time the High Commissioner will be asked to consider any powers. Conditions in various parts of East Africa are very greatly and it seemed to him, instead of having one large country under one policy to the High Commissioner, the Governor of the individual Colonies was the one person properly qualified to speak with authority on these subjects. It would be wise to have authority for the Government without interference from the central authority. The proposal of the Government were in their present position, to be obliged to do very possibly fraught with considerable danger.

In regard to finance, he could not see where there would be a counterbalancing saving as a result of these measures to set off the extra expense involved. They were inclined to have some estimate from the Government.

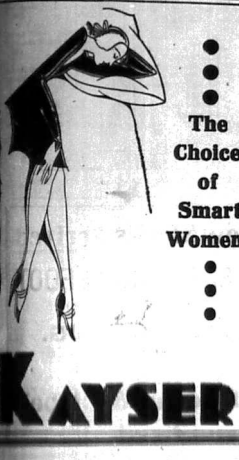

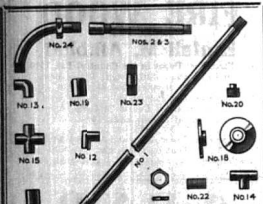

While the agencies may sell wheat in any market outside or inside the Colony, their first duty shall be to supply the East African demands. The agency or agencies shall also be responsible to the Governor for satisfying the requirements of all millers at a common price.

Wheat Reserves may be exempted from the operations of the Bill.

It is expected that this measure will come before the special session of the Legislative Council on 19th inst.

INCREASED CRIME IN KENYA.

The Prisons Report for Last Year.

MORE RECIDIVISTS.

Attempt at Classification of Prisoners.

Commissaries to prison throughout Kenya in 1929 show an increase of 40, or 7 per cent, of convicted prisoners, and an increase in remand prisoners admitted but not convicted of 1,596, or 45 per cent. The net increase in the total commitments for the year 1929 was 2,010, or 20 per cent, as compared with 1928. Figures from 10,805 in 1928 to 12,720 in 1929, but dropped to 9,958 in 1930, to rise again to 11,995 last year.

There was also, says the Kenya Prisons report for 1929, from which these figures have been taken, a considerable increase in the number of people sentenced to death for petty offences. From a total of 9,941 in 1928 the figure jumped to 11,916 in the year following.

An attempt was made last year to classify prisoners in such a way as to enable the separation of first offenders from recidivists, and young from old, until the system cannot be introduced through want of more suitable accommodation is provided.

The need for a proper central penal establishment in Kenya for long sentence convicts is again stressed.

INTERESTING STATISTICS.

The daily average of prisoners in all the prisons combined decreased from 2,599 in 1929 to 2,328 in 1928, and from 2,328 in 1928 to 2,253 in 1927.
