Kenya's Heavy Share in Allocation of Loan Responsibility.

The effect of the present economic conditions in East Africa is reflected very clearly in the Budget, Kenya and Port Services of Kenya and Uganda.

The Railway revenue for next year is placed at £57.24, less than the figure for 1950, the principal decrease in earnings being one of nearly £30,000 on goods traffic.

On the other hand there is an estimated increase of expenditure of £77,990, principally in transport expenditure of £27,000, which is due to the increasing traffic in low priced commodities the transport of which is being carried by the railway.

The Railway anticipates that next year there will be an excess of revenue over expenditure of £745,672, which is nearly 500,000 more than last year.

One of the main reasons for this surplus, however, is that the Government has decided to make provision for interest and other charges amounting to £200,000, but the Railway will only have interest reserve, etc., of £150,000, one quarter of the balance there budgeted for this year.

But this small surplus will be entirely swallowed up by the losses on the Port. While last year the Port made a small increase and is expected to leave a margin over expenditure of £150,000, this year it is expected to lose £200,000, which will entirely absorb the profit both of the Railway and of the Port.

For a number of years the Railway has been building up certain funds to meet cost of renewals, betterment, insurance, and other such items.

These funds are safeguarded against sudden heavy reductions in revenue. The total of these funds is £281,000, of which £173,700, about one-third of which is planned to expend during the next year.

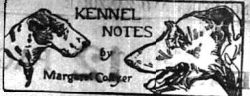

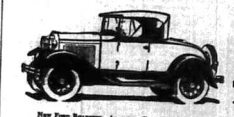

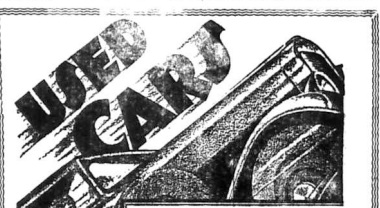
