Accused Committed for Trial.

A REVIEW OF THE EVIDENCE.

Memorandum to be Submitted by Magistrate for Defence.

Summing Matus Njomo, the Wakamba native, for trial in the Supreme Court on the charge of the murder of Miss H. J. Stump at the African Inland Mission, Kijabe, in January last. Mr. H. S. Fagan, the District Commissioner of Kiambu, took the opportunity to review at length the whole of the evidence presented for the Crown at the investigation which he has conducted.

On the last day of the investigation at Kiambu the accused expressed a wish to have certain witnesses for the prosecution called on his behalf. Before this was done, high legal authority was taken, and it was decided not to accede to his request lest it damage his case, but that he should receive his defence.

Mr. Fagan, who has been connected with the case from the time the murder was discovered, is giving the Chief Justice a memorandum to be used by counsel for defence.

The investigation just closed at Kijabe, in the very house where Miss Stump was murdered, and is concluded on Tuesday. A large number of exhibits have played an important part in the case, and nearly 30 witnesses have given evidence.

DEFENCE FORCE CAMP AT ELDORET.
Six Days' Intensive and Enjoyable Training.

Eldoret, Sept. 30.

The training camp under the command of Lt.-Col. C. A. Brown, D.S.O., C.B., at the hands of Major Mansell in the six days' intensive training which commenced on Sunday, September 22, and continued until Friday evening, the location of the camp was on the bluff overlooking Eldoret ('Yambou') open, healthy and clean to abundant water in the reservoir; conveniently situated as regards the transport of supplies; and possessing splendid facilities for training purposes. 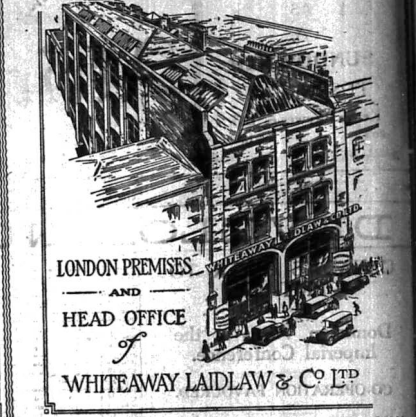

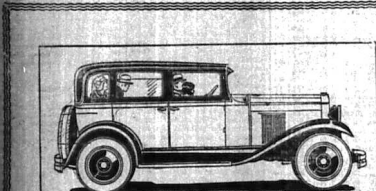

A Definite Plan

The Canadian Premier, Mr. Bennett, just forward a definite plan based on the broad principle of Empire preference based on common advantage and gained in the spirit of reciprocity. It is the intent the welfare of the Empire. He offered a plan to the United Kingdom and all other parts of the Empire preference in the form of a plan to be put into effect for the performance in their based upon the addition of 10 per cent for some in preventing general tariffs or other tariff rate to be created. This rate could not be uniformly applied. The basis of the proposed was an adequate protection of industries existing or to be established. But a certain flexibility in preferential tariff must be ensured. This proposed programme should not be a hounded one towards Empire free trade which is believed either desirable nor possible. It was conceivable that a preferential rate should be lower for raw materials or where the Empire supply did not meet the demand and higher where the 10 per cent was inadequate to give adequate goods appreciable advantages over foreign countries. It was also proposed by creating additional preference on goods carried on imperial coast transport between Empire ports, the movement service should be preferably used.

If this change in inter-imperial economic relationship was to be made there should be no delay. It is suggested that technical committees be set up in each country of the Empire to consider the supply line the effect upon their domestic situation and the general point. These should be ready within six months and be therefore proposed that the economic conference meet again at Ottawa as guests of Canada next year to discuss the final report.

The Australian Premier, Mr. Scullin, pointed out that nearly 24,000,000 worth of foreign manufactured goods were imported into Australia annually but that to see shared by Empire industries. How that could be done was a matter for those engaged in the industries of Australia and Britain to determine and he thought methods of consultation should be evolved between these industries with a view to making such allocation of the supply of Australia's requirements as should benefit both parties.
