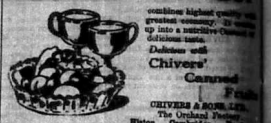

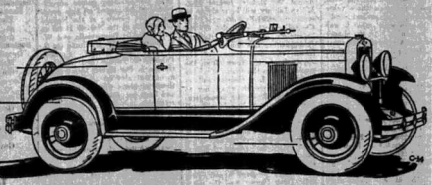

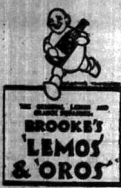

STOCK FARMING IN THE TRANS KOZIA.

An Address to the Farmers' Association. FIRST ESSENTIALS.

Recently Mr. W. D. D. Jardine, Inspector, Veterinary Department, addressed the Trans-Niwa Farmers' Association on the possibilities of stock farming.

HARVEST PROSPECTS ENCOURAGING.

Bountiful Crops Anticipated.

WHEAT AND COFFEE.

Former Likely to be Above the Average.

Official estimate of forthcoming crops issued by the Department of Agriculture and based on reports received from all parts of the country for last month show that the prospects everywhere are favourable.

The wheat harvest is expected to be much above the average whilst on circumstances have arisen to necessitate a revision of last month's estimate of the coffee crop which was put at about 15,000 tons.

Most of the native reserves it is anticipated that the harvest will be a good one.

Essentially the Department observes that the report is based on information from 224 crop correspondents, the highest number yet recorded.

AUGUST RETURNS.

Department of Agriculture reports the following crop returns for August:—

Cereals: Maize (including sorghum) 1,200,000 bushels, 10 per cent above last year's crop.

Wheat: 1,200,000 bushels, 10 per cent above last year's crop.

Coffee: 15,000 tons, 10 per cent above last year's crop.

Other crops: 1,200,000 bushels, 10 per cent above last year's crop.

Summary of the above returns shows a general increase in all crops compared with last year.

The Department attributes this increase to the favourable weather conditions prevailing during the growing season.

It is expected that the harvest of all crops will be well above the average.

The Department also reports that the price of all crops has risen considerably since last month.

This is due to the increased demand for all crops, particularly wheat and coffee.

The Department anticipates that the price of all crops will continue to rise during the next few months.

It is therefore recommended that all farmers should take advantage of the present high prices and sell their crops as early as possible.

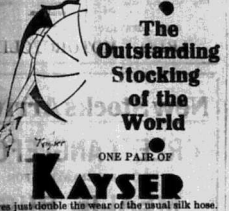

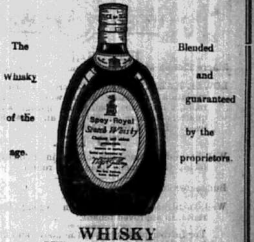

The farewell dinner arranged at Nyver this week for His Excellency the Governor of Kenya took the striking evidence of the co-operation, friendship and understanding which exist between Government and settlers in the Highlands. In the course of his speech, a fuller report of which appears below, the Governor laid emphasis on the fact that the progress of the Colony depended very largely upon that spirit.

Mr. Edward devoted his speech to an expression of some of his fundamental views on the two sides of the Dual Policy. He emphasized that the authority of the chiefs is essential to good government and to the progress of their people.

As far as white settlement is concerned, the Governor expressed strong faith in the future and he promised to do his utmost in Kenya to make people realize that the Dual Policy has two sides and that a bold policy of encouragement of settlement is not only essential to the progress of all races but our departure from that policy would be a deep and deplorable breach of faith by the Imperial Government.

The President of the Nyeri Settlers Association, in an admirable speech pointing to the health of the Colony, expressed a tribute to the work of Lady Grigg which Sir Edward greatly appreciated. Captain de la Poer also expressed sympathy and understanding with the Government and the Imperial Government might have been tempered by the knowledge that recent events have cast a shadow of gloom upon the realization of the hopes which have been his highest hopes for the Colony to whom she has devoted five strenuous years.

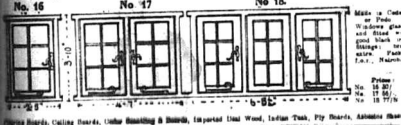
