**REVOLUTION IN THE ARGENTINE.**

**Overthrow of Aged President.**

**FIGHTING IN BUENOS AIRES.**

**Army and Navy Join the Disaffected Workers.**

The 78-year-old President of the Argentine Republic has been forced to resign and the country is in open revolt. The story of the sudden coup d'etat is told in messages from Buenos Aires and New York.

Despite the proclamation of martial law and reinforcement of the naval and military forces popular disaffection against the regime of the President spread and a military junta has taken over control of the Government.

Fighting has taken place in the streets of the Capital and it is reported that a thousand people have been killed or wounded. Columns of troops and a mob of excited people marched on Government House, tore down the President's portrait which was burnt in the square, ransacked government buildings and set fire to newspaper offices.

The President and his Cabinet Ministers have disappeared.

Senior Hipolito Irigoyen who assumed office two years ago was in a sense a Dictator in the affairs of the Argentine. President Irigoyen has a minimum lease on his political power to his present position as a member of the Executive Council in the hands of the President who selects his own Cabinet. President Irigoyen has always had Socialist leanings and during his earlier part of regime had the support of the proletariat, a circumstance which caused disaffection among the intelligentsia.

**1,000 CASUALTIES.**

(THROUGH NEWSPAPERS AGENCY.)

Buenos Aires, Sept. 5. President Irigoyen has been forced to resign and his political power has passed to a military junta. The news, though not unexpected, has stunned the Capital and has established but street fighting is reported.

Buenos Aires, Sept. 6. Vice-President Martinez has proclaimed a state of siege of the entire country and has ordered the restoration of martial law.

A later message says that the resignation of President Irigoyen and the proclamation of martial law by the military junta have caused the outbreak of the workers which led to the President's resignation.

Notwithstanding these measures the demonstration against the Government continued.

President's Resignation.

Minister offered to resign collectively if the President would resign. He was refused.

The United States News Service has reported on September 8 that it was believed that the news of the overthrow of the President was true.

Major generals are now reported in the Capital but the troops have the situation well in hand.

Messages from Buenos Aires state that a state of martial law exists in the city. Military officers are in control of the Government in Buenos Aires.

The thousands of the Argentine population are awaiting orders to march on the Capital, headed by a military officer, nephew of the President.

An Ultimatum.

General Jose Uriburu has sent an ultimatum to President Irigoyen demanding the resignation of the latter. Irigoyen has refused to resign; alternatively he will resign if the President's resignation is accepted.

see, therefore, at the present moment.

**Martial Law.**  
Washington message states that the American Red Cross headquarters reports that 2,000 killed and 2,500 injured, 20,000 homeless and nearly 2,000 homes destroyed. The same message adds that martial law has been proclaimed in San Domingo City to-day.

The officers of the United States Marine Corps who flew to San Domingo on Tuesday night had a wireless message: "The conditions are unbelievable. The food, medicines and fuel are imperative." Accordingly, doctors, nurses, and supplies are being despatched by air from Haiti and also by three steamers from San Juan.

**The Death Roll.**  
(BY WIRELESS.)

Bayly, Sept. 6. According to the latest estimate the loss of life caused by the hurricane which struck San Domingo, the Capital of the Republic of Dominica in the West Indies, was approximately one thousand. Over 100,000 number of persons were injured and thousands of homes were destroyed. Shortage of food and drinking water is also reported. Martial Law has been declared to facilitate the relief work. British possessions in the West Indies seem to be the main to have escaped serious damage although an official report from the Leeward Islands states that further news from the small British island of Dominica indicates considerable damage to houses of persons and laborers for whom assistance was needed. Corps have been extensively damaged and many buildings were reported lost. There was no shortage of food or other supplies. Local telephonic and telegraphic installations have been affected and messages were interrupted. Some Government offices have suffered. Generally however, the damage to the island on this occasion was not by any means as extensive as in the hurricane of 1919.

**Life a Shambled Toy.**  
A United States marine officer who flew over Port au Prince

blamed the city to a "toy shambled by the hand of a giant baby who, and mother with this monster, stirred up the wreckage with a stick.

He reported that the roads had washed out the crops from the surrounding, whence, coffee were floating like rocks.

The crops are now being collected in heaps, placed in concrete bins and being sold at a time. On landing, the coffee were saw hundreds full of holes, with overcasted, silver, coming and sweating, and saying: "More don't, always more!" Men and women were going about dazed and dazed, and asked nothing for the loss of their belongings.

A newspaper says that bodies are still being discovered in the streets. Dr. Antonio Calderon who is in charge of the sanitary service estimates that at least 1,000 people have perished in the city.
