## MONSTROUS CLAIMS OF KENYA SETTLERS.

### Spectator's Definition of Colonial Principles.

### THE GERMAN OPPOSITION.

### London Representative of East Africa Replies to "The Times".

"Spectator" in a comment on the East African issues  
declares the Kenya settlers' claims to self-government  
as "monstrous".

It contends that East Africa is not a parallel case with  
the great Dominions where the British community can  
expand the normal course of political evolution to be  
troubled in the opinion of the journal the principle  
of trusteeship is the only sound basis of Colonial  
policy in countries with mixed races.

Language of the Unofficial Conference called by the  
Colonial Office, in the opinion of the "Spectator,"  
shows that the Colonists are out of touch with British  
thought on Colonial questions.

Mr. W. M. Crowley, one of the members of a Publicity  
Committee formed by the London on behalf of  
the East African settlers replies to "The Times" by  
leading article published recently in the "Standard."

He declares that Associated Producers have  
always been in agreement with the view "that legisla-  
tion in matters which exclusively affect Natives should  
be reserved out of the powers conferred upon a locally  
elected majority."

tion of Native affairs as a source of great danger to

These long scarves are excellent for traveling and motor-touring, also they will be draped over the shoulders, or worn close to the throat, as you wish.

On the other hand, many women prefer the coat with a scarf of the same material attached as a collar. There is the very ample, straight fringed coat which has a long, not too wide girth attached at the back of the neck, to be brought round and tied in a graceful knot at the throat. There is also the

more chic coat, still ample, but not reaching to the hem of the skirt, although a little bit longer than three-quarter; this wrap has wide sleeves, and a comfortable three-rowed scarf by way of collar.

### Bows and Ties.

Fashion is very pleased with bows, knots, and ties at the moment. One of the smartest frocks I have seen lately is made out in soft, rose-pink wool material. The straight bodice is pleated back and front, the plain panels at the sides. The skirt is tucked and mounted on a pointed yoke which ties at the back of the waist in a neat bow drawing the material perfectly flat across the front, and giving a very slender, graceful line.

These are narrow, beautifully made little bows on the cuffs, at the back of the neck, and on the fronts of fewed coats, silk coats, and suit frocks. There is one thing to remember now—bows on the fronts of frocks have rather little in simple bows. At the back. Bows of soft satin, tulle, taffeta, or wide black velvet ribbon, are seen on long gowns of plain or printed muslin, marocquin, or plaid.

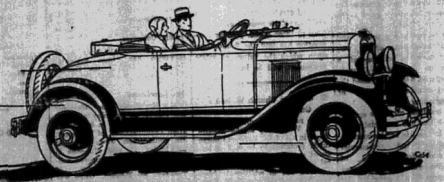

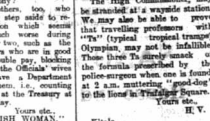

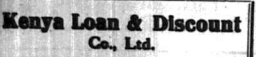

## TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR.

### Effort to Revive Club's Fortunes.

## TEAM BUILDING NOT YET FINISHED.

Spurred into action by the success of their London rivals, Tottenham Hotspur are making a bold effort to revive the fortunes of the club. Under the direction of Terry, the manager, a great deal of money has been—and will be spent—in an effort to secure the class of players that will take the team back to its proper sphere—the First Division of the League.

At the time of writing five new players have been acquired, but the figures are not yet published with the talent at their command. It is expected that the manager, in obtaining the signatures of a full-back and an inside-forward, will complete his team—and the completion of their transfers may be expected shortly.

Prominent among the new signings is Messer, the leading center-half, who has been on the verge of international honours for a considerable time, and who is a great asset to the team. He will impart a driving force into the team, says "The Daily News," who fill a long-felt want as the captain of the side.

## YOUTHFUL YOUNG LEAD.

Much as expected from Hunt, a young center-forward from

Cardiff, who is reported to be a factors leader with two goal posts, and Edwards, a left half-back from Porters, Ireland. Evans, Mac-Clellan, Green, Kettlewell, and Clayton remain full-back, and Don, an outside-left from Kettlewell, should also prove decidedly useful.

