THE MEMORANDUM ON E.A. NATIVE POLICY.

To Be Placed Before the Joint Committee.

Enquiry Body May Take Into Fullest Account.

During the debate in the House of Lords on the motion for the appointment of the Joint Committee on Closer Union in East Africa, Lord Passfield announced that the Memorandum on Native Affairs would be placed before the Joint Committee.

He explained that this was necessary because it was required in the Memorandum on Closer Union. He further stated that the Government would not prevent the Joint Committee from taking it into consideration as fully as it chose.

The House of Commons has also agreed to a motion in favour of the appointment of the Joint Committee. The East African Delegations are returning this month to give evidence before the Joint Committee. They have, however, achieved one of their primary objects, in getting into touch with the Imperial Conference delegates.

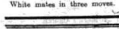

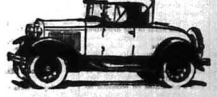

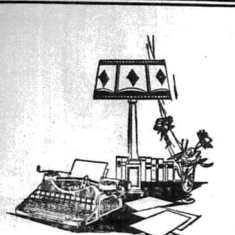
