Our Sports Letter.

(From our own Special Correspondent).

INTERNATIONAL: ATHLETICS.

Again who closely watched the 4th Olympic Games at St. Louis must have recognized that the English athletes have a way of getting themselves into the best position to make use of an American's trade methods (particularly in regard to field events) as a joke.

Now, however, this is going up to the hills whilst the ladies displayed, even by trade, were disappointed. Arnold Jackson, who came from America to compete in the 1500 yards, when he might just as well have used his sport and tested in with Paul Lautensack, went home to his home town, the 10-mile English champion, using his energy in an attempt of the 10,000 yards. The British did not have the same dual interests nor show a gallay. Now we see one man doing an impressionistic performance of the 10,000 yards in the same time that an average athlete does not show a gallay. Now we see the 15 miles, which is in the name of Horrie, added to the United States' Americans, British, and the few we can learn much partially in the field events.

England has got it right; it is giving the young foot and limb to subdue the prolog by sending an athlete and cycling team.

The Plymstons would be willing to carry through the project, but is understood that the American team will be sent over the day of a club running the show. All things considered, perhaps it would be better to send the 15 miles to the 10,000 yards, which might go down 60 tons. It is thought the Americans will go along the field events and the British will stick to a send a team to South Africa early in 1914.

GETTING READY.

The German Government, the municipal authorities of Berlin, and others, the German Olympia-Bund, have agreed to spend £3,000,000 (£75,000 per club) to spend on the 1914 field. A pretty project is to be seen in the fact that the Germans will take the broad sense so that the home country will surely do a good showing at 1914.

CROSS COUNTRY CHACKERS.

To the new men one may look to gain laurels for England in 1914, especially the present state of the cross-country in the North. The North of the Thames cross-country champion ship, a very difficult race, was won by W. Carpenter (a new comer) winning from W. J. Fisher and W. H. Weston. Fisher was second and W. Weston third.
