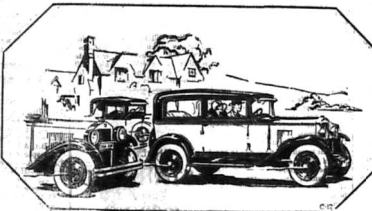

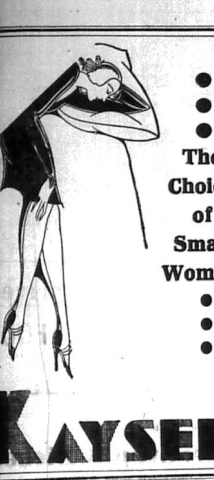

THE MANNING CUP.

A Review of the Shoot.

CONDITIONS SPILL SECOND STAGE.

(Continued by Captain Rivers.)

Again Kenya has won the Manning Cup. Two years in succession 'I' will do so.

Following last year's example the team that extremely well only a few points separated the top and bottom scores. It was really good team shooting. The selection of the team took place immediately after the finish of the championship. There were ten candidates from the winning team last year. O'charbhan was not yet returned from leave, and Least was selected as reserve with David O'Edmond.

In their places came J. O. Sains, Joseph O'Keefe, and Missions of Edmond. Sains shot 100 in the Manning Cup team of 1927 and 1928, but Missions is a new comer and an untried shooter, although thoroughly settled here. He is a young shot and still improves each year. Sains in a team made of this material is a great asset. The young shot, and Missions left the first stage last year and did not shoot at all in the second stage. Every man who placed in the first round in the second stage was back in his old form, and they were all in the top ten. Sains finished up with a 60-100 yards. We were fortunate to get 100 shots at 300 yards. It is a heavy gun. The magnitude of the shot was such that the Vacuum Oil Company was unfortunately in Nairobi being the time

the first meeting. Not only did he shoot to the top of the standard, but he was most useful as a wind gauge in the morning. He was a hard throughout the match.

Captain P. V. Ward's appointment as first shooter gave very good satisfaction, and under his control everything ran very smoothly.

The target was slightly more difficult than last year. There were using the N.E.A. 1929 target. This was but 12 1/2 x 1 1/2 inches larger, with the red ring inner at 300 yards, and 12 inches at 300 yards and 12 inches at 500 yards. It was a very good mark to keep on hitting.

The first stage the same as the King's Cup shoot, but the target was 200 yards and 100 yards was compared with last year. Monday morning. The light was excellent with an air wind. The finish of the first stage showed the difference more, as the range total, but taking into consideration the previous score, we were very well satisfied.

A Very Fine Shoot.

On Tuesday we shot the second stage. The range total was 100 points. 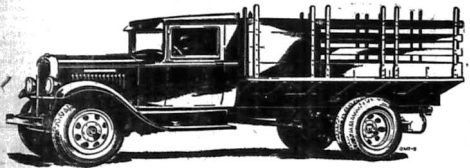

As mosquito larvae take about nine days to grow from egg to the flying stage the killing should be done weekly. The writer started doing this killing last year and an intelligent friend has been treated to go round the farms every Thursday. The writer has found that the larvae are killed very rapidly simply by the use of a small bottle of oil, both in the case of white and black pools.

Trained Medical Department boys were sent to the farms before the oiling afterwards. In one hot night a dam, 143 Anches were caught before being sent to a strainer. (July of last year) and about three days later, after oiling had been done three times the same but produced only four larvae.

Other lots gave similar results.

Cattle are vaccinated regularly at a dam, both in oil and in oil and they appear to resist the mosquito quantity which they drink on oiling days.

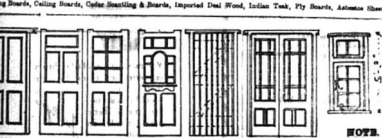
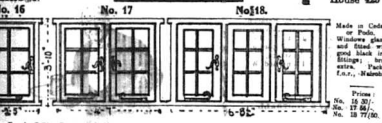
