**PASSAGE OF THE NEW WATER LAW.****D. P. W. Explains the Committee Changes.**

The final stages of the Water Bill were passed through the Legislative Council on Friday morning when the Director of Public Works proposed the following motion:

"That the report of the Select Committee of Legislative Council appointed to consider and report upon the provisions of a Bill to amend the laws relating to water supply and the management and construction of water works and to regulate water rights in irrigation and drainage be accepted."

In speaking to the motion he said:

"The Select Committee was appointed in August 1928 and the report was laid on the table in July of this year. Although the period which has elapsed since the second reading of the bill is considerable I do not consider it necessary on that account; for the Bill deals with the control of one of the most important of the Colony's natural resources, water. It is perhaps the most important need to the resources in land. Owing to the nature of that resource it is available in quantity as it is affecting the community at so many points it was necessary for the Committee to give especial close attention to the provisions of the bill and to afford means for the public ample opportunity for expressing their views upon the proposed amendments which this bill gives expression to were fully given to the public by the Committee when it laid on the table of Council in August 1928, and follow the lines of the recommen-

dations of Mr. Lewis, the Director of Public Works, and the Hon. Sir South Africa. They were detailed to report to me last year. The Select Committee received representations against the details of importance were an appeal. Much useful help was given by Mr. William Dunn, an expert Civil Engineer and Arabic scholar, as a delegate of the Government, and the Director of Public Works made trouble to convey to the bill and assist the Committee by criticism and advice.

The Amendments.

I will only touch briefly on the most important of the amendments which the Committee recommended.

Some water rights have been granted in past years by lease under the Crown Lands Ordinances and by Agreements. These water rights which have no right of alienation or which have no right of sub-sale, and which are subject to the provisions of the bill, as it will be amended by some that the bill is drafted might be deemed to be confiscatory in regard to those rights. It is not intended. Nothing was further from the mind of the Water Commission than to deprive those rights held by the Water Board by instrument made in good faith and for any other purpose. It is the intention of the bill that the Water Courts in South Africa had to do in regard to the water rights in South Africa after the enactment of the Water Act of 1919 and similar provisions were granted to the Board of Investigation in British Columbia which were in effect to provide for the water rights in British Columbia existing rights.

The question of appeal from a decision of the Water Board was the subject of careful scrutiny by the Select Committee. The bill provided for appeal to the Director-in-Council. It was held both by Government

and the Select Committee that provision for appeal to Executive Council was not desirable. It would be best to provide a special appeal, as tentatively suggested by Mr. Lewis. The Committee considered, however, that in those cases where the amount of compensation could be settled by agreement between the parties concerned, decision should be made by application of the Arbitration Ordinance. The Committee was unanimously of the opinion that in those extreme cases, the reasons for which are set forth in the bill, where the Water Board is empowered to cancel a water right, the person entitled to appeal to the Appeal Board.

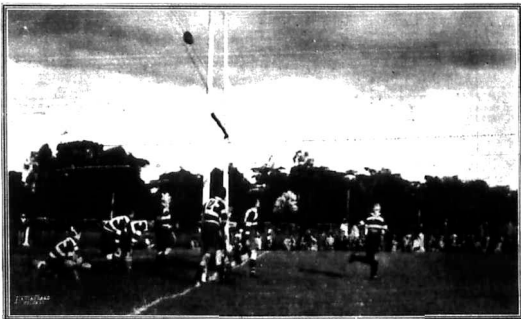
