UNDERWRITERS LEFT WITH £586,000. 23 Per Cent of Kenya Loan Not Subscribed. POOR LOCAL INTEREST. Only £2,700 Taken Up By Subscribers in Colony.

Only £2,700 out of the £50,000 of the Kenya £3,400,000 loan offered for local subscription was taken up in Kenya.

At Home 23 per cent, equal to £586,000, has been left by the underwriters. This duplicates an experience which befell Kenya in 1923.

Among the causes suggested to the "Standard" on enquiry yesterday are the short notice, insufficient publicity, political intrigues regarding East Africa and the premature placing of the loan on the market.

Lord Passfield Defines Purpose of Committee.

LORD CRANWORTH'S VIEW.

Kenya's Spirit of Accommodation Gassed.

Considerable light was thrown upon the functions and status of the Joint Committee on East Africa during the debate in the House of Lords last month when the Secretary of State for the Colonies moved the appointment of the Committee.

Lord Passfield said the Government felt that the appointment of the Committee was "the best way of settling whatever rights and interests that he got on the subject in correction or supplement or alteration of the conclusions which the Government had arrived at and referred to the Committee as the collective wisdom of Parliament."

Lord Lugard and the Archbishop of Canterbury both expressed the view that ordinary parliamentary institutions were outside the Government of the East African Dependencies.

In connection with the Memorandum on Native Policy, Lord Lugard assumed that any improvement which might be suggested by the Joint Committee would cover the question of the phraseology of the Memorandum although it was not the function of such a committee to re-draft a Government memorandum.

Lord Cranworth, who was very critical on the Joint Committee proposal, suggested strongly that the time had not yet come when it would be wise to discuss the spirit of accommodation in Kenya as "a good or a bad thing."

The same speaker also reminded the House of the circumstances in which the panometry phrase had originated and warned them of the dangers of Indian domination in East Africa.

will be a permanent food supply for the future, the fact that more than half has come off private land is a good reason for agricultural purposes. Now a large proportion is coming under the permanent forest reserves, and that the Department has a "wood fund" consisting of all the Department's forests. We will sell the timber from these forests and use the proceeds to buy the railway and other public works. It is not in the least the country's loss, as the timber is sold to the country's benefit.
