## "ON THIS DAY."

AMUSEMENT.  
(For August 26th.)  
The eruption of Vesuvius, August 26, 79 A.D. Few people can recall the wonderful day of Naples for the first time without being the abject of the latest Vesuvius, and, according to imagination, to the heroes of that day who remained in the face of the A.D., when it visited its former domain. The tremendous volcano from Mount Vesuvius has, through the centuries, and by the last time, been known to erupt. The eruption on the morning of the 26th of August, 79 A.D. was so fatal that it is still a vivid description of how it was felt at the comparatively distant spot of the town and Miletum from which, with the comparatively few people who were on hand, it is clear that the eruption was a disaster of Vesuvius and Pompeii and Herculaneum.

Speaking as one who had travelled in every part of the Empire, the Bishop of Mombasa then discussed the problem of any part of Africa. There they had the most adventurous European. Indians who were amongst the most difficult races that India had produced, the tall, slender, Arab race, as the basis of all. It was the battleground of three main streams of native man.

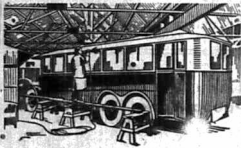

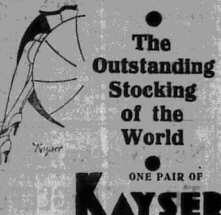

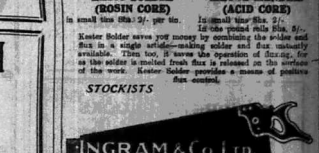

**CROP PROSPECTS FOR THE COMING SEASON.**  
(Continued from page 1).

As already mentioned, the total area under maize has been estimated to be 4,229,000 acres. The East District shows a decrease of 2,077,000 acres, whereas the West District shows a decrease of 1,000,000 acres. It is believed, however, that some of the losses shown subsequent to the end of July and that the figures for August will reflect a slightly improved position. Conditions are reported as being favourable in most districts and yields up to average are anticipated.

**Wheat.**  
The total area planted with wheat shows the small increase of 270 acres, as compared with 1929 sowings. Having regard to the low market prices at present prevailing, the crop is regarded as being satisfactory. Some farmers, notably in Nakuru and Trans-Gichu districts, have given considerable areas over to wheat. In Narivara and Nyeri districts, however, large areas previously covered by wheat have been allowed to revert to grass. Considerable areas known to have been sown subsequent to 15th July.

Crop prospects are favourable and a total yield somewhat above the average may be confidently expected, although it is doubtful whether the high yield secured in 1929 will be repeated.

**Coffee.**  
The additional area under coffee is estimated to be 4,229 acres, or 4.4 per cent. above that of 1929. This figure is slightly lower than the average annual increase, but having regard to the Kibonyi district being so intensively planted up, can be regarded as satisfactory. In the early part of the year a very heavy crop was indicated and a recent total of over 14,000 to 17,000 tons was roughly estimated. A series of attacks of Chilo has since created considerable damage. As a consequence, there has ultimately less undamaged harvest.

**WEATHER REPORT.**

Although Crop Correspondents have not yet been asked upon to furnish estimates of their respective yields, it is believed that the total crop will not greatly exceed 12,500,000 tons.

**Summary.**  
A summary of conditions in the Kampang area shows prevalence of coffee disease in many areas, retarding effects of varied weather conditions including excessive rain, drought and cold impeding cultural operations.

In the native reserves equally varied conditions prevail. The long rains at the Coast were, until the middle of July, a season, the yield of which will, therefore, be somewhat reduced. The export of maize has been prohibited for numerous food supplies. In South Kikuyu the maize crop is said to only 60 per cent. of normal, probably 75 per cent. of normal and 50 per cent.

The Post Office has reported unfavorable weather conditions, poor maize, poor bean crops and very bad yields of English potatoes. There will, however, be a single food supply.

In the office head maize crops in Embu are exceptionally good but are below average in Meru.

Central Kavirondo shows all maize crops up to average but in North Kavirondo there is little to harvest yet though yields should be good. Harvesting will be very late in South Kavirondo.

**Cassava.**  
It is not yet practicable to estimate quantities of Maize, Wheat and Coffee which will be available for export during the coming season.

The report issued early in the season, for additional Crop Correspondents met with a gratifying response, over 50 farmers consented to furnish the monthly reports required. As a consequence, this report has been compiled from the information received by 230 Correspondents, representing over 10 per cent. of the entire number of Cultivators in the Colony, which can be regarded as satisfactory, and the forecasts thereon should be reliable.

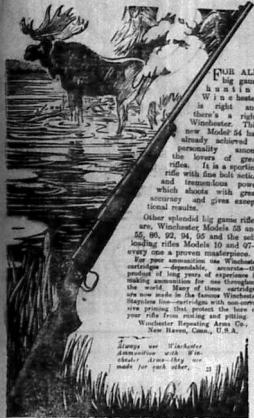
