Berets will be seen again, of course. Never have we had such success with any kind of small hats as this year. For the coming season will bring certain changes. The newest kind will be larger than those we have worn for motoring, and to complete our trim suits of flannel, kid, and other light materials it will be draped, and mounted on a band of satin, grosgrain, or fine felt.

For wear with frocks, and without coats there are large soft hats of velvet, with shallow crowns and drooping brims. This style of picture hat is simply trimmed with narrow ribbon tied at the back in a bow with long loops, a diamond clip being pinned on the ribbon in front.

Very attractive large square hats, mounted on glass or silver, with fastenings of beautiful blue, jade, or amber also match a string of beads, are made of black velvet like these.

HOW TO MAKE FEATHER FLOWERS.

Feather flower buttonholes are in vogue and if the right feathers are used and artistic colors obtained by dyeing, these colors look, with dainty and charming.

Use the best white swan or goose feathers; free them from down, put them into hot water, and let them drain before dyeing them to shades as desired. This is possible. After dyeing, rinse two or three times in clear cold

water, lay them on a tray over which a cloth has been spread, and set in the sun to dry. When good fire. When the feathers be dry and unfold, draw each one evenly between the thumb and finger until it regains its own shape.

Various Colors. To dye the feathers blue, take two ounce weight of oil of vitriol (sulphuric acid) in a bottle and mix with four pennyweight of blue indigo powder. Let it stand for a day or two. When required, shake well and put one tablespoonful with a quart of boiling water into an old soapstone. Stir well; put in the feathers and let them simmer for a few minutes. In pouring, stir and do not leave it lying about.

For a yellow shade, use a tablespoonful of the best turmeric mixed with a quart of boiling water. Mix thoroughly and mix the dye a deeper yellow, and a pinch or two of soda will turn it to orange.

A little of the blue indigo mixed with the turmeric while boiling will make green; still they require the same dye.

To make the flowers. Take a specimen of the flower you wish to copy, pull off the petals and cut the shape in tissue paper, leaving the shaft of the feather to the proper shape, taking care not to break the web. Put tin snips and heart of wire, and the top of a length of wire with cotton wool, cover with velvet and make all firm with a few turns of very fine wire. Insert the feather; petals round the centre with very fine wire or silk, and cover the stem with green silk. C. A.

HONEY HOLL.

Ingredients: For the pastry: 1 egg, 2 table-spoonful sugar, 5 table-spoonful honey, self-raising flour.

For the filling: 5 table-spoonful honey, 2 hard plain chocolate, 5 oz. melted wafters.

Beat the egg and sugar together, mix in the honey, and add flour very gradually to form a stiff dough. Knead, and roll out to a well-shaped oblong.

Prepare the filling as follows: Chop the wafters finely small and add to them the finely-grated chocolate. Mix well. Heat the honey very slowly and, when it boils, add the milk and chocolate, and continue boiling, stirring all the time, until a thick mass is obtained.

Spread this evenly over the dough, rolling and leave it to set slightly. Roll it up into the length desired. To serve, it slices and gratinate each with a little powdered cinnamon.

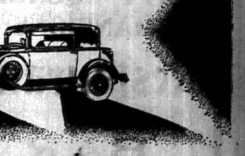

I have been asked to give a description of the symptoms shown in cases of a liver disease in dogs, and the cause of same. A liver abscess may be caused by some injury, such as a blow or a fall, or it may arise from foreign bodies passing through the liver, or from parasites or perforating abscesses coming from the stomach, or from disease from one part of the body to another. Fatigue and depression, also from pyæmia (blood-poisoning producing abscesses in abscesses of the stomach, and in the bile-ducts from a growth of gall-stones or parasites.

Abscesses of the liver usually appear singly, but they may be present in large numbers; the treatment usually depends on the extent of the abscess caused by some disease as Metastatic cancer, the case known as Metastatic cancer, the case known as Metastatic cancer, the case known as Metastatic cancer.

1. By the entrance of the virus matter of the bile into the tissues, they become more yellow. This yellow tint may very rarely, be seen on the abdomen or the inside of the stomach, but is more common on the mucous membrane of the mouth and throat. The colour ranges from a light yellow to a dirty orange-yellow.

2. On account of the colouring matter secreted by the kidneys being present in the urine, it is changed from the normal to a yellowish green, or to a dark brown almost the colour of dark beer. Besides the bile acids, the urine in tetanus cases almost always contains albumen, etc.

3. On account of the stoppage of the flow of bile into the intestine, the faeces become green or clay-coloured, and contain much undigested fat. The fat substance, not being digested the faeces become very fetid. This is due to the loss of the antiseptic effect of the bile in almost all cases of constipation. In order to answer the question whether tetanus depends upon a mechanical retention of the discharge of the bile we must first consider the nature of the faeces.

The bile acids present in the bile produce a certain amount of depression of the nerve centres, and for this reason we find that the pulse and respiration are subnormal in action, and the temperature depressed. Other symptoms of the narcotic effect of the bile are seen in some cases where there is depression, great muscular debility, indifference to food.

Manipulation of the liver does not seem to cause pain in the latter stages of the disease.