The names of Messer and O'Callaghan, both perfectly fit players, would probably add additional strength to the forward and intermediate divisions.

It is believed that Hunt, who was one of the field two for the greater part of last season, has already commenced training, and will have regenerated their confidence by the time the League programme commences.

Last season the play of the team was disappointing and through their poor record must be attributed to the number of players who were unfortunate in the various injuries which occurred in the early stages of the season. Greatly a reasonable immunity from casualties, Tottenham should have little difficulty in making a vast improvement this year.

With four or five new players in their ranks the team will probably require a little time to settle down, but should quickly take into a strong force.

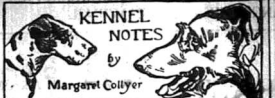

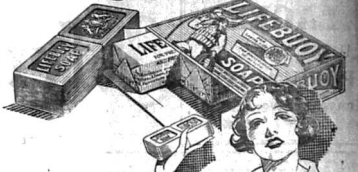
**KENNEL NOTES**  
Margaret Collyer

Miss Collyer, Shill, in whom all correspondents in connection with "Kennel Notes" should be addressed, does not hold herself responsible for accuracy of statements made by her which are, in the main, based on information supplied by trustworthy correspondents.  
I am just back from a fortnight's holiday on the Coast where it struck me forcibly that there was a fair share of good dogs. The outcome of my work I saw was Mr. and Mrs. Wake-Bowler's greyhound "Simples" which was a very fine bound indeed and the largest of the breed. I have ever clasped eyes on. I had a stand 80 yards from the shoulder. "Simples" is a ruff necked and has had some fine neck and shoulders. He is a well built and most thoroughly appreciated by his owners.  
On my return to the farm I find a number of dog letters awaiting replies. I have spent all today at my typewriter and have got through the most important of them. I am applying tomorrow in reply to I had no letter forwarded while I am on holiday.  
I am replying to Mr. O. Maclean who is starting an Animal Sanatorium where people can send their dogs, or any other pets, to be cared for while on leave. This is also provided for and at the moment a parcel is one of the paying guests. The charge for dogs is 5s. 6d. per month or per week thereof, I suppose according to size. The prospectus says "Floors, cots, dogs, kites and every kind of living creature cared for." Comfortable quarters, sympathetic handling, groomed and conditioned and fed according to clients' requests." Gards with all particulars of this Sanatorium are printed and can be had from Mr. Maclean at the above address.  
Messrs. Smith and Oldenbury write thanking me for a strongly recommending their dog-cakes. The price of 5/6, but for over 40 lbs. they must remain at 4/6. I have spoken highly of these dog-cakes because they are worthy of high praise. I got a larger consignment before, for the coast, and I return to find all my dogs in excellent condition although they have gone rather short of meat while I was away. Their morning meal has been of satisfactory of these dog-cakes given

and proved very difficult and gave rise to a great variety of opinions. My own view, which about April 22 was that he had "Gastric Tetany" a very rare condition in horses being that one may see in adults or rickety children with abnormal trouble. Peter was seen on April 11, before the muscular spasms and tremor occurred, by a veterinary surgeon who diagnosed "tetanus." On April 15, two other veterinary officers examined and diagnosed "Intestinal ulceration" and "acute gastritis" respectively. I do not think that the latter diagnosis was correct. Peter was seen by a veterinary surgeon who was never my own, but he diagnosed "tetanus" and prescribed strychnine as the only rational treatment so far as one could see. In addition to the above veterinary opinions, there were my medical colleagues were so sure as to come out and examine the dog for me. One diagnosed "tetanus," a specific bacterial infection that has nothing at all to do with Tetany and I fancy invariably fatal, and even with me some anti-tetanus serum for treatment of the disease. The second doctor thought the case was "Acute yellow stupor of the liver" a very rare disease in human beings that is accompanied by jaundice and is invariably fatal. The third diagnosis was "Acute Septicæmia" and "Dumb Babes" a form of hydrophobia both invariably fatal, though I believe that hydrophobia does not occur in this Colony. The diagnosis of hydrophobia was suggested by the fact that the dog jaws were so much clamped by the muscular spasm that he could not drink, which is a common feature with rabies; and also by the Marbled appearance of the hair on his back and shoulders, because hydrophobia in dogs is sometimes associated with a mottled redness of the hair, but in Peter case it was a natural wave.

