Washington, Jan. 16. A great national stock-taking on the effects of prohibition was carried out today in the United States by the House of Representatives and the Senate committee with resolutions in favour of repeal which were referred to committee.

The debate in points of view was epitomized by Mr. Shepard in the Senate and Mr. Oliver in the House as Representatives, the former proclaiming that prohibition was "unjustified, un-Christian, un-American," while Mr. Oliver

said that prohibition had transferred drinking "from the bar room to the boudoir."

The "New York Leader" remarks that the anniversary was celebrated by the most genuine enthusiasm and gratitude in 30,000 New York "speakeasies," where a small whisky and soda is retailed at a dollar as compared with the regular price of 25 cents.





Plant of Slower Growth than Political Ability.

By Mr. HUNNY. Above all he will, for the ordinary man, intellectual ability with those qualities which are desired from students and students of a school which are absolutely vital to the healthy growth of a nation. The possession of high ideals and their application to private life is immensely important, but it is not enough. Ideals of honesty and duty and service should permeate the life of the country and be found in the performance of public duties.

Mr. Tomblings has referred to the good progress made by the boys in the Clarke Course which started last January, when I had the privilege of addressing a similar gathering to this, two years ago. That they possess the necessary ability can hardly be doubted, but the possibility of their employment in such positions in the public service depends on whether they are developing the necessary sense of integrity and honesty. Without this sense, as well as other attributes of their character, they are bound to fail and present indications that they are not the material on whom it is worth while to expend educational facilities or national stipends for teaching. It is incumbent on the youth of the rising generation to be just to themselves to attain a high standard of character.

Integrity

"I do not wish it to be thought that I am pessimistic in this matter. I have seen many of our countrymen in their appointments in individual cases who are admirable and whose number that integrity in public life is a sign of a vigorous growth then political ability or intellectual capacity. We have only to look at our own history to be made aware of this, and I look forward to the future, being as it necessarily large number of years in the public service, to see that will comprise credit by men whose qualities of character have been fortified and inspired by the teaching spirit of this College. 






A view in contrast. On the left an old Dispensary erected for the Natives in the Mashaka district. On the right the present building recently substituted.


