HOME PRESS VIEWS ON EAST AFRICAN ISSUE.

Manchester Seeks Deals Instead of Words.
APPLICATION OF THE TEST.

"Morning Post's" Plea for the Settler's Interests.

As a guide to responsible opinion at Home on the East African issue, opportunity is seized when presented, to find space for newspaper opinions. To-day extracts are given from three leading British journals.

"The Manchester Guardian" gives unqualified support to the White Paper, particularly that on Native policy but questions the wisdom of establishing a Central Legislature. The paper holds that an advisory body is sufficient.

It also hopes that in the course consideration will be given to the separate administration of native and European areas in Kenya as in the long run, the best method.

"The Morning Post" asks for impartial justice in place of the native "White Paper" and inquires whether the Common Koll proposals will be accepted.

"The Glasgow Herald" also asks the Imperial Government to beware lest it carries idealistic views of democratic equality impracticable extremes.

A SCOTTISH WARNING.

Further comments on the East African issue are published today. They express the views of leading British journals.

The recurring reader of the two White Papers on East Africa need not be taking too much for granted as to the principles on which the Government will be guided in its application. 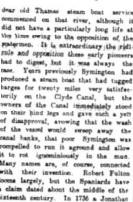

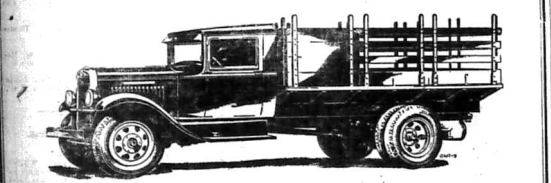