"Judging by the quotations you have sent me from the German dog-books I should say there is no doubt our Peter had an attack of gastric tetany. From seeing him many times I saw how to treat a similar case again I should suggest by giving a large dose or two of strychnine which clearly should have been done in Peter's case; and by relieving the muscular spasm and tremor I should give 60 grains or so in the case of a big dog of Atropinum Chloride three times a day instead of a sedative like Chloroform because I believe that nowadays strychnine is given in an undue alkalinity of the blood which I really can not recommend Atropinum Chloride. I should really like to send my doctor friend sufficiently for this very definite case of the dog's tetany because why I'll tell you in my next issue."

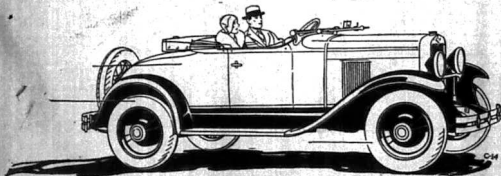

**SLIGHT REDUCTION IN LIVING COSTS.**

Official Figures for Month of July.

**BUTTER AND FLOUR.**

**Maohi Comparisons With Overseas Prices.**

During the month of July—July, which statistics we now available—the retail prices of local products in Kenya fell by 1 per cent. This was brought about mainly by the reduction in the average price of Creamery butter from Shs. 2/- to Shs. 1/10; of bread of 10 cents to 37 cents; of wheat flour from 24 cents to 24 cents, and of lard from Shs. 1/45 to Shs. 1/20 (all per lb.).

There was also a slight decline in the average retail price of bacon and coffee but this was wholly due to the fact that a few more lines whose prices have risen above the average have fallen into line.

The Statisticians note a slight rise in the price of glue and explain that this is due to the raising of individual traders and not to any increase of a general rate. It is also noted that there is a steady increasing difference between the price of butter and glue and the latter is falling much more rapidly than the former.

Several new items of local produce appear in the list for the first time and there are now 17 commodities which are subject to monthly examination by the Statisticians.

**Index Numbers.**

The index numbers are given for four years. They show that because of lower prices for wheat, maize, white bread, and glue have all been reduced steadily in retail price since 1918. 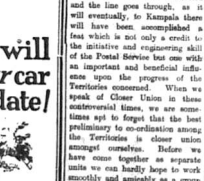

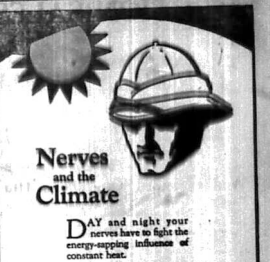

**PLATEAU WHEAT GROWERS AND THE POOL.**

**Criticism of the Enabling Bill**  
**AGAINST COMPULSION.**

Proposed Compulsion of Farmers and Millers.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.]  
Eldoret, Aug 17.

A meeting of Plateau wheat growers numbering about 200 people was held in Eldoret on August 25. The proceedings were opened by Mr. Mackay, Chairman of the Kenya K.F.A., who called upon Capt. McNab-Mundell, J.P., to take the chair. Following a brief address on the subject of the meeting the Chairman called upon Mr. Mackay to address the meeting.

Mr. Mackay stated that the object of the meeting was to sound public opinion as to the desire for a wheat pool for which there was a widely voiced need. The matter had been discussed by the Legislative Council, the Board of Agriculture, etc. He wished to elucidate one or two points as to the object of forming a wheat pool which did not seem quite clear to the public. The K.F.A. were in favour of co-operation and certain regulations had already taken place between the K.F.A. and mill in the district. All wheat grown must be treated alike. It was, in his opinion certain that the K.F.A. must be the only selling agency in the event of the formation of such a pool.

Objections were immediately raised to this suggestion. Mr. Mackay went on to say that the K.F.A. could finance the wheat pool and, with the aid of the Bank, finance any wheat grown up to a point once his wheat had been delivered to the K.F.A. If wheat pool were introduced the wheat industry could not carry on. 
